DOST NCR Launches Regional Science, Technology, and Innovation Week to Promote Green Economy Solutions in Metro Manila



Quezon City Mayor Hon. Maria Josefa "Joy" G. Belmonte welcomed participants, underscoring that this RSTW serves as a crucial platform for forward-thinking discussions on how science and technology should drive inclusive progress that uplifts all communities. DOST NCR Regional Director Engr. Romelen T. Tresvalles presented the region's achievements and unveiled future plans, with a highlight on the inauguration of the DOST NCR Innovation Hub (iHub).

DOST 1 empowers Community with Potable Water Solutions, deploys SAFEWATRS Technology in Umingan, Pangasinan

This initiative, under DOST's CEST Projects DANUM (Disinfecting Aqua's Noxious and Unwanted Microorganism) and NaKaSa-GaNa (Nagliliinang ng Kahandaan sa Sakuna Gamit ang Napapanahong Teknolohiya), aims to provide a reliable emergency potable water system to the community by equipping them with the latest technologies.

SAFEWATRS, formerly known as Up-EDS (Upgraded Emergency Disinfection System), is an innovative solar-powered water purification system developed by DOST-ITDI. It can produce up to 2,000 liters of safe drinking water within nine (9) hours of operation. This technology is designed to ensure access to clean water not only during emergencies such as floods, typhoons, and earthquakes but also in remote areas where potable water is scarce. By providing a reliable source of clean water, SAFEWATRS helps reduce the risk of water-borne diseases and promotes public health and safety in both crisis situations and everyday life.

The event, facilitated by DOST-ITDI experts Dante C. Vergara, Senior Science Research Specialist, Garry A. Diopol, and Marvin P. Mendoza, Science Research Specialists II, was attended by 26 participants from the

beneficiary barangay, accompanied by support staff from the Local Government Unit of Umingan, including Mr. Kenneth Estillero from the Mayor's Office and Mr. Kennedy L. Sonaco from the MDRMO. The program featured a comprehensive training session on the operation, maintenance, and benefits of the SAFEWATRS system.

The deployment of the SAFEWATRS Technology is expected to provide clean water to at least 25% of Brgy. Luna Weste's population, or approximately 200 residents. And to ensure its sustainability, the barangay plans to pass a resolution to cover the operational and maintenance costs of the system.

This initiative is part of DOST's ongoing commitment to empowering communities through science and technology, particularly those in remote areas with limited access to safe water. The successful deployment of SAFEWATRS marks a significant step in improving water access and ensuring public health in the community. DOST I will continue to monitor the system and explore further science and technology collaborations to uplift communities across the region. (Cecilio R. Repanco and Geambay D. Morata)

To provide a reliable emergency potable water system, the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) Region I, through its Provincial Science and Technology Office (PSTO) Pangasinan, in collaboration with DOST-Industrial Technology Development Institute (DOST-ITDI), deployed SAFEWATRS Technology on October 2-3, 2024 at the Community Empowerment thru Science & Technology (CEST) Program beneficiary in Brgy. Luna Weste, Umingan, Pangasinan.

This newly launched iHub will serve as a dynamic space for nurturing transformative ideas and innovations that can significantly impact communities, aligning with Metro Manila's push toward sustainable urban development.

Dr. Renato U. Solidum Jr., Secretary of the Department of Science and Technology, delivered the keynote, reflecting on Typhoon Kristine's recent impact and advocating for a redefined resilience through S&T. Dr. Solidum highlighted the role of local government units (LGUs) in adopting technology to enhance sustainable practices and green development. "Development is a continued series of structural transformations," he noted, adding that RSTW's focus on green technologies is a call to action to incorporate these advancements into enterprises,

communities, and homes.

The event also featured several notable activities, including the signing of memoranda of understanding (MOUs) between DOST NCR and partners such as PIA-NCR, TESDA-RTC NCR, and The Filipinos Word, aimed at fostering STI-driven partnerships. The ceremonial launch of DOST NCR's STI Plan for Quezon City further underscored the collaborative efforts toward sustainable urban transformation.

Pondo ng Philhealth, sayang kung dadagdagan at hindi naman ito nagagamit nang lubusan – Escudero

Sayang daw kung dadagdagan ang pondo ng Philippine Health Insurance Corporation o Philhealth sa susunod na taon kung hindi naman ito nagagamit nang lubusan.

