Tabaog, Regional Director of the Department of Science and Technology Region 1 and a member of the National GAD Resource Program (NGRP), recently led a series of comprehensive training sessions on Gender Sensitivity and Gender Mainstreaming at Ilocos Sur Polytechnic State College (ISPSC).

Duterte tells ICC to 'hurry up' with probe: 'Baka mamatay na ako'

Former President Rodrigo Duterte on Wednesday said he was asking the International Criminal Court — whose jurisdiction his administration and the current Marcos Jr. administration do not recognize — to rush its investigation into his war on drugs over alleged crimes against humanity.

Duterte said this during the House quad committee inquiry on Wednesday where he finally showed up after skipping previous invitations.

When asked by Gabriela Party-list Rep. Arlene Brosas whether or not he was willing to cooperate with the ICC investigation, he said, "I am asking the ICC to hurry up and if possible, they can come here and start the investigation tomorrow."

Duterte, 79, claimed that the "issue has been left hanging for so many years... Baka mamatay na ako, hindi na nila ako ma-imbestiga."

"So, I am asking the ICC, through you, na magpunta na sila dito, bukas. Umpisahan na sila ang investigation (They should come here at once, tomorrow. They should start their investigation). If I am found guilty I will go to prison and rot there for all time," he added.

Asked to clarify if this meant he would cooperate with the tribunal, Duterte said, "The ICC does not scare me a bit. They can come here anytime... Wala naman tayong taguan. Ang sinabi ko, ang ginawa ko, I did it for

my country and for the young people, no excuses, no apology. I got to hell, so be it."

"Bigyan mo ako ng pera, ako na pumunta ng ICC doon, ako na mismo magpaimbestiga doon," he said.

The International Criminal Court in The Hague is currently investigating Duterte's war on drugs and the alleged Davao Death Squad for possible crimes against humanity.

The government has taken the position that it will not cooperate with the ICC, which the Philippines left in 2019 because of its preliminary inquiry into the drug war.

But the Marcos Jr. administration also said that it would not prevent the ICC from getting statements and information and setting interviews with potential resource persons.



These sessions were held across the Sta. Maria, Candon, Narvacan, Cervantes, Santiago, and Tagudin campuses on September 27, October 18, 28, and 29, 2024, aimed to build a more inclusive, gender-responsive culture in both academic and workplace settings. In her role as a member of the ISPSC Board of Regents, Dr. Tabaog shared valuable insights on integrating Gender and Development (GAD) principles into academic institutions, inspiring ISPSC faculty and staff to advance gender equity within their professional roles and campus communities. Her expertise highlighted practical strategies for effective gender mainstreaming, empowering participants to promote an inclusive and respectful environment across all ISPSC campuses.

The first two sessions were held at the ISPSC Sta. Maria Campus focused on Gender Sensitivity Training for faculty and non-teaching personnel. Dr. Tabaog's presentation covered foundational gender concepts, the distinctions between sex and gender, and the impact of social institutions on gender perceptions. She also introduced participants to the differences between equality and equity, emphasizing the importance of fostering an environment that recognizes and respects these distinctions. Through hands-on activities and group discussions, participants engaged in an in-depth examination of gender roles and stereotypes and explored

strategies for minimizing biases in workplace interactions.

The subsequent Gender Mainstreaming in the Workplace seminars, held at ISPSC's Main Campus, targeted faculty and non-teaching staff from other five campuses. Dr. Tabaog introduced participants to the principles of gender mainstreaming, focusing on how GAD initiatives could be systematically integrated into institutional policies and practices. She provided a practical framework for advancing gender sensitivity across campuses covering the four key entry points for gender mainstreaming. In addition, she led discussions on Women's Economic Empowerment, underscoring the importance of equitable practices in creating gender parity, particularly in leadership roles and Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) fields.

The training sessions were lauded as an enlightening experience for many participants. Through interactive workshops, real-life examples, and engaging activities, participants enhanced their understanding of gender issues and renewed their commitment to promoting a more inclusive, equitable environment at ISPSC. Supported by the ISPSC administration and led by Dr. Tabaog's expertise, these trainings mark a significant step forward in ISPSC's dedication to gender equality and inclusivity in education.

House Quad Comm moves resumption of hearing to Nov 21

House Quad Comm lead co-chairperson Rep. Robert Ace Barbers said the verification of the credibility of individuals volunteering to testify in the hearings prompted the mega-panel to reschedule the November 13 hearing to November 21.

"Because of the several witnesses who wanted to give their testimony before the Quad Comm, we decided that we should maybe interview them first. Tingnan namin sino 'yung mas credible doon and it will take a lot of time para sa amin," Barbers explained.

Despite the cancellation of the Wednesday hearing, former Presidential spokesperson Atty. Salvador Panelo said former president Rodrigo Duterte will go to the House of Representatives to "confront" Quad Comm members over the changes in the hearing schedule allegedly without prior notice.

Panelo said Duterte accepted the mega-panel's invitation for the November 13 hearing, and even came to Manila on Monday night.

"(Former) PRRD (President Rodrigo Roa Duterte) and I will go to Batasang Pambansa tomorrow at 10:00am and confront the Quad Committee members why after demanding his presence and

accepting their invitation and coming here last night, they will just cancel it without prior notice," Panelo said.

"He will ask them to schedule a marathon hearing of 10 days," he added.

But Quad Comm leaders said the panel notified Duterte and his counsel, Atty. Martin Delgra III, regarding the hearing schedule on Monday Night. Barbers added that as of Tuesday noon, they have yet to receive formal communication from Duterte's camp, expressing the former President's intent to attend the November 13 hearing.

