DOST 10 Regional Science and Technology Week 2025 Set in Bayfront Arena in Oroquieta City

Oroquieta City will take the spotlight on October 1-3, 2025, as it hosts the Regional Science, Technology, and Innovation Week (RSTW) at the Bayfront Arena. Organized by the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) Northern Mindanao, in partnership with the Provincial Government of Misamis Occidental and the City Government of Oroquieta, the RSTW is the regional annual event that offers the public an opportunity to see how science and technology are being applied to improve lives and communities.



The RSTW is the regional counterpart of the annual celebration of the National Science and Technology Week (NSTW) as mandated under Presidential Proclamation No. 780, signed in 2019. This year's theme is "Agham at Teknolohiya: Kabalikatan sa Matatag, Maginhawa, at Panatag na Kinabukasan" and sub-theme "Building Smart and Sustainable Communities."

The RSTW will feature a Technology Expo, where visitors can explore DOST-developed innovations that offer solutions and opportunities for local industries, enterprises, local government units, students, and people from all walks of life to promote human well-being, foster wealth creation, reinforce wealth protection, and institutionalize sustainability. It is also the platform where the scientific community can meet, collaborate, and network, as well as DOST's vehicle in bringing Science, Technology, and Innovation programs and services closer to the people and support the development agenda of the local governments.

The event will also highlight learning hubs designed to inspire young learners. The Mobile Planetarium will provide a window to the wonders of the cosmos, while nuLAB, a mobile STEM learning facility, will offer high school students hands-on experiences with science and technology and laboratory experiments in an interactive setting.

A major highlight will be the launch of the Innovation Hub (iHUB) in Misamis Occidental. The facility is envisioned as a collaborative space for innovators, researchers, and entrepreneurs to co-create solutions that respond to local challenges.

Ang mga naturang proyekto ay pawang wala sa official Flood Management Program (FMP) ng bansa.

Ayon sa grupo, mahigit P115 billion ang nailaan para sa mga naturang proyekto, kung saan lalo itong lumalaki sa bawat taon, mula sa dating P81.552 billion noong 2022 patungong P115.262 billion ngayong 2025.

Natuklasan ng grupo na sa ilalim ng 2025 General Appropriations Act, ang budget para sa flood control project na wala sa FMP ay halos 50% na mas malaki kumpara sa alokasyong nakapaloob sa FMP.

Inihimbawa ng UP ang budget na nakapaloob ngayong taon para sa flood control project na nakalaan lamang sa pagtatayo at maintenance ng mga general structure tulad ng mga dingsing, revetments, dikes, slope/river-bank protection, drainage systems, at coastal protection infrastructure.

Sa kabila pa ng malaking bulto ng pondong nakalaan sa flood control projects, lumalabas sa pag-aaral ng academic institution na lalo lamang lumalaki ang problema ng bansa. Tinukoy nito ang nangyari sa probinsya ng Albay kung saan mahigit P16.2 billion ang inilaan para sa flood mitigation kung saan mula 2018 ay hanggang 273 flood control project na ang itinayo. Ngunit sa kabila ng maraming proyekto, lumalabas na mahigit P7.3 billion pa rin ang natukoy na infrastructure damage sa naturang lalawigan sa loob ng anim na taon (2017-2023). Ito ang pinakamalaking danyos sa buong bansa.

Ayon sa UP – National College of Public Administration and Governance, ang naturang pattern ay nangyayari sa buong bansa.

Dahil dito, inirekomenda ng naturang institusyon na siyasatin din ang mga proyektong nasa labas ng Flood Management Program ngunit natukoy bilang flood control at disaster-related structures tulad ng mga kalsada, tulay, at evacuation center.

Maliban dito, nakapagtala rin ng ilang mga violations pa ang HPG gaya ng mg asong rehistro kung saan nahuli ang hindi bababa sa 1,000 motorista at 1,212 na mga paglabag sa 'no plate, no travel' policy at 522 na kso ng mga hindi tamang pagkakabit ng mga plaka.

