DOST Region 02 Expands STARBOOKS Access in Sto. Tomas, Isabela



Mr. Carl Reyes, the regional focal person for STARBOOKS, successfully installed 13 kiosks across three schools namely Santo Tomas National High School, Lanna National High School, and Santo Tomas Technological International School.

During the closing program, Mr. Reyes presented a detailed overview of STARBOOKS, highlighting its features and providing a step-by-step guide on how to access and navigate the kiosk. He also emphasized the importance of monitoring, managing customer profiles, and generating monthly transmittal files to track engagement. Senate President Francis Escudero on Tuesday urged families of alleged extrajudicial killings (EJK) to finally sue former President Rodrigo Duterte following his declaration at the Senate Blue Ribbon sub-committee that he alone was responsible for the brutal drug war.

Drug war critics question Go, Dela Rosa participation in Senate probe

Among the most vocal of them was Sen. Ronald "Bato" Dela Rosa, former national police chief, who made statements to defend himself and the Philippine National Police and asked resource persons questions after their presentations to the Senate Blue Ribbon sub-committee chaired by Sen. Aquilino "Koko" Pimentel III, a former Duterte ally.

Go, who gave an opening statement, claimed that the drug war was necessary and enjoyed wide support from the public.

He also said that he was not only a member of the panel holding the hearing but

also a resource person on the Duterte administration's flagship program.

In a statement, the National Union of Peoples' Lawyers, whose members have been assisting the families of drug war victims in court, said that an inquiry at the House has already "yielded significant revelations" in alleged extrajudicial killings in the drug war and alleged reward system for those killings.

"Today, as an investigation into the 'war on drugs' by the Senate opens, we are agast that it has become a platform for those involved and accused," NUPL said in a

statement.

The pro bono lawyers warned that the participation of Dela Rosa and former Duterte aide Sen. Christopher "Bong" Go in the proceedings raises doubts on how independent and effective the probe will be.

They pointed out that Go and Dela Rosa "had neither the decency nor discretion to inhibit themselves" from the probe despite being linked to the alleged drug war killings by resource persons at the inquiry being handled by the House quad committee.

In a separate statement on social media, Kabataan Party-List Rep. Raoul Manuel said that "top officials in charge of the fake and anti-people drug war are hijacking the Senate hearing."

Manuel said that the people that the Senate panel was supposed to be investigating were being handed a platform to serve their own agenda.

"They are bastardizing the legislative inquiry. The Senate should not sit back and let Bato and Digong continue their self-serving move," he also said.

Sens. Dela Rosa and Go, members of former President Rodrigo Duterte's Partido Demokratiko Pilipino, have denied claims made at the House that law enforcement personnel who killed alleged drug personalities received rewards as claimed in separate testimonies by Police Col. Jovie Espenido and retired Lt. Col. Royina Gamma.

Dela Rosa had even proposed holding the inquiry under the Senate Committee on Public Order and Dangerous Drugs, which he chairs.

While official government data said 6,181 people were killed in Duterte's war on drugs, several rights group believed up to 30,000 may have been killed, some innocent victims, and that corrup-

Escudero noted that Duterte and his police chiefs have not been sued before, leaving only lowly policemen facing cases and penalized for drug war-related deaths.

The Senate President pointed out that the difference between Duterte's statements before and at the Senate on Monday was that the latter were made under oath and can be used against him in court. "Karamihan naman ng sinabi niya kahapon, sinasabi din naman niya nung siya'y

Pangulo pa... Ang pinagkaiba kahapon lahat ng binitawan niyang salita ay under oath... 'Yun 'yung malaking pagkaiba," Escudero said.

Escudero said it will be hard for Duterte to retract or dismiss his statements as "jokes."

'DAMNING EVIDENCE' Meanwhile, human rights lawyer Chel Diokno stressed that Duterte's "shocking admission" to organizing a "Davao Death Squad" serves as "damning evidence" that

can be used against him in court.

"It is very damning evidence because he made those statements under oath and those are what we call extrajudicial admissions," Diokno said.

"That is coming from the horse's mouth. It is the best kind of evidence because it doesn't come from someone else. It came directly from the former President," he added.

Diokno also said Sen. Ronald "Bato" dela Rosa may

also be held liable for issuing Command Memorandum Circular 16-2016 on his first day as Philippine National Police (PNP) chief in 2016 that served as the basis for Project Double Barrel.

"If you look inside that circular, it repeatedly contains the command to negate and neutralize... When you give the police officers that kind of leeway to interpret a command in any way they can, that is giving them a blanket license to kill," he said.

Umaasa pa rin ang Philippine Hotel Owners Association (PHOA) na mapupuno pa rin ng mga bisita ang ilang mga tourist destination sa bansa ngayong panahon ng UNDAS. Ito ay kahit na dumaan ang bagyong Kristine sa bansa. Ayon kay PHOA Executive Director Benito Bengzon, na maaring magkaroon ng pagbaba ng bilang ng mga turista sa mga bahagi ng dinaanan ng bagyo.