Tugon ito ni Senate President Francis "Chiz" Escudero kung saan dapat na masagot at mabigyang linaw ang sobrang pondo ng Philhealth samantalang ang daming mga Pilipino ang hindi nakikinabang sa mga benepisyo nito. Ayon pa kay Escudero, kung bigong magamit nang lubusan ng Philhealth ang mga pondo nito at mawalan ng bilyon-bilyong piso kada taon ang mga taxpayers dahil sa inflation, ay dapat gumawa ng paraan ang gobyerno kung papaano mailalaan ang scarce financial resources, particular na sa gitna nang matinding hamon ng pana-

hon na nagdudulot ng pinsala sa ekonomiya. Aniya, inflation pa lamang ay tala na ang bansa. Limang daang bilyon ang sobrang pondo ng PhilHealth sa ngayon at sa four percent inflation, nangangahulugan, nawawalan ng P20 billion ang PhilHealth kada taon na hindi binibigay na serbisyo sa mga Pilipino dahil hindi nila aniya ginastos ang pera. Ipinunto pa ni Escudero na ang P20 bilyon na nawala ay maaaring gamitin para sa iba pang pangangailangan ng bansa. Ayon kay Escudero, may mga agency programs at projects na kailangang unahin at pag-aralan habang tinutugunan ng Senado ang P6.352 trillion national budget, kabilang ang flood control initiatives kasunod ng pagbaha sa Bicol region dulot ng Severe Tropical Storm Kristine.

Luistro flags P10.4 million 'unaccounted' DepEd confidential funds



Batangas 2nd District Representative Gerville Luistro has flagged P10.4 million worth of confidential funds left unaccounted for by the Department of Education under then Secretary and Vice President Sara Duterte.

Dynamic Learning Program, ilulunsad para sa mga klaseng nakakansela dahil sa bagyo-DepEd

Inanunsiyo ng Department of Education (DepEd) na ilalabas ngayong buwan ang kanilang bagong programa na Dynamic Learning Program (DLP). Naglalaman itong maiwasan ang pagkawala ng pagkatuto ng mga estudyante dahil na rin sa mga sunod-sunod na pagkakansela

ng mga klase dahil sa mga bagyo. Ang Dynamic Learning Program (DLP) ay magbibigay sa mga paaralan ng flexibility para sa mga gagawing make-up classes. Gagamitin ang programa na ito ng mga simpleng activity sheets.

Ang pagkakaroon ng par-

allel classes, activity-based engagements, at learners' portfolios na may kakaunting homework loads ang tataglayin ng naturang programa.

Dagdag pa ng ahensya na nais nila itong simulan sa mga paaralan ng Ilocos, Cagayan Valley, Central Luzon, Calabarzon, Bicol, at Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) dahil sa mga nagdaang bagyo, ang mga lugar na ito ang lubhang naapektuhan pagdating sa pagkakansela ng mga klase.

In a House Committee on Good Government and Public Accountability hearing on Tuesday, Luistro said the amount is part of the P15 million confidential funds supposedly allocated for youth leadership summits and information education campaigns.

The Batangas congresswoman said certifications provided to the Commission on Audit that show only P4.2 million has been liquidated, covering only one of four DepEd programs.

"Ang total expenditures po ng counterinsurgency program is only P4.050 million when the amount utilized is P15.540 million. Mayroon pong nawawala P10.490 million. Saan po kaya napunta itong deperensya ng nasabing amount," she said.

The DepEd's confidential funds were allocated for programs on counterinsurgency, abuse prevention and control within schools, anti-illegal activities operation and anti-extremism efforts.

However, the COA confirmed to the lawmaker that the youth leadership summits and information education campaigns are under the DepEd's counterinsurgency program, seeking to prevent the recruitment of teachers and students.

"We considered the entirety since ang sabi naman po focused on protecting the schools and youth from physical harm, criminality and abuse. So hindi na lang po sa counterinsurgency," Atty. Gloria Camora of the COA Intelligence and Confidential Funds Office said.

"The fund was used for payment of rewards po in relation to these four programs," she added.

Luistro pointed out that expenditures on the three other programs remained unaccounted for.

She also questioned why the certifications that aimed to explain the P15.54

million disallowance lacked the necessary details.

COA said additional purposes are the youth leadership summits that include lectures on drug abuse and other crimes, but were not specific.

"Are you not particular about defining saang programa ito nakapaloob? How are you able to account for the expenditures if you are not even aware of where each DepEd's activity falls under?," Rep. Luistro responded.

In a previous hearing, the Philippine Army said it did not receive nor use DepEd funds in conducting the youth leadership summits.

Camora said the supposed unaccounted funds were listed as "other purposes" in two certifications, but no specific amount was indicated in both.

Luistro urged COA to review its auditing so it can identify how much was spent on each specific program.

The Batangas congresswoman asked whether COA checked if the payment of rewards to informants is consistent with the location of the youth leadership summits and information education campaigns.