Samantala, nanindigan naman ang HPG na magpapatuloy lamang ang kanilang hanay sa pagkakasa ng mga joint operations katuwang ang iba pang law enforcement agencies upang mahuli ang mga motoristang patuloy na lumalabag sa mga umiiral na batas trapiko sa mga lansangan.

The Department of Science and Technology (DOST) formalized its partnership with e-commerce platform Lazada Philippines on Wednesday to help Filipino micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) expand their market reach and strengthen competitiveness through the digital platform. A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed on September 24, 2025, at the DOST Central Office in Bicutan, Taguig City.

PhilATOM Law ni Cayetano, susi ng bansa tungo sa mas ligtas at mas matalinong paggamit ng nuclear technology

Naisabatas na ang isang landmark law na magbibigay ng malinaw na gabay sa paggamit at pamamahala ng nuclear energy sa Pilipinas, salamat sa mga pagsisikap ni Senate Minority Leader Alan Peter Cayetano. Ito'y matapos lagdaan ni President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. ang Philippine National Nuclear Energy Safety Act (Republic Act No. 12305) bilang isang batas noong September 18, 2025. Si Cayetano ang nanguna sa pagsusulong ng batas at ipinaglaban ang mga naunang

bersyon nito sa Senado bilang chair ng Senate Committee on Science and Technology sa 19th Congress.

"Across the globe, nuclear energy has been used for peaceful and beneficial applications contributing to sectors such as medicine, agriculture, industry, and energy production," wika ni Cayetano.

Sa ilalim ng batas, itatag ang PhilATOM bilang isang independent regulatory body na may eksklusibong kapangyarihang mangasiwa sa kaligtasan, seguridad, at mga pangangalang na may kaugnayan sa nuclear energy, mga pinagmulan ng ionizing radiation, at radioactive materials. "It's obvious why we need the PhilATOM [as established by the] Nuclear Energy Safety Act. It plays a vital role in treating diseases, food security, improving crop yield, mitigating the effects of climate change and generating clean,

reliable power or electricity," giit niya.

Layon din ng batas na i-update ang mga luma nang batas na may kaugnayan sa nuclear energy at maiwasan ang conflict of interest. Mananatili sa Philippine Nuclear Research Institute (PNRI) ang tungkuling magtaguyod ng nuclear energy, habang lililipat naman sa PhilATOM ang tungkuling mag-regulate.

Kaugnay ng ionizing radiation, ang regulatory function ng Food and Drug Administration's Center for Device Regulation, Radiation Health and Research ay lililipat din sa PhilATOM.

Ang paghihiwalay ng tungkulin ng PNRI at FDA ay para makatuon ang mga ahen-sya sa research and development, at sa gayon ay lalong mapapainam ang mga praktikal na aplikasyon ng nuclear energy sa larangan ng medisina, agrikultura, at industriya. "We will align with our international conventions. It is also not really possible for those who promote nuclear atomic energy to be the ones who regulate it. This will fix that problem," aniya.

Upang pangalagaan ang kalayaan ng regulatory body, binigyang diin ng senador na ang PhilATOM ay malaya sa mga political appointment. "Unless the politico or barangay captain or senator has at least 7 years of actual distinguished experience in specific fields of science, they cannot be appointed. In PhilATOM, they should regulate use of nuclear energy, not promote it," sabi ni Cayetano.

Binanggit din ng senador na isa sa mga layunin ng PhilATOM ay ang magbigay-inspirasyon sa mas maraming Pilipino na magtamo ng karera sa larangan ng nuclear energy.

Magalong, tinukoy bilang pampalubag-loob ang posibleng mas mataas na posisyong alok sa kaniya kung magresign bilang alkalde ng Baguio

Tinukoy ni Baguio City Mayor Benjamin Magalong bilang pampalubag-loob ang umano'y mas mataas na posisyon na naghahintay sana sa kaniya kung piniling mag-resign bilang alkalde ng Baguio.

