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Cayetano sa Ombudsman: Magsagawa ng lifestyle check sa mga opisyal ng gobyerno

Hinimok ni Senador Alan Peter Cayetano ang Office of the Ombudsman na magsagawa ng maagap na lifestyle checks sa mga opisyal ng gobyerno bilang panangga laban sa korapsyon.

Iminungkahi ito ni Cayetano sa kanyang pagtatatag sa mga kandidato na nagmamagaling susunod na Ombudsman, na isinagawa ng Judicial and Bar Council (JBC) mula August 28 hanggang September 2, 2025.

Si Cayetano ang Senate representative sa JBC sa kanyang kapasidad bilang Chair ng Senate Committee on Justice and Human Rights.

"I'd really like for you to consider lifestyle checks. Kasi kung wala, there's no deterrent," sabi ni Cayetano sa isang kandidato para sa pagka-Ombudsman.

Ipinaliwanag ng senador ang kahalagahan ng lifestyle checks sa pagkumpirma kung naaayon ba ang pamumuhay ng isang opisyal ng gobyerno kumpara sa idineklarang kayamanan base sa kanyang opisyal na Statement of Assets, Liabilities, and Net Worth (SALN).

"Ngayon sa social media, kapag nakita sa SALN mo na meron kang P5 million, but because all of that were acquired in the 1970s to 80s, and you have a car or watch, they automatically think you're corrupt. On the other hand, if you say no to lifestyle checks, many will be

flaunting their wealth," wika ng senador.

Binigyang diin rin ni Cayetano ang kahalagahan na mamuhay ng payak at umiwas sa marangyang buhay ang mga opisyal ng gobyerno. Sinabi niya ito sa gitna ng mga maiinit na alegasyon ngayon ng korapsyon sa flood control at ghost projects.

Iginiit rin niya na dapat mapili ang isang matuwid at proactive na Ombudsman sa gitna ng mga pagsisikap ng pamahalaan na tugunan ang katiwalian.

"Napakahalaga na tama ang mapili nating Ombudsman. Given y'ung nangyayari ngayon sa Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), given y'ung perennial na nangyayari sa iba't ibang departamento, having a very proactive but balanced Ombudsman will really change so much," aniya.

Dagdag pa niya, malaking bagay ang pagpili sa susunod na Ombudsman dahil magiging kritikal ito sa pagbabalik ng tiwala ng publiko sa gobyerno.

"I think who the next Ombudsman is will determine whether people will totally lose confidence in any government official," wika ng senador.

"If we have a good Ombudsman, I really believe na pwedeng bumalik ang tiwala ng tao sa public officials," dagdag pa niya.

DOT launches Philippine Golf Experience to boost PH tourism promotion

"For many years, it has been a long-held desire to bring golf and tourism together in a way that truly unlocks their potential. We have always known that the Philippines—with its stunning landscapes, vibrant culture, and warm hospitality—together with more than a hundred world-class quality golf courses across our islands, has all the makings of a world-class golf destination. What was needed was a deliberate effort to place golf within our broader national strategy, not only as a sport, but as an experience that brings together play, culture, as well as community," Secretary Frasco emphasized in her speech.

The tourism chief said that under the Marcos Administration, the DOT pivoted to an innovative approach that not only counts the country's tourist arrivals but also puts a premium on measuring the value of tourist offerings.

"Tourism, after all, is not only about how many people have arrived, but rather about how many livelihoods it sustains, how many enterprises it strengthens, and how deep the pride of place it nurtures across our communities. Golf captures this most beautifully—for when done sustainably, golf is a high-value, low-impact form of tourism that draws travelers to stay longer, spend more, and engage more deeply with our destinations, not to mention come back again and again," she noted.

With the presence of partners from the public and private sectors, as well as members of the Diplomatic Corps, she said that the event strengthens partnerships among all stakeholders by likewise campaigning for the Philippines as a destination for tourist source and opportunity markets.

Furthermore, the Secretary described that the launch of GolfEx in Clark "is no coincidence" as the emerging leisure golf and leisure hub now has a world-class international airport and facilities.

