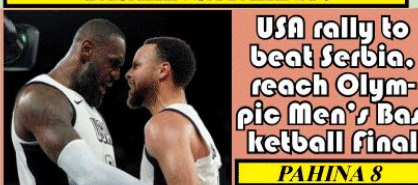

Marcoleta's Investigation on Offshore Accounts Cast Doubt on Comelec Chairman Ahead of Elections Manila, August 1, 2024

In a detailed press conference, Marcoleta explained that his verification team, with international volunteers' assistance, confirmed these offshore accounts' existence. A volunteer from New York deposited \$100 into two accounts under the name George Erwin Mojica Garcia in the Cayman Islands, conclusively verifying their existence. This revelation comes after Garcia had consistently denied having any offshore accounts.

Marcoleta further detailed that Garcia had issued a waiver of bank deposits to the Anti-Money Laundering Council (AMLC) and the National Bureau of Investigation (NBI). Still, no reports have been forthcoming from these agencies. Due to the lack of response, Marcoleta and his team took it upon themselves to investigate. He noted that, following a press release on June 26 highlighting these allegations, the accounts were closed between June 28 and July 15, with transactions transferred to accounts with foreign-sounding names. This swift closure of accounts and transfer of funds heightened Marcoleta's suspicions.

Chairman Garcia had previously dismissed the allegations as a "demolition job," but Marcoleta argued that the closure of accounts suggests otherwise. He emphasized that without a basis for the claims, there would be no need for such drastic measures. The implications of these actions are serious, potentially undermining public confidence in the electoral process.

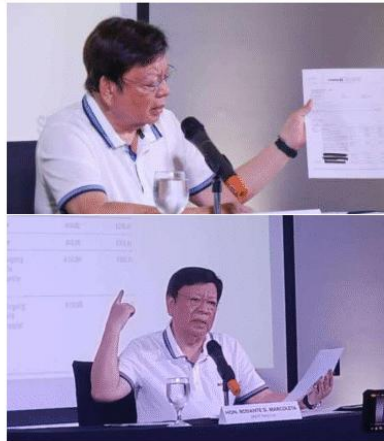
Marcoleta stressed the importance of investigating these allegations to ensure the integrity of the upcoming elections.

He argued that the credibility of the electoral process is at stake and that a clean, orderly, and true conduct of elections is essential for the democratic rights of Filipinos. Instead of pursuing an impeachment process, which would be lengthy and potentially unresolved by the time of the elections, Marcoleta has filed a House Resolution to initiate a comprehensive and expedited investigation into these accounts.

He called for a swift and thorough investigation by the House of Representatives to verify Garcia's claims and to determine if the Chairman should remain in his position to oversee the elections. Marcoleta highlighted that if these allegations are substantiated, it could have far-reaching consequences for the credibility of the Comelec and the upcoming national elections.

Marcoleta also addressed the procurement of the MIRU system, questioning its reliability and the potential impact on the elections. He suggested that existing ballot-counting machines could suffice and emphasized the need for transparency in the electoral process.

In conclusion, Marcoleta urged the public to stay vigilant and informed as the investigation unfolds. He reiterated his commitment to transparency and accountability in governance, emphasizing that the integrity of the electoral process is paramount. The outcome of this investigation will be crucial in maintaining public trust in the elections and ensuring that Filipinos can freely and fairly choose their leaders.

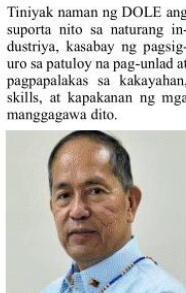

In a recent nationwide survey conducted by Social Weather Stations (SWS) from July 6-12, 2024, Erwin Tulfo has emerged as the leading senatorial candidate for the 2025 elections.

LTRFB, nagpaabot ng pasasalamat kay PBBM dahil sa pagsuporta PUVMP



Pinasalaman ng Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board si Pangulong Ferdinand Marcos Jr. dahil sa ipinakita nitong suporta patuloy na implementasyon ng Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program.

Ayon kay LTRFB chairperson Teofilo Guadiz III, ang pagsuporta ni PBBM sa naturang programa ay nagpakita lamang ng importansya na inordemisa ang public transportation system ng bansa.

Ginawa ni Guadiz ang naturang pahayag matapos na sabihin ni PBBM na hindi siya sumasang ayon na ipagpaliban ang pagpapatupad ng programa para isaialam sa paa-aaral.