Ayon kay Magalong, mas epektibo siya bilang imbestigador, kung nanatili sana siyang bahagi ng Independent Commission for Infrastructure (ICI).

Mahalaga aniya ang papel ng isang imbestigador sa ICI dahil siya ang magsisiyasat sa lahat ng isyung bumabalot sa public infrastructure, kasama na ang personal na pagbisita sa mga ito. Ito ay malayong naiiba aniya sa papel ng mga commissioner.

Giit ng alkalde, ang kaniyang tungkulin sa ICI ay sapat na para matunton niya ang mga anomalyang bumabalot sa mga public infrastructure project at mailantad ang mga responsableng indibidwal.

Hindi rin aniya opsyon na mag-resign siya bilang alkalde ng Baguio City.

Giit ng alkalde, pinili siya ng mga botante ng naturang lungsod upang makapagsilbi.

Nanindigan ang opisyal na kaya niyang gampanan ang dalawang posisyon – bilang alkalde at imbestigador, lalo na at mismong ang Palasyo Malakaniyang aniya ang gumawa ng paraan para siya ay mapabilang sa ICI.

Camille Sue Mae Ting na tanging sa listahan lamang ng Judicial and Bar Council maaring pumili ang president. At kung hindi man, aniya'y maituturing ito bilang 'unconstitutional' o di' naayon sa saligang batas.

Aniya, malaking ginhawa naman ang pagbabalik ng kuryente kamakailan, matapos ang mga unang araw ng pagdepende sa flashlight at solar lamp.

Bagamat sanay na umano ang lungsod sa mga bagyo, ibang-iba ang naging epekto ng lindol — hindi lang sa mga ari-arian kundi maging sa emosyonal na kalagayan ng mga tao.

Samantala, nagpaabot naman ito ng pasasalamat sa mga pribadong sektor at lokal na pamahalaan na nagpaabot ng tulong, hindi lang sa Bogo City kundi maging sa mga karatig-lugar na naapektuhan rin ng lindol.

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Retirement or marketing gimmick? Cryptic LeBron video sets Internet buzzing

A cryptic video shared by LeBron James set the Internet abuzz on Monday, with fans wondering if the NBA superstar was preparing to announce his retirement or simply another commercial venture.

The 10-second video posted on James' social media channels teased that the Los Angeles Lakers star would reveal the "decision of all decisions" at 1600 GMT on Tuesday, dubbing the event "The Second Decision."

The video was a clear reference to James' first famous, choreographed "Decision" in 2010, when he kept the basketball world on tenterhooks before announcing he was leaving the Cleveland Cavaliers to join the Miami Heat in free agency.

Monday's video comes as James, 40, prepares to make history later this month by becoming the first NBA player to begin a 23rd season in the league.

At a Lakers media day

last week, James said he had made no decision about when he plans to retire from basketball, acknowledging only that he expected it to come "sooner than later."

"I'm excited about today, I'm excited about the opportunity to be able to play the game that I love for another season," James told reporters.

"Whatever the journey lays out this year, I'm super-invested because I don't know when the end is. It's a lot sooner than later."

While one US media outlet's report about Monday's video wondered in a headline "Could retirement be next?", reports also noted that James has an array of commercial partnerships, including Amazon, which could explain the cryptic post. Amazon is staging a sales event on Tuesday.

Yet whether Monday's video teases something momentous such as his retirement, or simply a new business venture, tickets for the Lakers final home game of

the season reportedly skyrocketed. Reports citing Ticketpick, the online marketplace for buying and selling tickets to sports and cultural events, said the cheapest ticket for the Lakers' game against the Utah Jazz on April 12 jumped from \$85 to \$445 in the hours after the video went online.

The cheapest price for a ticket on the SeatGeek online secondary market was an eye-watering \$821, while the lowest price on Ticketmaster was advertised at just over \$955.
