Elevating Mediation and ADR Standards at the 6th AMA Conference



The 6th Asian Mediation Association (AMA) Conference, hosted by the Supreme Court of the Philippines in support from the Office of the Court Administrator and the Philippine Judicial Academy, took place from October 15-16, 2024, at the Grand Hyatt Manila in Taguig City. Themed "Harmony and Strategic Innovations in Mediation and ADR," the conference aims to bring together local and international experts, ADR practitioners, academics, and advocates from across Asia and beyond to explore the future of mediation and its role in promoting peace and justice.

In her keynote address, Hon. Rosmari Candang, Chancellor of the Philippine Judicial Academy, emphasized the need for innovative approaches to mediation and ADR to ensure justice systems remain accessible, efficient, and equitable. She highlighted key areas such as family mediation, cross-cultural justice, environmental disputes, and the integration of artificial intelligence, stressing the transformative power of mediation, which reflects humanity's collective desire for harmony in a world where conflicts are inevitable.

The two-day event featured eight sessions designed to promote dialogue and knowledge exchange on a wide range of topics related to mediation and ADR. These sessions included discussions on Family Mediation led by retired Philippine Chief Justice Teresita J. Leonardo-De Castro; Access to Justice and Dispute Resolution Across Cultures by Justice Pamidighantam Sri Narasimha of the Supreme Court of India; and The Use of Mediation in Managing Environmental Disputes presented by Atty. Brenda Jay C. Angeles-Mendoza from the ADR Department of PHILJA. Additional sessions focused on Community Dispute Resolution in the Philippine Context with Atty. Irene D.T. Alogoc; Enhancing International Dispute Resolution Capabilities for the Complex Global Business Environment with Dr. Alfred Chan from the Hong Kong Mediation Centre; and a Survey of Online Dispute Resolution Platforms by Mr. Anil Xavier of the Indian Institute of Arbitration and Mediation. Discussions also addressed Artificial Intelligence as a Tool in Mediation by Mr. Daryl

Chew; and Ethical Challenges in the Age of Digital Mediation presented by Mr. Chern Yang See of the Singapore International Mediation Institute.

Hon. Alfredo Caguiao, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of the Philippines, also addressed the conference, underscoring mediation as an essential alternative to conventional court proceedings. "The foremost aspiration of mediation is to resolve disputes within the framework of the rule of law," Caguiao said, emphasizing that with an increasingly interconnected world, cross-border conflicts have become common, necessitating collective and global efforts to resolve them.

The event welcomed First Lady Louise Araneta-Marcos as the guest of honor, underscoring the conference's significance in advancing the Philippine judiciary's goals of making justice more accessible through ADR mechanisms. Distinguished speakers participated in sessions designed to stimulate insights on enhancing ADR techniques and adapting to evolving regional and global challenges. This conference promotes cooperation among ADR professionals across Asia, strengthening the regional mediation landscape. Established to foster mediation application across the continent, the AMA has previously held conferences in Singapore, Malaysia, Hong Kong, China, and Indonesia. The 6th AMA Conference represents a critical step toward advancing mediation as a preferred method for resolving disputes, ensuring that justice remains accessible, particularly in a world where conflicts transcend borders. DOST capacitates 39 DA-SAAD farmers with food safety, good manufacturing practices

On September 26, 2024, trainers capacitated thirty-nine individuals who attended the training at the Barangay Small Banisilon Gymnasium in Tungal, Lanao del Norte.

The association is composed of farmers who are beneficiaries of the Department of Agriculture's Special Area for Agricultural Development (DA-SAAD) Program, which aims to alleviate poverty in the marginalized sectors of agriculture and fishery.

The DA-SAAD Program introduced the association to DOST-X to elevate its production of bottled chili garlic, soon-to-be-available dried chilis, and virgin coconut oil.

This activity aligns with DOST's strategy to provide STI-driven support services for the production and manufacturing sectors, which will help them in value-adding activities of their agricultural goods.

In her remarks, Ms. Carion M. Mapandi, the Association President, underscored the relevance of food safety to her members and how it can add value to their livelihood and be applied in their daily lives.