Sinabi ni Marcos na hindi minamadali ang programa habang idiniin na pitong beses na itong ipinagpaliban.

Ang PUV Modernization Program ay kasalukuyang tumutuo sa route rationaliza-

tion phase matapos ang deadline para sa konsolidasyon ng mga operator sa alinman sa isang kooperatiba o isang korporasyon ay natapos noong Abril 30 ngayong taon.

Mula noong 2018, ipinaliwanag ni Transportation Secretary Jaime J. Bautista na gumastos na ang gobyerno ng 53 porsiyento ng kabuuang P7.5 billion na inilaan para sa pagpapatupad ng programa, kabilang ang P1.6 bilyon na inilaan para sa PUV Modernization para sa taong ito.

Sa pagtutok ngayon sa rationalization ng ruta, sinabi ng DOTR na may kabuuang 6,090 ruta ang pinagsama-sama mula noong Abril

30 habang 71 porsiyento ng kabuuang 1,574 na local government units sa buong bansa ang nakapagsumite na ng Local Public Transport Route Plan. Ang Local Public Transport Route Plan ay isang plano na nagdedetalye ng network ng ruta, mode, at kinakailangang bilang ng mga yunit sa bawat mode para sa paghahatid ng public land transport.

Noong Abril 30, umabot sa 83.38 porsiyento ang nationwide consolidation kung saan ang DOTR's Office of Transport Cooperatives ay nag-accredit sa 1,781 na kooperatiba na may 262,870 miyembro.

Marcos urged to reject calls to suspend PUV modernization program

Members of modern jeepney cooperatives, led by the Angat Kooperatiba at Korporasyon ng Alyansang Pilipino (AK-KAP MO), hold a program near the Mendiola Peace Arch in Manila as part of a Unity Walk supporting the Public Utility Vehicle modernization program on August 5, 2024. The group of modern jeepney drivers and operators urged President Marcos to reject proposals to temporarily suspend the implementation of the Public Transport Modernization Program (PTMP) following the filing of Senate Resolution No. 1096, signed by 22 senators, calling for a thorough review of the program's implementation.



The survey, with a margin of error of +/- 3 percent, provides a snapshot of voter preferences across the Philippines as the country prepares for the upcoming senatorial race.

The most crucial attribute, according to the survey, is having a "heart for the poor," highlighting the electorate's desire for leaders who demonstrate empathy and a commitment to addressing the needs of the marginalized.

Erwin Tulfo's strong performance in the survey underscores his deep connection with the public, largely attributed to his advocacy work and prominent media presence. The presence of seasoned politicians like Tito Sotto, Ping Lacson, and Imee Marcos suggests that experience and established political

careers continue to be significant factors for voters.

Paolo Duterte's position in the top five reflects his family's ongoing influence in Philippine politics, while Congressman Dante Marcoleta's high ranking points to his growing prominence in the political landscape.

The survey also reveals a diverse array of candidates, including veteran politicians such as Pia Cayetano and Francis Tolentino, alongside well-known personalities like Manny Pacquiao and Willie Ong. This diversity reflects a broad spectrum of support across various sectors of society.

As the election season approaches, the emphasis on candidates with a "heart for the poor" indicates a shift in voter priorities towards compassionate and socially responsible leadership. This trend is expected to shape campaign strategies and voter engagement efforts in the months ahead.

The SWS survey offers valuable insights into current voter preferences, setting the stage for a dynamic and competitive senatorial race. The focus on empathy and social responsibility among candidates may signal a new direction in the political landscape, where the welfare of the Filipino people takes center stage.

DA Sec. Laurel Jr., pinapasilip sa SRA ang aktwal na volume ng mga sugar products na pumapasok sa Pilipinas



Ipinag-utos na ni Department of Agriculture Secretary Francisco Tiu Laurel Jr. sa Sugar Regulatory Administration (SRA) ang pag-imbestiga sa aktwal na volume ng iba't-ibang mga produktong asukal na pumapasok sa Pilipinas. Maliban sa mismong asukal, pinapa-imbestigahan ng kalihim ang iba pang sugar products na kinabibilangan ng glucose, sucrose, dextrose, maltodextrin at lactose.

