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DOST-CAR Bridges STI and Community through RSTW in Ifugao

The ribbon-cutting ceremony was led by Secretary Dr. Renato U. Solidum, Jr., alongside DOST Assistant Secretary for Development Cooperation Mr. Rodolfo J. Calzado Jr., DOST Undersecretary for Regional Operations Engr. Sancho A. Maborang, DOST-TAPI Director Atty. Marion Decene (represented by Atty. Joycel Aguilar), and DOST-CAR Regional Director Dr. Nancy A. Bantog. They were joined by Hon. Solomon R. Chungalao, Congressman of the Lone District of Ifugao (represented by Mr. Ram Cabbigat), Provincial Governor of Ifugao Hon. Jerry U. Dalipog, and Mayor of Lamut Hon. Victormar Hagada Bunnol. Ifugao State University officials and employees, led by Dr. Eva Marie Codamon-Dugyon, also actively participated in the event.

Guests and partners from state universities and colleges (SUCs), higher education institutions (HEIs), local government units (LGUs) in CAR, the Philippine Information Agency (PIA), media partners, as well as private sectors and industry representatives were also in attendance. In her welcome remarks, Dr. Nancy Bantog, DOST-CAR Regional Director, emphasized the benefits of DOST's programs, projects, and activities (PPAs) for the region. She highlighted the importance of strengthening the STI ecosystem in the Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) and called for active community involvement to shape the future through STI. Atty. Marion Decene, Director of DOST-TAPI, represented by Mr. Joycel N. Aguilar, discussed the rationale behind the RSTW celebration. He spotlighted the hard work of the agency and its scientists in advancing STI, emphasizing the significant contributions of science to local development.

Provincial Governor Hon. Jerry U. Dalipog expressed gratitude for the partnership with DOST and urged the people of Ifugao to embrace innovation with DOST's support. He called on local leaders to collaborate with DOST in implementing new technologies suitable for the province and region. Hon. Solomon R. Chungalao, represented by Mr. Ram Cabbigat, conveyed his full support for DOST's PPAs, especially during budget hearings in Congress. He assured that all PPAs benefiting the people of Ifugao would receive backing in Congress. DOST Undersecretary

for Regional Operations, Engr. Sancho A. Maborang, refocused the agency's PPAs to align with equitable operations at national, regional, and provincial levels. He presented how DOST-CAR has effectively implemented its PPAs in the province and affirmed DOST's commitment to fostering a sustainable future for all.

In his keynote address, DOST Secretary Dr. Renato U. Solidum, Jr. emphasized DOST's collaboration with local government units (LGUs) to provide solutions and open opportunities, stressing the importance of developing fit-for-purpose solutions for LGUs. Dr. Solidum outlined DOST's four pillars that support the socio-economic agenda of the administration and the ultimate goal of achieving smart and sustainable cities and communities across all local governments. He also introduced the 8th Big R&D project focusing on biologics in pharmacology, aiming to develop preventive and curative medicinal applications to ensure readiness for future epidemics or pandemics and enhance resilience across various sectors beyond disaster risk reduction and management (DRRM). Moreover, Sec. Solidum mentioned that the agency is currently working with partners and academes to support the country's green economy program, aiming to recycle 20,000 tons of plastic waste by 2028, create green jobs, and support waste reduction strategies.

The event also featured a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) signing and the ceremonial turnover of the TaRaKi DRR-CCAM Knowledge Management Kiosk, aimed at mobilizing DRR-CCAM knowledge transfer to all partners in Cordillera and also the MOU signing for Natural Dye Hubs in Abra. The 2024 SETUP Praise and Best CEST Community awards recognized outstanding SETUP cooperators and CEST beneficiaries. A press conference followed, discussing various DOST programs and initiatives for the region.

Throughout the celebration, different fora and activities were held, addressing agendas under DOST's four pillars. These discussions aimed to provide solutions and open opportunities for the Cordillera Administrative Region through science, technology, and innovation. (Nelson S. Santos)

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IPOPHL, FIS partner to provide IP support to more local inventors

The MOA was signed between IPOPHL Director General Rowel S. Barba and FIS President Dr. Ronald P. Pagsanghan last week at the IPOPHL office in Taguig City.