Ms. Gerrylyou Sweet Pia and Ms. Melody Anne Donio were the activity trainers. Trainers taught farmers to identify and mitigate food hazards that could compromise the quality of their bottled chili garlic products and future products.



TANGCAL, LANA DEL NORTE—To provide modern technical guidance and assist farmers in value-adding production, the Department of Science and Technology—X (DOST—X) trained the Small Banisilon Farmers Association in food safety and good manufacturing practices.

The training attendees were taught techniques for improving their product labels and production layouts, making their products more appealing to the public, and complying with regulatory requirements.

DOST-X extended its assistance through consultation on developing the association's plant layout design to improve its production process, leading to increased output and higher-quality products.

With the new insights gained from the training, the Small Banisilon Farmers Association is optimistic about improving the quality and safety of their products, which could open new opportunities for growth and market expansion.

DA-SAAD Focal Person, Mr. Ashary Sanguiligan, stated, "Small Banisilon Farmers Association is grateful for the collaborative effort we extended to them. The Food Safety Training by the DOST is a stepping stone for the association to establish a

community-based enterprise. I hope all SAAD Phase 2 supported associations in Lanao del Norte can benefit from this training."

This activity addresses the target of Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 2.3, which aims to double the agricultural productivity and incomes of small-scale food producers, in particular women, indigenous peoples, family farmers, and others, for value addition and non-farm employment by 2030. Mindanao gears up for disaster challenges with DOST's 'Handa Pilipinas'



THE Department of Science and Technology (DOST), through its office in Region XII, has launched the Mindanao leg of its "Handa Pilipinas" initiative at the KCC Convention Center in General Santos City.



The event, with the theme "Enhancing Mindanao's Resilience through Science, Technology, and Innovation," seeks to bolster the region's disaster preparedness through advanced science and technology interventions.

Engr. Sancho A. Maborang, DOST Undersecretary for Regional Operations, highlighted Mindanao's vulnerability to volcanic hazards and flash floods, noting that the region is home to at least 25 active and inactive volcanoes.

Maborang underscored the importance of technological innovations in preparing communities for these risks, which are aligned with the administration's support for the Handa Pilipinas initiative.

Assistant secretary Bernardo Rafaelito Alejandro IV, who is the Deputy Administrator for Administration and Education of the Office of Civil Defense (OCD), said the DOST and the OCD are focused on reducing disaster risks and implementing effective measures. He also stressed the necessity of inter-agency collaboration to enhance disaster preparedness in the region.

In his keynote address, DOST Secretary Dr. Renato U. Solidum Jr. focused on the importance of anticipating and preparing for natural hazards, pointing out that disaster prevention is a shared responsibility, and through proper planning and mitigation strategies, communities can be protected from hazards.

Solidum said a proactive approach to disaster mitigation is the foundation of the Handa Pilipinas program, which aims to empower communities to save lives and livelihoods.

A key moment during the event was the signing of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the DOST and the Office of the Presidential Adviser on Peace, Reconciliation, and Unity (OPAPRU), a partnership that is designed to provide science and technology interventions to empower former combatants and their families in the six recognized MILF camps in Mindanao.

The MOA seeks to address the need for sustainable livelihood and community development in the Mindanao areas.

Secretary Carlito G. Galvez Jr., Presidential Adviser on Peace, Reconciliation, and Unity, highlighted the transformative potential of technology in peacebuilding efforts, noting how it can foster dialogue, create economic opportunities, and promote healing and trust within communities.

The event brought together distinguished leaders and stakeholders from various sectors, marking a significant step towards creating collaborative solutions for disaster resilience. The Handa Pilipinas Mindanao leg showcased cutting-edge DRRM technologies ready for adoption by local leaders, aimed at enhancing safety measures in Mindanao's most vulnerable areas.

The initiative is part of a broader national goal to achieve a resilient Philippines, where communities are equipped to mitigate and adapt to the risks posed by natural and climate-related disasters. (Nelson Santos)

Ipinunto pa ng grupo na ang pagkabilangon bawin ang pagpasa ng bagong batas ay mangangahulugan ng panibagong

pag-urong sa pagsisikap na tugunan ang krisis sa edukasyon.

