PTFOMS, CHR Sign Agreement to Enhance Journalists' Safety

"The work of journalists is vital in illuminating truth, empowering citizens, and strengthening democracy. Yet, too often, this work is met with harassment, threats, and violence," said Undersecretary Jose Torres Jr., PTFOMS executive director.

"Today's agreement is our roadmap for reversing that trend," he said. "It establishes concrete actions that will provide real protections, prompt responses, and justice for media workers in distress."

Key initiatives under the partnership include:

- Rapid Response Mechanism: Establishing a hotline, threat assessments, and temporary protective measures to swiftly address immediate dangers.
- Investigation and Accountability: Strengthening collaboration with legal and investigative agencies to ensure impartial, timely investigations into attacks.
- Victim Support: Providing legal and psychosocial assistance to victims and their families.
- Capacity Building and Prevention: Conducting gender-sensitive safety training for journalists and first responders.
- Data Monitoring: Sharing databases on threats, attacks, and investigations to identify patterns and inform policy.
- Legal and Policy Reforms: Advocating for measures to expedite investigations, strengthen witness protections and address online harassment.
- Resources and Sustainability: Mobilizing human, technical, and financial resources to sustain protection initiatives.
- Engagement and Awareness: Promoting ongoing dialogue with media organizations, civil society, and the public to foster a culture of respect and responsibility towards journalists.

The partnership underscores the importance of measurable targets, transparency, and continual review to ensure effective implementation.

"Protecting journalists is not just an obligation but a reflection of our commitment to democracy, human rights, and the rule of law," said Torres.

DOST XII Advances Smart and Sustainable Communities through Regional Science and Technology Week 2025

Anchored on the theme "Siyensiya, Teknolohiya, at Inobasyon: Kabalikat sa Matatag, Maginhawa, at Panatag na Kinabukasan" and the subtheme "Building Smart and Sustainable Communities," the celebration emphasized the role of STI in shaping secure, comfortable, and future-ready communities.

Day 1 of RSTW opened with thematic events showcasing the power of STI. Handa Pilipinas Rehiyon Dose highlighted science-based resilience for safer communities, while PROPEL the Future provided a platform for startups, innovators, and entrepreneurs to accelerate technology commercialization.

On Day 2, DOST Secretary Renato U. Solidum Jr. graced the event, underscoring the Department's vital role in delivering science-based solutions to protect lives, safeguard livelihoods, and secure development gains. "It is important that we understand the problem. If we don't understand the problem, maybe our interventions may not be enough," he stressed during Handa Pilipinas Rehiyon Dose.

Major highlights included the launching and MOA signing of the SMART-ER SOCCSKSARGEN Project, awarding of the 2025 Best CEST and Best SETUP regional winners, the converted electric tricycle (CTrike) project in Cotabato, the MOA

signing for two 10+1 seater all-electric tourist trams, and the launch of the AI Bayanihan Challenge. These initiatives reflect DOST's commitment to clean technologies, smart mobility, and inclusive digital transformation.

Throughout the three-day celebration, participants explored forums and exhibits showcasing advanced technologies such as Artificial Intelligence, Internet of Things, and digital ecosystems,

alongside grassroots-driven innovations. The RSTW underscored that building smart and sustainable communities begins with people — with inclusivity, accessibility, and dignity for all at its core. The 2025 RSTW in SOCCSKSARGEN concluded with a reaffirmation: the event is not merely a celebration but part of a continuing mission. Each partnership, program, and initiative demonstrated how science, technology, and

innovation address pressing challenges such as climate change, digital transformation, and inclusive economic growth.

Breakthrough Research and Innovations Take Spotlight at 2025 RSTW EduTech Summit PM Sessions

The afternoon sessions of the 2025 Regional Science, Technology, and Innovation Week (RSTW) featured two parallel R&D Summits that highlighted pioneering projects aligned with regional development priorities.



R&D Summit 1 focused on innovations in textiles, smart mobility, and sustainable urban transport:

Ms. Jona May G. Basit of the Philippine Textile Research Institute (PTRI) introduced "SEDA Pilipinas," a groundbreaking project merging traditional Philippine silk weaving with advanced technology to promote sustainable livelihoods and preserve cultural heritage.

Mr. Timothy Joshua Vargas, President and Co-founder of Mobility Vision+, showcased smart mobility solutions that leverage digital platforms and data analytics to improve transportation efficiency in cities.

Dr. Audy R. Quebral, Project Leader of eTram and CEO of Aparri Campus, discussed the development of an eco-friendly transport system aimed at cutting carbon emis-

sions and supporting sustainable urban growth.