Ang All Saint's Day kasi ay isa sa mga itinuturing ng mga hotel owners na 'peak season' sa bansa.

Mahigpit rin na binantaan ng heneral ang kanyang mga pulis na huwag panay gamit ng cellphone habang naka-duty hindi lang sa mga sementeryo subalit maging sa mga paliparan, puerto, public transport terminals at mismong mga simbahan.

Magugunitang nasa higit 200 sementeryo ang bibigyang seguridad ng pulisya, militar at force multipliers upang matiyak ang katiwasayan ng All Saints at All Souls Days.

Kinumpirma ng hydrology division ng bansa na nagpapatuloy ang pagpapakawala ng tubig tatlong pangunahing dam sa Luzon.

Ito ay dahil sa dami ng volume ng tubig ulan na ibinagsak ng bagyong Kristine nitong mga nakalipas na araw. Ayon sa ahensya, kabilang sa nagpapakawala ng tubig ay ang Ambuklao Dam at Binga Dam sa Benguet kabilang na ang Magat Dam sa Isabela.

Batay sa datos ng state weather bureau, binuksan ang dalawang gate sa Ambuklao at Binga Dam dahil hanggang sa ngayon ay naaabot na nito ang high water level ng dam. Samantala, isang gate naman sa Magat Dam ang binuksan at ito ay mayroong 2 meters opening. As of 8am ng umaga ngayong araw, abot sa 88.55 meters ang water level ng Magat Dam.

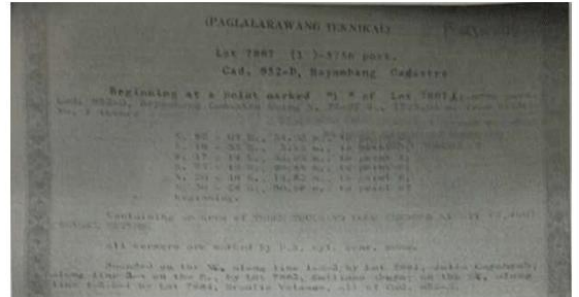
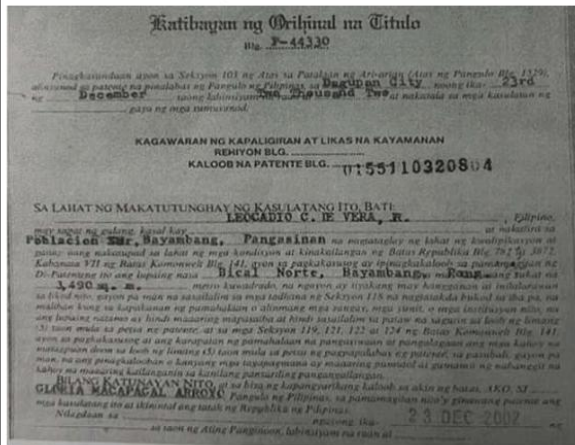

DSWD ready to release more food packs upon request of LGUs in storm-hit areas

DSWD Assistant Secretary Irene Dumlao on Monday said the agency has so far distributed over 609,000 family food packs to LGUs as part of their augmentation support.

The food packs contain 6 kilograms of rice, 10 assorted cans of food -- including corned beef, tuna flakes in oil, and sardines -- 5 sachets of instant coffee, and 5 sachets of choco malt, she said.

These can last for 2 to 3 days, and are good for a family of 5.

"Ang mga resources po ay nandyan. Makipag-ugnayan lang po sa mga lokal na pamahalaan para maging maayos iyon po pagpapahatid ng tulong, at maabutan po kayong assistance mula po sa ating pamahalaan," she said in a televised interview on state-run PTV-4.

Dumlao shared that they have also released non-food items, and cash relief assistance

and burial assistance under the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) program.

She explained that prior to the storm, food packs have already been prepositioned in various areas in the countries, and the agency responds to LGUs asking for additional help.

"Ongoing po rin iyang ating production sa ating national resource operation center at sa Visayas disaster response center para nasu-sustain iyon ating pagpapahatid ng tulong. Ibig sabihin, habang nagre-release tayo sa mga LGUs, may paparating pa na karagdagang food packs," she said.

"Meron pong mga nagsasakay na sa rubber boats, gayundin po ay mga trucks din po sila ginagamit para makapagpahatid ng tulong..."

House to house is one of the strategies that they are doing para talaga makapagpaabot

ng tulong," she added.

Dumlao said they are also looking into providing emergency cash transfer (ECT) or cash for work for typhoon-affected residents.

"Bahagi na rin ng ating early recovery under the Disaster Response Management ay iyon po emergency cash transfer o iyang pagsasagawa ng cash for work. Ito po ay mga tinitingnan nating interventions," she shared.