Iginiit din ni ACT chairman Vladimir Quetua na itinaguyod ng mga eksperto at ng Department of Education (DepEd) noon na maging prayoridad na wika ng pagtuturo ang mother tongue.

Kayat ang hakbang na ito umano ay nakakagulo sa logical transitory framework kung saan ang mother tongue ang first language, ang Filipino ang second language at ang English naman ang third language sa pagtuturo. Ang tunay na agenda din umano sa likod nito ay hindi para sa mga mag-aaral na magkaroon ng mastery sa mga mahalagang aral na kailangan nilang matutunan, ngunit upang gawin itong marketable para sa mga dayuhang employer.



With the theme, "Siyensya, Teknolohiya, at Inobasyon: Kabalik sa Matatag, Maginhawa, Panatag na Kinabukasan - Providing Solutions and Opening Opportunities in the Green Economy," the three-day celebration features exhibits, technology demonstrations, and forums that focus on eco-friendly solutions in energy, agriculture, manufacturing, and other key industries.

The event also brings together innovators, researchers, entrepreneurs, and government leaders to collaborate and explore pathways toward a more resilient and sustainable future.

In his opening message, DOST XII Regional Director Engr. Sammy P. Malawan said that "this year's RSTW will feature a diverse range of activities and milestones, underscoring the region's unwavering commitment to innovation and community empowerment."

Monetary Board, binawasan ang target reverse repurchase rate ng 25 basis points

Nagpasya ang Monetary Board na bawasan ang Target Reverse Repurchase (RRP) Rate ng BSP ng 25 basis points hanggang 6.0 percent.

Inanusyo ito sa kanilang monetary policy meeting ni-tong Miyerkules.

Ang interest rates sa overnight deposit at lending facilities ay nai-adjust sa 5.50 porsyento at 6.50 porsyento.

Magkakabisang mga ito sa October 17 transactions.

Ang desisyon ng Monetary Board ay batay sa assessment nito na ang mga price pressure ay manageable.

Bumaba rin ang risk-adjusted inflation forecast para sa 2024 sa 3.1 percent mula sa 3.3 percent sa nakaraang pulong.

Inaasahan ng Monetary Board na patuloy na magiging malakas ang domestic economic growth.

Sinasalamin nito ang mga pinabuting prospect para sa kita at pagkonsumo ng sambahayan, mga pamumuhunan, at paggasta ng gobyerno, na sinusupportahan ng pagsisimula ng monetary easing cycle sa Agosto at ang inihayag na pagbawas sa

mga kinakailangan sa reserba noong Oktubre.

Sa balanse, patuloy na sinusupportahan ng within-target inflation outlook at well-anchored inflation expectations ang paglipat ng BSP tungo sa hindi gaanong mahigpit na patakaran sa pananalapi.

Gayunpaman, patuloy na susubaybayan ng monetary authority ang mga lumilitaw

na konsiderasyon sa inflation, kabilang ang mga geopolitical factors.

Inaasahang pananatilihin ng Monetary Board ang isang nasusukat na diskarte sa easing cycle nito upang matiyak ang katatagan ng presyo na nakakatulong sa napapanatiliing paglago ng ekonomiya at trabaho.

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Kylian Mbappe 'investigated for rape' in Sweden

After Swedish newspaper Aftonbladet reported that an alleged rape had been reported to police but did not say who was accused, Expressen newspaper said 25-year-old Mbappe was the suspect.

"According to information obtained by Expressen, police are investigating the star who is reasonably suspected of rape and sexual assault," the newspaper wrote.

Swedish law enforcement differentiate the level of suspicion as either reasonable or probable, with reasonable being the lower degree of suspicion.

Mbappe's entourage, when contacted by AFP, said it had no knowledge of a legal complaint made against him.

The French international was not selected for his country's latest round of Nations League matches, so visited the Swedish capital with a group of people last Thursday.