These presentations were followed by an engaging open forum where participants exchanged ideas on blending science, culture, and technology for sustainable progress. R&D Summit 2 centered on community-focused research tackling social welfare, disaster preparedness, and agriculture:

Dr. Noel S. Gunay of Mindanao State University-General Santos introduced "ItWatcher," an AI-powered 24/7 traffic monitoring system designed to enhance road safety and traffic flow in General Santos City.

Dr. Mary Jane K. Balawag of Notre Dame University presented her study on the psychosocial impact of maternal incarceration on children, highlighting the need for stronger social support

systems. Engr. Christopher A. Benito of the University of Southern Mindanao presented the "USM Center for Flood/Landslide Preparedness and Mitigation," a project aimed at strengthening community resilience through disaster risk reduction and early warning systems.

Dr. Edward Barlaan showcased his research on cacao varietal fingerprinting, which identifies high-yield and quality cacao varieties to improve farmer productivity and preserve traditional Philippine strains.

The session concluded with a strong call for collaboration among academe, government, industry, and communities, underscoring that addressing real-world challenges through innovation requires collective effort. (Alex P. Josol, Cathy Q. Cat and Amirel Mamacotao)

200 STARBOOKS Units Installed in La Union Schools, Opening News Doors for Learners through Science and Technology

This milestone was made possible through the joint efforts of the Department of Science and Technology Region 1 (DOST Region 1), the DOST-Science and Technology Information Institute (DOST-STII), and the Department of Education - Schools Division Office of La Union (DepEd - LUSDO).

The three-day mass installation and deployment, held on August 18 to 20, 2025 at the DepEd Division Office Center in San Fernando City, marked a significant step towards making science, technology, and innovation-based knowledge more accessible to students and teachers even in schools where internet connectivity is a challenge.

Leading this landmark initiative was Mr. Justin N. Madrid, Project Leader of STARBOOKS in DOST Region 1, together with the dedicated DOST-STII STARBOOKS Team. The program opened with uplifting messages from education and science leaders, including:

- Dr. Teresita A. Tabaog, Regional Director, DOST Region 1
- Dr. Tolentino G. Aquino, Regional Director, DepEd Region 1, represented by Dr. Emiliana M. Boac, Chief of School Governance and Operations Division
- Dr. Napoleon K. Juanillo Jr., Assistant Secretary for Technology Transfer, Communications, and Commercialization and OIC Director of DOST-STII, represented by Ms. Louella L. Pestaño, STARBOOKS Unit Head.

One of the highlights of the event was the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) Signing Ceremony between LUSDO, DOST-STII, and DOST La Union Provincial Director Mr. Jonathan M. Viernes. The

A brighter future for learning has begun in La Union as 200 elementary and high schools across the province received STARBOOKS (Science and Technology Academic and Research-Based Openly Operated KioskS) installations.



MOA symbolizes not just a partnership, but a shared vision of continuously expanding access to quality learning resources across the province.

To ensure that schools can maximize the use of STARBOOKS, a hands-on training and orientation was conducted by Mr. Reynaldo Morales, Science Research Analyst of DOST-STII. The training gathered 284 participants composed of ICT coordinators and librarians (232 female and 52 male) who

are now equipped to guide their schools in using STARBOOKS as a powerful learning tool.

The program concluded with a heartfelt message from Ms. Katrina Ronquillo, Provincial Focal Person of DOST La Union, delivered on behalf of Director Viernes. She emphasized the govt's unwavering commitment to bridging the digital divide, especially for learners in far-flung areas, and highlighted how technology can serve as

a great equalizer in education.

With STARBOOKS now installed in 200 schools, thousands of learners in La Union will soon have access to a wealth of digital resources ranging from science and technology journals, research papers, and e-learning materials to livelihood guides and interactive content. This initiative paves the way for a more inclusive, innovative, and knowledge-driven generation of learners who are better prepared to face the future.

DOST Region 2 Conducts Two-Day Monitoring of SETUP Beneficiaries in Cagayan

The activity, organized by the Regional Project Management Office (RPMO) in collaboration with the Provincial Science and Technology Office (PSTO)-Cagayan and with the participation of the Commission on Audit (COA), was carried out to evaluate the progress of funded projects and ensure the proper use of government resources.

As part of the monitoring, the team visited project sites, validated implementation milestones, and inspected equipment provided under the program. These efforts allowed the group to measure the impact of SETUP on local enterprises and to identify additional areas

where support is needed to strengthen business competitiveness.