"Yung location ng YLS or EIC is based on the certification po, these are the areas covered po ng activities. On the other hand po yung payment of rewards, pwede pong nasa ibang lugar or address po niya yun. We don't inquire beyond that," Camora responded.

"What is consistent with respect to their location is equivalent only to the amount of P4.2 million. So there remains also an unexplained amount of P10.4 million," Rep. Luistro said.

MALVERSATION, BREACH OF PUBLIC TRUST?

Based on the findings during the House hearing, Luistro believes there is

basis for charges of malversation of public funds and breach of public trust.

"So, where is this amount now? In conclusion, I wish to believe that the confidential fund of the Department of Education was not properly recorded at its best, or misspent or misappropriated at its worst," she said.

"It is the humble submission of this representation that there is a prima facie case of malversation and, in addition an apparent case of breach of public trust," Luistro added.

The Batangas congresswoman cited the four elements of malversation: the individual is a public official, the person is in custody of the fund, the money is for a public purpose and the public official took, misappropriated or misused the funds.

"Malversation can be done intentionally. We call it 'dolo', which is with criminal intent. And it can be done as well by negligence. We call it 'culpa' or by negligence. In other words, with or without criminal intent," Luistro explained.

"If the four elements are present, which I believe they are, there is prima facie case of malversation. With respect to the breach of public trust, this is violation of public's confidence in a public officer's ability to serve with integrity, impartiality and in accordance with law," she added.

The House panel's chairperson Manila Rep. Joel Chua earlier said the potential misuse of funds, particularly graft and corruption and betrayal of public trust, could be grounds for Duterte's impeachment.

The Office of the Vice President has yet to issue comment on the issue.

Duterte earlier denied alleged misuse of the agency's confidential funds.

Nakadagdag rin ang koleksyon mula sa Law Enforcement and Traffic Adjudication System na umabot sa P68,299,455 at Motor Vehicle Inspection Center na pumalo sa P12,841,490.

Tiniyak naman ni LTO-NCR Regional Director Roque "Rox" I. Verzoza III na mamantine nila ang mataas na revenue collection para sa natitirang buwan sa taong ito.

Marcos Jr. skirts ques-

tions on Sara Duterte's comments on his leadership. When asked for comment on the attacks of Duterte, Marcos said she would rather move on from it. "Wala, matalaga na 'yun, panis na eh kaya okay na. Tuloy na tayo magtrabaho. Kaya nga sinasabi ko ayokong may alyansa alyan-

sa, papanig sa isa laban dun sa isa, makikipag-bunuan, ayokong makipag-away ang dami dami pang trabaho," the senator said. Philippine politics has long been dominated by wealthy families who form and break coalitions depending on their interests.

VP Duterte says Marcos

'does not know how to be president' Sen. Marcos added that she did not get upset with Duterte for saying her brother does not know how to be a president nor for threatening to dig up Ferdinand Marcos Sr.'s remains at the Libingan ng mga Bayani if "political attacks" continue.



Sen. Imee Marcos' friendship with Vice President Sara Duterte remains intact despite the latter's recent tirades against President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. and remark that she will exhume the remains of the Marcos patriarch, the President's sister said.

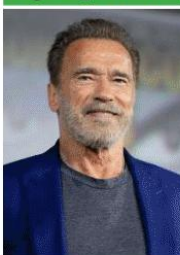

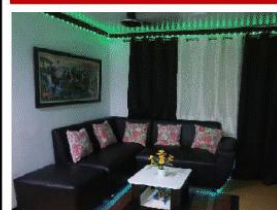

Gauff beats Swiatek at WTA Finals as Sabalenka earns year-end No.1



Coco Gauff posted a rare victory over Iga Swiatek to punch her ticket to the semi-finals of the WTA Finals in Riyadh on Tuesday, ensuring Aryna Sabalenka will finish the year as the world number one.

Faker's T1 retain League of Legends world title

The teams were locked at 2-2 at a packed O2 arena but T1 clinched game five to make it back to back titles after nearly four hours of tense action.

China's BLG started strongly, taking the first game before T1 struck back to level.

The Chinese team pulled ahead again at 2-1 only for their opponents to hit back again and go on to take the decider.

Faker, who won the MVP award, was asked what message he would send to himself from 11 years ago, when he clinched his first world title.

His response was just: "Have fun."

For the third year in a row the five players in the team were the same -- Zeus, Oner, Gumayusi and Keria accompanying Faker.

The 28-year-old, whose real name is Lee Sang-hyeok, is a multi-millionaire esports superstar in South Korea, who has been given the title of "national treasure."