"Wala pong naduduwag dito. Para malinaw, sa (November) 21 mayroon kaming hearing. Punta ho tayo dito. Pagkatapos ng 21, let us know kung kailan kayo pwede. Because we will schedule another Quad Comm hearing on the date convenient for you, on the date na gusto ninyo," Barbers said. "I-formalize lahat.

Kasi 'pag sa social media tayo nagsagutan, I think it will not be proper, at maliligaw tayo. 'Yan, nagpo-pronounce sila that they will be attending. And it's not even coming from the President... We are governed by the rules of the committee," Quad Comm Co-Chair Rep. Dan Fernandez added.

The House Quad Comm

previously sent invitations to Duterte, but in an October 21 letter, his counsel said the former president was not feeling well and in need of rest.

In another letter last November 5, Delgra said Duterte could not attend the November 7 hearing, because he was doubtful of the Quad Comm's integrity. Some lawmakers also expressed their criticisms against Duterte, saying the statement that he will confront the Quad Comm was just "another publicity stunt".

"Alam niya at pormal siyang na-inform na walang hearing bukas, ngunit nagbalak pa rin siyang pumunta para magpapasin at mangulo. Isa na namang publicity stunt ito mula sa dating pangulo... Gusto niyang palabasin na ang House ang umuunong sa imbestigasyon. Gayong siya mismo ang patuloy na umiwas sa accountability," Gabriela Party List Rep. Arlene Brosas said.

"Nagba-bluff ka ba? Hindi ka namin uurungan," ACT Teachers Party List Rep. France Castro told Duterte.

"Propaganda lang 'yung ginagawa nila, lalo na 'yung sinasabing pag-attend sa hearing ng Quad Comm. Talagang nabubudol-budol 'yung ating mga mamamayan," House Assistant Majority Leader Rep. Jefferson Khonghun

said.

Moreover, several lawmakers stated willingness to chip in to cover Duterte's airfare and accommodation, in order to help eliminate the financial obstacles the former president previously mentioned for skipping the Quad Comm hearings.

Garma's departure

On former police officer Royina Garma's reported departure from the Philippines, Barbers said he was unaware of it, but the Quad Comm previously notified Garma to attend if she will be needed in succeeding hearings.

"We have no idea kung nasa bansa ba o nakaalis na. I have no information... We advised them on the kapag kailangan sila ay kailangan mag-attend sila. Pero so far nag-move forward na tayo ng topic. Tapos na tayo doon sa Barayuga case somehow," he said. "Yung witnesses na hinirap sa kasong 'yan ay nakapagbigay na sila ng salaysay at na-record na ng ating DOJ... If there are any other witness that will come out and again perhaps mention the names of these personalities, then we will have to invite them, so that bigyan din sila ng pagkakataon na magkaharap sila: 'Yung nag-aakusa at 'yung inaaakusahan,' Barbers added.

naliwanag ni Meralco Vice President and Head of Corporate Communications, Joe Zaldarriaga, na ang dagdag singil ay dahil sa mas mataas na singil ng generation at transmission charges ng kanilang electricity supplier.

Dagdag pa nito, tumaas din daw ang charge sa kanila ng Independent Power Producers (IPPs) na tumaas ng P0.9392 kWh habang ang Power Supply Agree-

ments naman ay umakyat sa P0.4295. Dahil aniya dito, papatak ng P85 maginging increase sa mothly bill ng isang pamilya na kumokonsumo ng 200kWh. Filipina fighter Islay Erika Bomogao gave herself passing marks after a successful debut in ONE Championship this past weekend. The 24-year-old Bomogao dominated Japanese striker Fui in their 100-pound catchweight Muay Thai bout at ONE Friday Fights 86 on November 8, where she took her first win inside Lumpinee Stadium in Bangkok, Thailand.

"I'm happy that I was able to show new tricks, tricks that aren't usually seen in Muay Thai. I was throwing hook kicks," said Bomogao, who was among the several Filipino fighters in action last weekend in Thailand.

"I wanted to show that Muay Thai is so much more than roundhouse kicks, teeps, punches and elbows. We can be creative as well and put on new moves; that's what I'm happy about," she added.

While she leaves the full assessment of her performance to her coaches, Bomogao is happy that she was able to execute her game plan, despite coming in with plenty of hype -- and pressure.

"Personally, I think it was a good performance. I think I was able to execute my game plan, control her with my teeps, use my boxing, and move around. But the overall assessment would be really up to my coaches, because

they're the ones who are really watching," she said.

Still, the Filipina knows that there is room for improvement. In particular, she is not satisfied with her defense against Fui and believes she could have done a better job with her offense.

"For improvement, I feel like I need more head movement. I was getting hit a couple of times. I'm gonna work on that with my team," she said. "Then more straight combinations, not just one-two. I have to string more [together]. Maybe I have to put together strikes in one go."

Aside from Bomogao,

also triumphant last weekend was Filipino-American fighter Jackie Buntan, who pulled off an upset of Anissa "C18" Meksen to win the inaugural ONE Women's Strawweight Kickboxing World Title at ONE 169. Meanwhile, Fritz Biagtan came through with a unanimous decision win against Seydeli Asli, while Carlos Alvarez pulled off a second round stoppage of Mirza Aliev.

It was not a clean sweep for Filipinos, however, as Danny Kingad absorbed another loss at the hands of Adriano Moraes in a fly-weight bout.