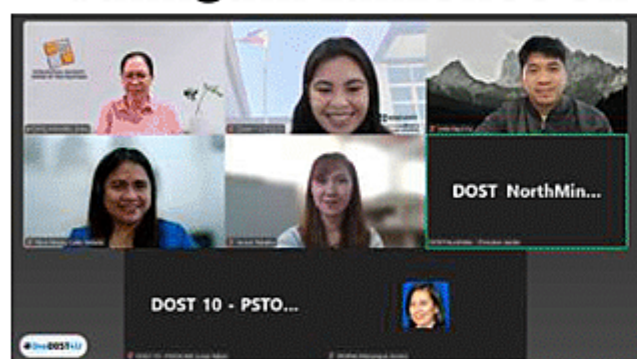
Since 2023, a total of 26 micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) in Cagayan have received P32 million in SETUP support. With this assistance, enterprises have been able to adopt innovative technologies, boost productivity, and expand their market reach.

Through these initiatives, DOST Region 02 reaffirmed its commitment to continuously support MSMEs by providing regular monitoring, technical guidance, and science- and technology-based solutions to drive sustainable enterprise growth.

Camiguin Lanzones on the path to GI protection



The Department of Science and Technology - Camiguin Provincial Science and Technology Office (DOST Camiguin) convened an engagement meeting with the Intellectual Property Office of the Philippines (IPOPHL) to advance its initiative of applying for Geographical Indication (GI) certification for Camiguin Lanzones. The discussion centered on the capacity building requirements, the process of filing a GI application, and best practices, ensuring that stakeholders are well-prepared to comply with standards and documentation.

A Geographical Indication (GI) is a form of intellectual property protection that identifies a product as originating from a specific place, where its quality, reputation, or unique characteristics are linked to its geographic origin. For Camiguin, having the Lanzones recognized under GI will safeguard its authenticity, protect farmers from imitation, and give the product a market advantage. It will also help increase the value of the fruit, support farmer income, and open more opportunities in both local and international markets.

The session was attended by experts from IPOPHL, Engr. John Paul Yu, Atty. Irma Morcillo, and Ms. Emmelina Masanque, and Ms. Jerace Tabalba of DTI Camiguin, who shared valuable insights and guidance for this undertaking.

This initiative reinforces DOST Camiguin's commitment to empower local farmers, enhance product value, and secure Camiguin Lanzones' place in the global market through intellectual property protection.

Isinagawa ito sa ilalim ng "Bayanihan sa Estero: Malinis na Estero, Pamayanan Protektado" program, kung saan 135 TUPAD workers ang itinalaga upang linisin ang Buli Creek sa Pasig, Catmon Creek sa Malabon, at Hagonoy at Pinagsama Creeks sa Taguig.

Liban dito, 236 TUPAD workers din ang nagtulong sa pagtanggap ng water lilies, damo, at basura sa mga daluyan ng tubig patungong Laguna de Bay.

Ang programa ay pinangungunahan ng Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA) katuwang ang iba't ibang ahensya ng gobyerno, LGUs, NGOs, at pribadong sektor.

Iginiit ni Senador Rodante Marcoleta na dapat sa Pilipinas isinagawa ang anumang paglilitis at pagpaparusa kung sakaling may pagkakasala si dating Pangulong Rodrigo Duterte alinsunod sa umiiral na mga batas ng bansa.

Kasalukuyang nakaditine si Duterte sa The Hague Netherlands kaugnay ng kasong crimes against humanity.

Giit ng senador sa ad interim appointments ng 24 na foreign service officials ng Department of Foreign Affairs, hindi sinunod ng International Criminal Court (ICC) ang sarili nitong mga regulasyon at patakaran sa pag-aresto.

Aniya, may umiiral na domestic law na nagsasaad na kahit ang mga kasong tinuturing na international crimes ay saklaw pa rin ng hurisdiksiyon ng bansa.

Kasunod nito, pito pang sasakyan ang boluntaryong isinuko ng pamilya Discaya sa BOC kabilang ang mga sumusunod: Rolls-Royce Cullinan 2023, Bentley Bentayga, Mercedes-Benz G-Class (Brabus G-Wagon), Mercedes AMG G63 SUV 2022, Toyota Tundra 2022, Toyota Sequoia at Cadillac Escalade ESV 2021. Ang tatlong natitirang sasakyan na isang Mercedes-Benz G 500 SUV 2019, GMC Yukon Denali SUV 2022, at Lincoln Navigator L 2024, ay kasalukuyang nasa awtorisadong service centers para sa pagkumpuni at inaasahang isusuko rin sa BOC. Ayon kay Commissioner Nepomuceno,

DOE, humiling ng P3.8-B budget para sa 2026

Humihiling ang Department of Energy (DOE) ng P3.8 billion budget para sa taong 2026 —mas mataas ng 24.44% kumpara sa P3.1 billion nitong taong 2025.

Kasama sa panukala ang P500 million para sa total electrification project at P6.4 billion para sa national rural electrification program, bilang suporta sa layunin ni Pangulong Ferdinand Marcos Jr. na makamit ang 100% electrification bago matapos ang kanyang termino.