Ginawa ng kalihim ang nasabing kautusan kasabay na rin ng naunang reklamo ng United Sugar Producers Federation (UNIFED) ukol sa umano'y nakakaalamang bultong ng asukal at mga sugar premix na pumapasok sa bansa. Ayon sa grupo, umaabot mula 200,000 hanggang 300,000 metrikong tonelada ang nakakapasok dito kada taon na kalimitan umanong ipinupuslit.

Batay sa naging kautusan ni Sec. Tiu-Laurel Jr, kailangang tukuyin at aralin ng SRA ang tungkol sa naturang usapin at alamin kung kailangang kumuha ng clearance para rito. Katwiran naman ni UNIFED President Manuel Lamata, ang bulto ng mga sugar premix na pumapasok sa bansa ay representasyon ng hanggang 4 million sako ng asukal at tinatayang nagkakahalaga ng P10 billion. Ang kawalan aniya ng regulasyon para sa mga naturang produkto ay nakakasira sa sugar industry ng bansa.

Garcia vs Marcoleta: Comelec chief mulls ethics raps against lawmaker over 'demolition job'



Will Commission on Elections (Comelec) chairman George Garcia file an ethics complaint against his former client Sagip party-list Rep. Rodante Marcoleta over his bribery accusations?

On Thursday, Garcia and other Comelec officials held a press conference to bare the "foreign entity" and individuals behind what they believed was a "well-oiled" demolition campaign against the poll body.

According to Garcia, he was just awaiting the result of the National Bureau of Investigation (NBI) probe into his alleged offshore accounts.

"Kapag po lumabas na yung sa NBI... Kasi po yung findings ng isang ahensya katulad po ng sa NBI ay credible, mapagkatiwalaan at talagang produkto ng pinagsama-samang imbestigasyon ng lahat ng mga dokumento," Garcia said.

Marcoleta previously linked Garcia to offshore accounts, and called for a House probe into alleged deposits made by a "high-ranking Comelec official" for possible violation of the Anti-Graft and Corrupt Practices Act.

In response, Garcia last month gave the NBI an absolute waiver to investigate the claims of Marcoleta that he has offshore accounts, supposedly to hide bribe money from Comelec's new contractor.

"Kasi sa bandang huli kinakailangan ng remedyo para sa mga nangyayari. Lalo na po yung mga pamemeke, pagpa-falsify ng mga dokumento... Hindi naman

po porke may kapangyarihan kapag nameke okay lang," Garcia said.

MARCOLETA REACTS

Responding to the possible ethics complaint against him, Marcoleta said: "We're in a democracy."

"Kung mayroon siyang ground na mag-file ng ethics complaint, kung palagay niya tama ang gagawin niya, we're in a democracy. Why don't he do it?" Marcoleta told the media. Asked about the claim that a disqualified bidder in the poll automation system contract has links to the "volunteer" depositor, Marcoleta said, "How do you establish the link? Only the NBI, only an independent agency can do that for our sake."

Marcoleta also reacted to Garcia's challenge to him to make his allegations under oath and to waive his parliamentary immunity.

"I am not making allegations. I am just simply proving... Noong makakita ako ng documents that would verify my point, ibinigay ko sa public. Is that an allegation? I did not allege anything," the lawmaker replied.

"Wala nga akong iwe-waive. I just prove my point... Why am I supposed to do that? Wala naman ako dapat i-waive eh. Hindi ko maintindihan where he is coming from," Marcoleta added.

Using coco fiber to fight oil spill

Workers from Brgy. Lamao in Limay, Bataan use coco fiber, rope, and empty plastic bottles to make booms on Tuesday, days after an oil spill from the capsized MT Terra Nova threatened parts of Bataan, Bulacan, Cavite, and Metro Manila. Grupo ng mga government employees, binatikos ang umano'y kakarampot na pagtaas ng sahod

Ikinadismaya ng grupo ng mga empleyado ng pamahalaan ang umano'y kakarampot na pagtaas ng kanilang mga sahod. Maalalang inilabas ni PBBM ang Executive Order (EO) No. 64 noong nakalipas na linggo na kinapapaloban ng pagtaas ng sahod ng mga government workers at pagbibigay sa kanila ng karagdagang allowance. Pero ayon sa grupong Public Services Labor Independent Confederation (PSLINK), nakakadismaya ang kakarampot na taas-sahod sa ilalim ng EO-64. Ayon kay PSLink President Annie Enriquez-Geron, masyadong mababa at kulang ang naturang taas-sahod, lalo na para sa mga rank-and-file government employees. Ayon pa kay Geron, mas mataas pa ang P35 na inaprubahan noon bilang dagdag sa arawang sahod ng mga pribadong mang-