For her part, Atty. Devanadera expressed confidence in Clark's readiness to host major golf tournaments and other sporting events.

"Clark is ready for the golf tournaments and all kinds of sports tournaments, and we would like to inform you, and to show you, that the secret here is synergy—synergy among the locators, synergy with the government agencies, synergy with our foreign friends, and above all, the leadership of the Department of Tourism, under, of course, the guidance of our President," she said.

In its continuing effort to bring science, technology, and innovation closer to all, the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) - Pangasinan conducted a Technology Training on Calamansi Juice Processing for 30 Persons Deprived of Liberty (PDL) on August 20, 2025, at the Dagupan City Jail – Male Dormitory (DCJ-MD).

The partnership between DOST-Pangasinan and DCJ-MD forms part of its Skills and Enhancement Training Program for both PDLs and jail officers. The training opens opportunities for microenterprise development inside and outside the facility, giving PDLs a better chance at opening opportunities that support rehabilitation and successful reintegration into their communities.

One of the participants, identified as “Mario” (not his real name), shared, “Ang training na ito ay nagbigay sa amin ng pag-asa na makapagsimula ng kabuhayan kapag nakabalik na kami sa aming mga tahanan. Taos-puso kaming nagpapasalamat sa kaalaman at sa pagkakataong matuto habang ginugugol namin ang panahon dito” (This training has given us hope to Start a livelihood once we return to our homes. We are sincerely grateful for the knowledge and for the opportunity to learn while spending our time here).

Mr. Alvin S. Aguilar, Instructor I from Pangasinan State University – Bayambang Campus, and Ms. Monica May B. Varilla, a Professional Food Technologist from the DOST Region 1 – PSU Food Innovation Center served as the resource persons of the training. The activity featured Calamansi Juice Processing as one of the technology offerings of the PSU-DOST Region 1 FIC under its extension and skills training program, which aims to promote food innovation and enterprise development. The participants also learned about current Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP) and Basic Food Safety, essential foundations for producing safe and market-ready food products.

A major highlight of the week is the 2025 STI Awards, which recognized outstand-

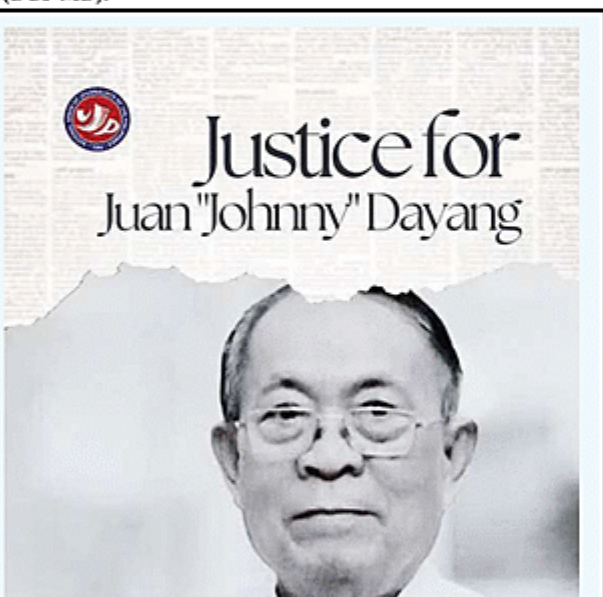

As Secretary Solidum noted, the honorees prove that science is not confined to textbooks or laboratories—it is about lives improved, livelihoods uplifted, and futures secured.

Another key feature was the signing of a partnership among the DOST-Philippine Textile Research Institute (PTRI), DOST Region VIII, and the Local Government Unit of Bobon, Northern Samar. The collaboration seeks to enhance fiber extraction technologies from abaca and pineapple, transforming agricultural by-products into sustainable raw materials for the textile sector while creating new livelihood opportunities in local communities.

Justice for Juan "Johnny" Dayang

On this day, August 29, the Church commemorates the Martyrdom of St. John the Baptist, who was executed for speaking truth to power and refusing to remain silent in the face of wrongdoing.