Layunin din ng budget na palakasin ang malinis na enerhiya sa bansa. Makakatang-

gap din ng P198 million ang Renewable Energy Development Program (tumaas ng 15.7%) at P460 million ang Alternative Fuels and Energy Technology Program na tumututok sa electric vehicles, LPG, at CNG.

Target ng DOE na maabot ang 35% renewable energy share sa power mix ng bansa pagsapit ng 2030.

Samantala mabilis namang inaprubahan ng House Committee on Appropriations noong Martes, Setyembre 2, ang panukalang P3.8 budget ng DOE para sa taong 2026, matapos tapusin ang deliberasyon sa loob lamang ng ilang minuto.

Ang mabilis na proseso

ay alinsunod sa tradisyon ng Kamara na hindi na isinasailalim sa matagal na pagbusisi ang mga dating kongresistang ngayon ay miyembro na ng Gabinete na kung magugunita si DOE Secretary Sharon Garin, na dating kinatawan ng Iloilo, ang kasalukuyang pinuno ng ahensya.

Una rito, pinangunahan ni Gagayan de Oro Rep. Rufus Rodriguez ang mosyon para tapusin agad ang pagtalakay.

"In accordance with the long-held tradition, the former colleague who is appointed as secretary... I move that we dispense and terminate the budget of the DOE," aniya at walang tumutol sa mosyon.

SOJ Remulla, planong baliktarin ang 'memo' ni ex-Ombudsman Martires sa 'access' ng SALN

Ayon sa naturang kalihim, na ngayon'y kabilang sa mga aplikante sa posisyon pagka-Ombudsman, gagawin niya raw ito sakaling siya ang maitalaga sa puwesto. Kanyang ibinahagi pa na aprub sa kanya maging 'accessible' ito at maalis ang paglilimita ngunit kalakip nito'y ilang hakbang para mapanatili ang kaligtasan o 'proper safeguards' aniya. Kasabay nito ay nilinaw ni Justice Secretary Remulla na kailangan munang magsumite ng liham ang isang indibidwal na layon makakuha o magkaroon ng 'access' sa naturang dokumento. Ngunit kanyang paalala naman na ang paghingi o akses sa naturang impormasyon ay dapat hindi gamitin bilang blackmail.

Aniya'y may panganib itong dala-dala sa oras na maibahagi sapagkat hindi lamang raw basta-basta ang nilalaman ng dokumento. Samantala, pabor ang naturang kalihim ng Department of Justice na masilip sa lifestyle check maging ang kaanak ng mga opisyal ng gobyerno. 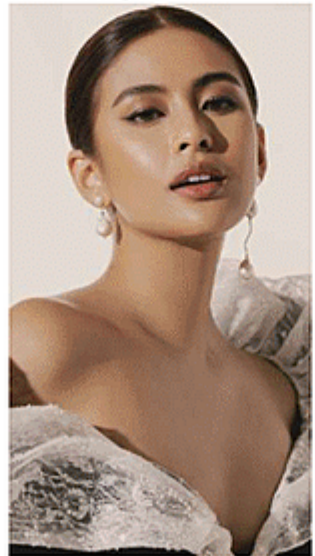

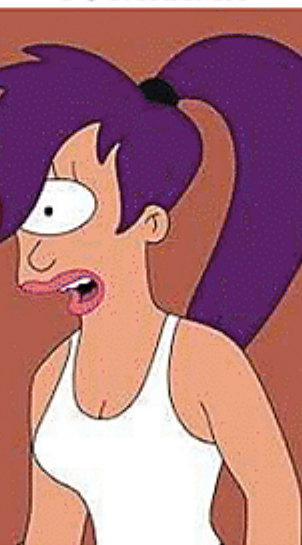
Kaugnay nito, umapela na ang grupo para sa humanitarian assistance mula sa United Nations at iba pang regional at international organisations.

Nagsimula ito ng magiging professional boxer noong 1967 sa edad na 17.

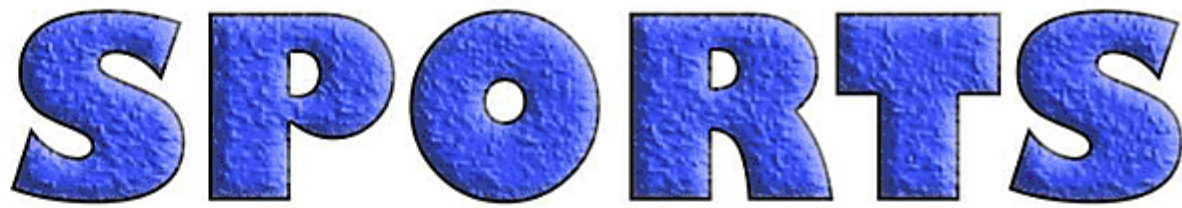
Naging British at European boxing champion ito noong 1970.