They dined at a restaurant before going to a nightclub, according to the Aftonbladet report. Mbappe and the group left Sweden on Friday.

The newspaper said a rape was committed "in Stockholm city centre", citing a formal complaint made to police on Saturday that it had seen.

Aftonbladet said the complaint was filed after the alleged victim had sought medical attention but did not say who was named in the accusation.

Later, Expressen reported that Mbappe was the suspect.

Mbappe himself claimed in a post on X, formerly known as Twitter, that there was a link between the Aftonbladet report and his hearing before a French league committee on Tuesday in his bitter dispute with his former club Paris Saint-Germain over what he says are unpaid wages.

Mbappe claims he is owed 55 million euros (\$60 million) by the Qatar-owned French champions.

"FAKE NEWS!!!! It's becoming so predictable, on the eve of the hearing, as if by chance," Mbappe posted.

A prosecutor investigating the accusation told AFP: "A probe is under way into a crime that was reported on October 10 in the center of Stockholm."

- "Slandorous" - Swedish police declined to give any further details.

"In general, if we have received a complaint and decided to conduct interviews and we make it known (to the public), those involved in the case may take actions that delay and complicate the investigation," said police spokeswoman Carina Skagerlind.

Aftonbladet published photos on its website on Monday showing police officers in front of the hotel where Mbappe and the group with him had stayed.

Mbappe's entourage said

in a statement sent to AFP: "Today, a new slanderous rumor is starting to spread across the web from the Swedish media Aftonbladet.

"These accusations are completely false and irresponsible, and their propagation is unacceptable.

"In order to put an end to this methodical destruction of (the) image (of Kylian Mbappe), all necessary legal action will be taken to re-establish the truth and pursue any person or media involved in the moral harassment and defamatory treatment that Kylian Mbappe is suffering repeatedly," the statement added.

A source close to Paris Saint-Germain told AFP it would "ignore" Mbappe's claim that there was a link between the report in Sweden and his dispute with the club.

Mbappe joined Madrid in the summer after seven years at PSG.

He has become one of the world's highest paid players after a stellar career.

He joined Pele as the only teenager to score in a World Cup final when France beat Croatia 4-2 to win the 2018 edition and was voted Best Young Player of the tournament.

Four years later in Qatar, he scored a hat-trick in the final against Argentina but finished on the losing side as Lionel Messi's side won in a penalty shootout.

How Mariane Mariano manages competing at an older age

Mariane Mariano knows that she is up not only against her opponent, but also Father Time even as she prepares for her long-awaited debut in ONE Championship.

The 36-year-old Filipina fondly known as "Trigun" faces Norika Ryu of Japan in a three-round strawweight MMA bout at ONE Friday Fights 83 on October 18 at the Lumpinee Stadium in Bangkok, Thailand.

It will be her first time stepping into the ONE Championship cage after a storied career in combat sports in the Philippines.

"I want to prove that age is just a number, for as long as you listen to your body," said Mariano. "It's not enough for you to say that 'I can still do it.' Age and your body plays a factor in it."

"Maybe, mentally I'm tough, but I have to really listen to my body," she admitted. "I must work on my strength."

"The kids today, the younger generation, they're a different breed. That's the challenge. I'll do my best, I'll do what it takes, so people will say that this hot mama's still got it."

Mariano credits her family and her train-

ing partners for motivating her to aim higher. While she is already satisfied with what she's done in the world of combat sports in the Philippines, she now has the opportunity to see action in a new arena -- mixed martial arts.

"It's my family and the people around me. There are times wherein I feel tired, but they've always been there. Their support is amazing. I can say they're silent supporters but when you talk to them, they're praying for you and they're really there for you," she said.

"My main motivation now is my loved ones and my team that continues to push me. They really push me to be better."

With a US\$100,000 contract a possibility depending on how she performs, Mariano knows that she won't see bigger opportunities to chase her global MMA dreams than this one.

"This is a once in a lifetime shot. I wouldn't want to waste it. This is the only thing missing from my checklist, a shot at an international MMA organization," she said.

"I have the confidence. I believe that I can still pull the trigger against this kid."