gagawa sa National Capital Region (NCR). Ikinalungkot din ng labor leader na hindi nakasali rito ang mga contractual at mga job order. Ayon kay Geron, humigit-kumulang 900,000 government workers na tumatanggap lamang ng substandard wage at wala ding job security at social protection ang hindi makikinhang sa EO ni PBBM. Panawagan ni Geron kay Pang Marcos, pakingan ang panawagan ng maraming mga empleyado ng gobyerno para sa akma at nakabubuhay na sahod. Umapela rin ito kay Marcos na tugunan ang wage disparity sa pagitan ng national at local government employees at sa pagitan ng mga nasa rank and file at managerial positions. Bago ang EO 64 ni PBBM, una niyang ibinida ang pagtaas ng sahod ng mga empleyado ng gobyerno sa kanyang ikatlong SONA.

LTO-NCR, ipinagmalaki ang nakolektang kita unang kalahati ng 2024 na umabot ng 2.70%

Ipinagmalaki ng Land Transportation Office-National Capital Region ang kanilang revenue na umabot sa 2.70% para pa lamang sa unang kalahating taon.

Katumbas ito ng mahigit P4.67-billion na revenue collection ng naturang ahensya.

Ayon kay LTO-NCR Financial Management Division (FMD) Chief Annabelle Quevedo, sa ngayon ay tuluyan na nilang nalampasan ang first half revenue collection noong nagdaang taon na umabot lamang sa P4.5-billion.

Mataas ang nakuhang koleksyon ng ahensya sa buwan ng Enero, Pebrero, Abril, at Mayo na may kabuuang P3.22-billion revenue collec-

tion. Karamihan sa mga kinita ng ahensya ay mula sa registration at licensing ayon kay Quevedo.

P49.4-million naman ang nakolektang ahensya mula sa mga nahuulugan pasaway na motorista sa ilalim ng Law Enforcement and Traffic Adjudication System.

Nakapag-ambag rin ang Motor Vehicle Inspection Center na nakalikom ng P8.4-million.

Paliwanag naman ni LTO-NCR Regional Director Roque "Rox" Verzosa III, patuloy ang kanilang mga hakbang at estratehiya para sa tumaas ang kanilang revenue sa ikalawang bahagi ng kasalukuyang taon.

Mga magulang, hinikayat ng PSA na iparehistro ang mga anak sa National ID



Nanawagan ang pamunuan ng Philippine Statistics Authority sa mga magulang na hikayatin ang kanilang mga anak maparehistro kanilang National ID System. Kabilang sa maaaring iparehistro ay mga bata na nasa isa hanggang apat na taong gulang. Sa naging pahayag ni PSA National Statistician and Civil Registrar General Undersecretary Claire Dennis Mapa, wala pa ring patid ang pagtanggap nila ng registration mula sa kanilang

mga itinalagang venues.

Ito ay naglalayong magiging mas accessible sa mga kabataan ang pagpaparehistro para sa National ID. Sinabi pa ni Mapa na pauloy rin ang kanilang mobile registration activities na nag-iikot lalo na sa mga Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas ng bansa. Batay sa datos, as of July 12, 2024, aabot na sa kabuuang 88,720,028 na mga Pilipino ang matagumpay na nakapag-rehistro sa National ID System ng PSA.

Taylor Swift's Vienna shows cancelled after IS sympathizer arrest



The Vienna leg of a tour by American mega-star Taylor Swift has been cancelled after Austria arrested an Islamic State sympathizer in connection with an attack plot, the organizers said.

nagmamaneho ng nakainom. Una ng nabigo ang 10-time Grammy winner na dumalo sa pagdinig ng kaniyang kaso noong nakaraang linggo dahil sa abala ito sa concerts kaya nagtakda muli ang korte ng panibagong petsa ng pagdinig sa kaso nito.

Authorities had earlier confirmed the arrest of a 19-year-old sympathizer of the armed group for allegedly planning an attack in the Vienna region, warning he had a "focus" on Swift's three upcoming shows.

"With confirmation from government officials of a planned terrorist attack at Ernst Happel Stadium, we have no choice but to cancel the three scheduled shows for everyone's safety," Barracuda Music said on Instagram.