Even though the match started around midnight in South Korea due to the time difference, hundreds of dedicated T1 fans gathered at LoL Park, an eSports venue in central Seoul, to cheer on their beloved team.

The crowd erupted in cheers when Faker appeared on the screen.

"T1 is the most special team because it makes things happen when everyone else says it's impossible," said Lee Pari, a T1 fan.

Hundreds of Chinese fans arrived early for a watch party in a shopping mall in Beijing.

Cosplayers dressed as characters from the game posed for photos on the steps leading to the entrance.

Inside, fans were packed shoulder to shoulder an hour before the first round.

Cheers filled the room when BLG players appeared on the screen, and periodic chants of "BLG! BLG!" rang through the mall.

Speaking after the match, 19-year-old student Du Zhaoyan said he had not expected to BLG to lose.

"I thought they could win and I wasn't planning on going back to school tonight," he said.

"I was going to go out for a drink with people who were also watching the game tonight and stay out until sunrise before going back to school. So now it feels a bit depressing to leave."

But engineer Zhao Lingling, 26, said she was a Faker fan.

"I'm very happy to see him win his fifth championship," she said. "He played very well tonight and his fourth game was very impressive. (China's) Bin also played very well. I hope to see Faker again in Chengdu next year."

The goal in League of Legends, which pits two teams of five against each other, is to destroy the enemy's base, known as the Nexus.

South Korea have traditionally been a League of Legends powerhouse but in recent years Chinese teams have been growing stronger.



South Korean giants T1, led by "Faker", won their fifth League of Legends world championship crown in London on Saturday, beating China's Bilibili Gaming in a thrilling final.

Swiatek, the defending champion, was in a direct battle with Sabalenka for the top spot this week but needed a win over Gauff to keep her chances alive of leapfrogging her Belarusian rival.

Gauff, 20, entered the contest having lost 11 of her 12 previous meetings with Swiatek, with the American's sole victory coming in Cincinnati last year.

But she turned the tables on Swiatek on Tuesday, defeating the second seed 6-3, 6-4 to make it two straight-sets wins from two round-robin matches in Riyadh this week.

"It feels great. I knew going into the match that despite our head-to-head I had a lot of confidence going in," said Gauff, who hit 11 double faults during the one-hour 48-minute showdown.

With the exception of the opening game of the match, Gauff had break point opportunities in every Swiatek service game in the first set.

The American third seed made her move in game seven, breaking for 4-3, and she closed out the set with a second break of serve, taking the lead in 49 minutes.

Swiatek needed six break points in a marathon third game of the second set to finally take down the Gauff serve but she couldn't consolidate her advantage.

They traded breaks again, as Gauff's double-fault tally went up to double digits and Swiatek racked up the errors.

It was Gauff who eventually steadied the ship, and wrapped up the victory on Swiatek's 47th unforced error of the match.

Swiatek, a five-time major champion, admits her two-month break between the US Open and the WTA Finals and the fact she is playing her first tournament with her new coach Wim Fissette have made things "a bit more tricky and different than usual".

"But I'll force myself to work even better in the next match," the Pole added.

- Krejickova eliminates Pegula -

Earlier in the day Barbora Krejickova ended Jessica Pegula's chances of qualifying for the semi-finals, defeating the sixth-seeded American 6-3, 6-3.

A runner-up at the WTA Finals last year, Pegula suffered her second straight-sets defeat of the week and entered her final round-robin match against Swiatek on Thursday anchoring the Orange Group with zero sets won.

Eighth-seeded Krejickova bounced back from her opening loss to Swiatek to keep her hopes of making the final four alive.

"I was fighting for every ball and I felt that I really have to play my best tennis and I was trying to be really solid and trying to put as many balls to the other side as I could," said Krejickova, who picked up just her 20th match win of the season.

"I'm definitely proud. I had some very high parts of the season, especially winning Wimbledon, that's something indescribable. And being here in the Finals is a huge privilege. It's nice to get the win and still be part of the event."

Despite being ranked number 13 in the world, Krejickova qualified for these WTA Finals thanks to a new rule introduced by the WTA that gave priority to a player who has won a Grand Slam this season, while maintaining a ranking between 9 and 20, over a player ranked number eight in the Race.

As the reigning Wimbledon champion, Krejickova claimed the final qualifying spot in Riyadh over world number eight Emma Navarro.

Krejickova squandered a 6-4, 3-0 lead against Swiatek in her opener two days ago and made sure there was no repeat scenario against Pegula on Tuesday.

The crafty Czech fired 11 aces and broke Pegula four times to wrap up the win in 69 minutes.

Both Krejickova and Swiatek will have to wait until Thursday's matches to learn their qualification fate in Riyadh.