"And in close coordination with local government units ay titingnan pa natin kung paano ito mai-implement, and we will identify also the amount that will be released per beneficiary. That is, of course, based on the existing guidelines on the implementation of the ECT," she added.

The death toll from severe tropical storm Kristine has reached 116, the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council

(NDRRMC) said on Monday. At least 39 people are reported missing.

More than half a million families were affected, with 160 cities and towns declaring a state of calamity.

UNIFORMED PERSONNEL

The Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP), meanwhile, said it has been "extensive" in providing personnel and equipment in the ongoing disaster response.

AFP Spokesperson Colonel Francine Padilla said thousands were sent to storm-hit regions.

"At the onset, we have deployed 28 squads, around 1,409 teams, 3,176 assets from the Armed Forces of the Philippines, and the Bureau of Fire Protection kasama din natin iyan sa kanilang deployment," she disclosed.

"Currently, we have 2,695 search and rescue and retrieval (SRR) teams, and

around 4,914 SRR assets po natin na naka-standby, with 195 individuals successfully who have been rescuing dito sa CALABARZON and Region 5 areas," she added.

Padilla said the teams have been stationed in different

areas in the Bicol region, Eastern Visayas, and Southern Luzon.

They are focused on rescue efforts and in providing medical aid and relief supplies.

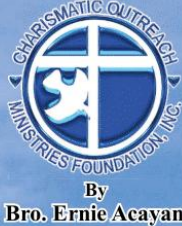

Grand slam from Fil-Am shortstop Volpe helps Yankees avoid World Series sweep

Volpe's third-inning blast gave the Yankees a 5-2 edge, their first lead since game one, and later homers by Gleyber Torres and Austin Wells sparked New York's rout.

"I pretty much blacked out as soon as I saw it go over the fence," Volpe said. "Everyone had confidence that someone was going to get the big hit... when the guys have confidence in you, I feel like you could do anything."

The Yankees pulled within 3-1 in the best-of-seven Major League Baseball championship showdown with game five on Wednesday at Yankee Stadium.

"We showed what we're

capable of doing as a team," Torres said. "We'll just try to continue that. Go tomorrow like there's no tomorrow."

No team has ever recovered from a 3-0 deficit to win the World Series, but the Yankees became the first team in 54 years to force a fifth game when down 0-3.

"It's going to take a lot," Wells said. "No one has done what we're trying to accomplish."

New York denied the Dodgers an eighth World Series title and first since 2020 while keeping alive hopes of the Yankees winning their first crown since 2009 and 28th overall. "It's good to have pressure," Wells said.



Anthony Volpe smashed a grand slam as the New York Yankees avoided being swept in the World Series on Tuesday with an 11-4 victory over the Los Angeles Dodgers.

"It means that we're in a good spot and people are counting on you, so I enjoy the pressure," Wells, 25, became the youngest Yankees catcher to homer in the World Series after going 4-for-43 in the playoffs previously.

"I just said screw it, we're down three and just went out there," Wells said. "I just blacked out. I don't really know what I did."

It was a record-shattering night for Los Angeles first baseman Freddie Freeman, who smashed a two-run homer in the first inning to become the first player with homers in the first four games of a World Series.

Freeman, who blasted a walk-off grand slam to win game one, also moved past George Springer to set a record with homers in six consecutive World Series contests, counting the last two games from his 2021 title run with Atlanta.

Mookie Betts doubled in the first inning and scored on Freeman's homer then made a great grab for an out in foul territory despite a Yankees fan trying to pull the ball out of his glove.

Volpe scored from third base in the second inning on Alex Verdugo's ground out but the best was yet to come.

- Yankees dominate late -

Wade won three NBA titles with the franchise during his tenure there, winning championships in 2006, 2012, and 2013. He also won the 2006 Finals MVP, and was a 13-time All-Star while he donned the Heat's colors.

These feats not only resulted in the No.3 Heat jersey of the 6-foot-4 guard out of Marquette to be retired by the organization, but it also made him the first-ever player of their franchise to have his own statue in their home arena.

"Who is that guy?" Wade added of the statue that was supposed to display his iconic "This is my house" celebration

after hitting a buzzer-beater against the Chicago Bulls for a 130-127 double overtime win on March 9, 2009.

However, while the statue was mimicking his hand gestures, NBA fans pointed out that its face shows little to no similarity to the Chicago native.

Still, D-Wadewas grateful for the historic gesture that his former squad did for him.

"That's beautiful. Personally, I think that it's one of the best statues that's been created because of what it represents. Man, I just have so many emotions," expounded Wade during the post-event press conference.

"Just sitting out there, in my mind, I'm like: 'What? Me?' I know it's bigger than me. This moment is way beyond just now, and way beyond the years that I will exist in life," he added.