The organizers added that all ticket holders would receive refunds. About 65,000 spectators were expected at each show scheduled for Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

The man, who had pledged his allegiance to IS "in recent weeks", was detained in Lower Austria about an hour from the capital early on Wednesday. Austria's top security chief Franz Ruf told a press conference.

"We have established corresponding preparatory acts and also that there is a focus of the 19-year-old perpetrator on the Taylor Swift concerts in Vienna," Ruf said.

He said that chemical substances had been seized at the suspect's home.

A second person believed

to have been in contact with the suspect was arrested in Vienna.

According to the initial investigation, both suspects radicalised themselves on the internet. Police had promised to ramp up security measures, including deploying special units for the concerts, while having minimised any concrete danger.

'SHOCKED, SAD'

In the official "Swifties" fan group on WhatsApp, panic ensued following the announcement of the shows' cancellation with administrators overwhelmed with thousands of messages.

Marie Sereinig, 15, who had travelled from the south of the Alps to attend the show with her aunt, had spent months planning her outfit for the concert.

"I'm simply shocked and very sad. But I can also understand that Taylor Swift wouldn't dare go on stage in these conditions," she told AFP.

Other fans also shared their dismay.

"I don't really have any words," said Flora Zoe Koberwein, a 20-year-old student, adding, "sorry for those who have travelled so far".

Conservative Chancellor Karl Nehammer called the

cancellation "a bitter disappointment" for fans in a post on X, adding that the "very serious" threat had been combated early to prevent any tragedy.

The 34-year-old pop star was due to bring her record-breaking "Eras" Tour, which began its European leg in Paris in May, to Vienna on Thursday.

Following France, the tour stopped in Sweden, Portugal, Spain, the United Kingdom, Ireland, the Netherlands, Switzerland, Italy, Germany and Poland, having a significant impact on the local economies at each stop.

In Austria, more than 170,000 spectators were expected to attend the shows, bringing in some 100 million euros, according to estimates by the news agency APA.

By the end of the year, "Eras" had already become the first tour to sell more than \$1 billion in tickets and it is on track to more than double that by the time it concludes in Vancouver this December.

Austria experienced its first deadly jihadist attack in November 2020, when a convicted IS sympathiser went on a shooting rampage in downtown Vienna, killing four and wounding 23 others before police shot him dead.

Gutierrez, one of the prominent "Regal Babies," expressed her deep gratitude for the opportunities and care she received from Monteverde.

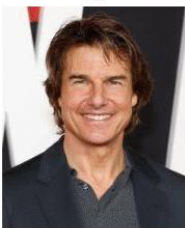

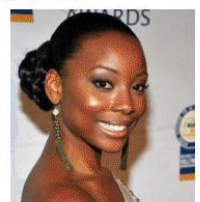

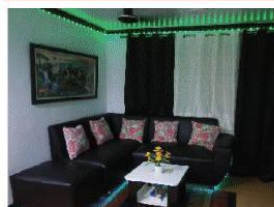

Nobel laureate Yunus arrives to lead Bangladesh, says will be guided by students

A harsh critic of Hasina, Yunus, 84, arrived in Dhaka following medical treatment in Paris after protesters backed him for the role in a government tasked with holding elections for a new leader.

"The country has the possibility of becoming a very beautiful nation," the economist told reporters at the airport, where he was greeted by senior military officers and student leaders.

The student protesters had saved the country and that freedom had to be protected, he said, adding: "Whatever path our students show us, we will move ahead with that."

"We had ended those possibilities, now again we have to rise up. To the government officials here and defense chiefs—we are a family, we should move ahead together."

Hasina's Awami League party does not figure in the interim government after she resigned on Monday following weeks of violence that killed about 300 people and injured thousands.

In a Facebook post, her son Sajeeb Wazed Joy said the party had not given up, however, and was ready to hold talks with opponents and the interim government.

"I had said my family will no longer be involved in politics but the way our party leaders and workers are being attacked, we cannot give up," he said on Wednesday.