Exactly four months ago, on April 29, our father, veteran journalist Johnny Dayang, met a similar fate. He was assassinated for being a fearless voice of conscience, a man who dedicated his life to truth, and someone who never compromised in his duty to inform the public. Like John the Baptist, he unsettled those who thrived in silence and falsehood. And like St. John, he was silenced by violence.

As his family, we affirm that while his life was cut short, his voice endures. His writings, his example, and his memory remain alive. His legacy as a journalist and as a truth-teller cannot be erased.

Violence may end a life, but it can never extinguish the truth for which that life was lived.

We continue to seek justice for his assassination, holding on to the hope that those responsible will be held accountable.

Nanawagan na si Nepal President Ramchandra Paudel sa mga protesters na magkaroon ng mapayapang pag-uusap.

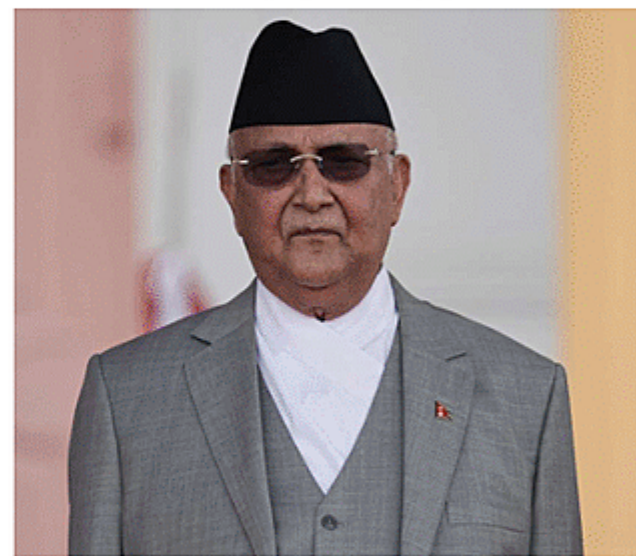

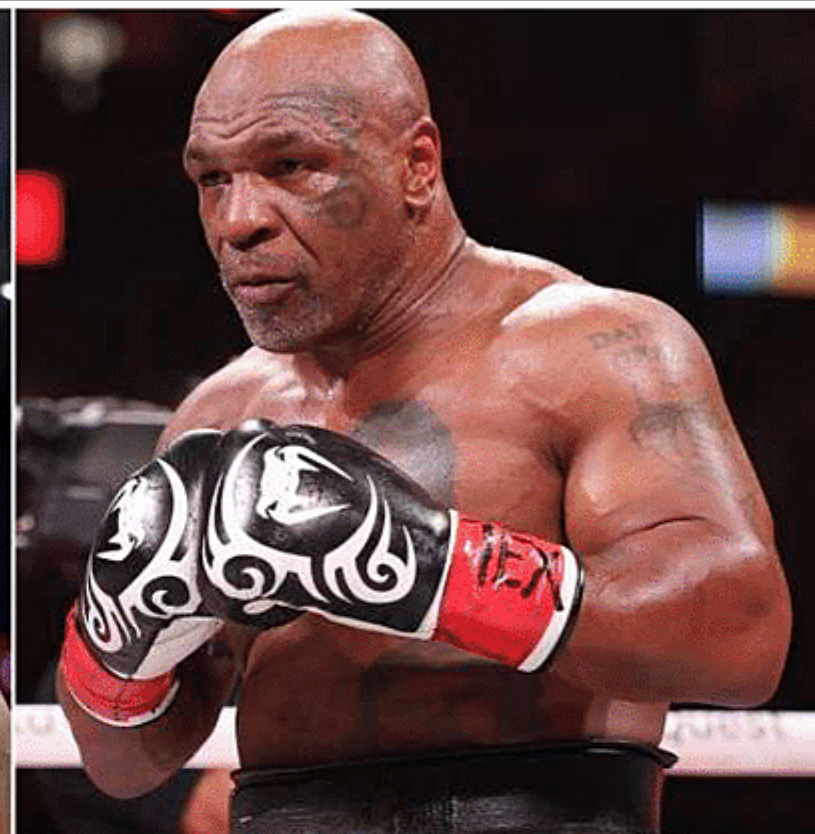
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Mike Tyson at Mayweather maghaharap sa exhibition boxing