Opposition appeals for calm

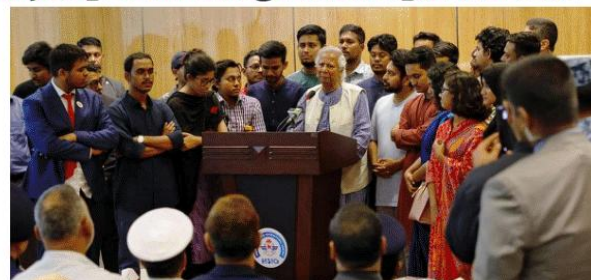
Yunus, known as the "banker to the poor," received the 2006 Nobel Peace Prize for founding a bank that pioneered the fight against poverty through small loans to needy borrowers.

Hasina's flight from the country she ruled for 20 of the last 30 years after winning a fourth straight term in January, triggered jubilation and violence as crowds stormed and ransacked her official residence.

She is sheltering at an air base near the Indian capital New Delhi, a development that Yunus said caused anger at India among some Bangladeshis.

The student-led movement that ousted Hasina grew out of protests against quotas in government jobs that spiraled in July, provoking a violent crackdown that drew global criticism, though the government denied using excessive force.

The protests were fueled also by harsh economic conditions and political repression in the country, born after a war of liberation from Pakistan in 1971.



Nobel Peace laureate Muhammad Yunus returned home to Bangladesh on Thursday to lead a new interim government after weeks of tumultuous student protests forced Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina to resign and flee to neighboring India.

The main opposition Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) boycotted two national elections after the arrest of its leaders, while the COVID-19 pandemic damaged the \$450-billion economy after years of strong growth, leading to high inflation, unemployment and shrinking reserves.

It pushed the Hasina government to seek a \$4.7 billion loan from the International Monetary Fund.

Hasina's archrival and BNP leader Khaleda Zia, 78, called for calm and an end to

violence in a video address from her hospital bed to hundreds of supporters at a rally on Wednesday after her release from house arrest.

"No destruction, revenge or vengeance," she said as the BNP demanded elections in three months.

USA rally to beat Serbia, reach Olympic men's basketball final

Golden State Warriors star Stephen Curry dazzled with 36 points and all-time NBA scoring leader LeBron James had a triple-double of 16 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists.

But it took a massive fourth-quarter effort to finally subdue the Serbs, who led most of the night and took a 76-63 advantage into the fourth quarter.

Kevin Durant and Devin Booker drilled back-to-back three-pointers to start the fight-back.

Joel Embiid pulled the States within four with a three-point play and James tied it up at 84-84 with 3:41 to play.

Curry rattled in a three-pointer with 2:24 remaining to give the United States their first lead since the first quarter 87-86.

James followed with a driving layup. Curry grabbed a steal and drove for a basket that pushed the US lead to five and the Americans held on.

"We know e weren't playing our best basketball at all the whole game, but we were like two or three possessions away or one bad bounce away from flipping the momentum," Curry said.

"We could feel it. There was a point end of the third quarter where you started to feel a little like ... are they going to slow down at all?"

"That first four minutes of the fourth quarter changed everything."

Embiid scored 19 points and Durant woke up just in time after a sleepy first half to add nine and the US maintained their chance to claim a 17th Olympic crown.

Three-time NBA Most Valuable Player Jokic finished with 17 points and 11 assists for Serbia, who got 20 points from a brilliant Bogdan Bogdanovic.

Curry got off to a scorching start, drilling five three-pointers on the way to 17 first-quarter points.

But Serbia combined for five three-pointers themselves and led 31-23 after a frenetic first quarter in which only four players scored for the United States.

Serbia continued to pour it on, pushing their lead to 42-25 with more than six minutes left in the second period.

Struggling offensively, the United States were also unable to slow the Serbian offense keyed by Jokic.

Aleksa Avramovic was a deadly four-of-six from three-point range on the way to 15 first-half points and Atlanta Hawks shooting guard Bogdanovic had 12 before the break.

Curry had 20 points in the first half but subdued Phoenix Suns star Durant missed his only attempt.

Suddenly the United States, whose romp through the group stage included a 110-84 victory over Serbia, looked in serious trouble for the first time at the Paris Games.

Back-to-back three-pointers from Curry and Jrue Holiday cut the deficit to 59-65 but try as they might the US couldn't reel Serbia in.

Marko Guduric converted a four-point play when he was fouled by Derrick White on a bomb from well beyond the arc to propel Serbia into the fourth quarter in the ascent.

The United States erased a 17-point deficit to beat Nikola Jokic's Serbia 95-91 on Thursday and reach the Olympic men's basketball final, keeping their bid for a fifth straight gold medal alive.