Under the MOU work plan, which will lay down the specific activities both parties will respectively and jointly undertake, IPOPHL will capacitate FIS to provide IP expertise to its members and technical assistance under the Inventor Assistance Program (IAP), extend support on enforcement concerns, and help build stronger linkages between the group's inventors and agencies that can boost their exposure in local and international markets.

IPOPHL will also work to establish a registry of all inventors and innovators and their patents.

For its part, the FIS will actively support and work with IPOPHL in raising awareness, promoting respect in IP, and encouraging its members to register and enforce their IP rights, as well as their technology transfer agreements.

Together, IPOPHL and FIS will support each other's endeavors towards elevating the country's innovation scene.

"This partnership will undoubtedly encourage other Filipinos to start their IP journey that can lead to more cre-

ations that could change society for the better," DG Barba said.

DG Barba committed that IPOPHL will ensure that FIS members will be provided support in availing its incentive programs for independent and starting inventors, which include, among others, the agency's Inventor Assistance Program, which links independent inventors to pro bono patent experts for assistance in patent application processes; the Youth IP Incentive Program, which waives certain fees and provides start-to-finish customer support in IP application; and the Juana Patent and Juana Design Protection Incentive Program, which waives some application fees for eligible women inventors.

Dr. Pagsanghan said the IPOPHL-FIS collaboration "extends beyond just rankings and membership," and marks inventors' increased trust in government and commitment to help boost the Marcos administration's goal of pushing the Philippines to leap higher in the Global Innovation Index ranking by 2028.

He shared that "inventors fear that sharing their invention prototypes with institutions will expose their future IP assets to theft. This fear dampens the spirit of collaboration and the inspiration of inventors who only seek to

further the development of technologies that Filipinos could be proud of but are instead discredited from what they have created."

"Through this MOA, we encourage our members to protect and commercialize their inventions, ensuring they receive the recognition and compensation they deserve. This partnership is more than just rankings and membership: It is also about empowering our inventors to dream bigger, aim more, and contribute significantly to our nation's progress together with the support of IP capabilities we look forward to developing through IPOPHL's assistance and dedication," he added.

The FIS was established in 1943, making it the oldest state-mandated institution to support inventors and advocate for the progress of the local innovation landscape. It is the largest inventor society in the country, with a membership of over 500 members nationwide who have met the group's membership requirement of having at least one registered patent or utility model.

The FIS is also the Philippine representative for and serves as a voting member at the International Federation of Inventors' Associations (IFIA) based in Geneva, Switzerland.

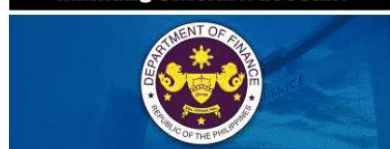

The Natural Dyes Hub in Abra is launching soon!



The Department of Science and Technology - Philippine Textile Research Institute (DOST-PTRI) inked a Memorandum of Agreement with the University of Abra (UAbra), formerly Abra State Institute of Sciences and Technology (ASIST) and the Department of Science and Technology - Cordillera Administrative Region (DOST - CAR) to establish the second Natural Dyes (NatDyes) Hub in La Paz, Abra.

This is the 3rd NatDyes Hub in CAR and the 14th in the country. This agreement was formalized during the opening ceremony of the 2024 Regional Science, Technology, and Innovation Week (RSTW) in Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) held at the Heritage Convention Center in Ifugao State University on August 7, 2024. The collaboration aims to develop and promote natural dyes in the textile industry, reflecting a commitment to sustainable practices and the use of indigenous resources.

The new hub will focus on improving extraction methods, color standardization, and creating value-added textile products. It also aims to boost the economic prospects of local communities by integrating natural dye production into their supply and value chains. Furthermore, DOST-PTRI will bring its expertise in natural dyes research and development, UAbra will offer academic resources and training, and DOST-CAR will oversee the establishment of the Abra NatDyes Hub and its integration into the local textile innovation ecosystem and economy.

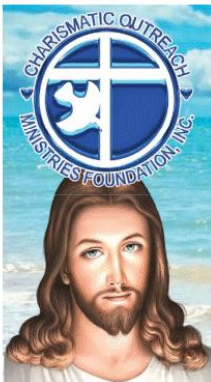
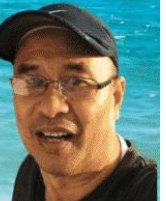
Second, by being transformed by the renewal of our mind that we may come to know the true meaning of "good", and to

ORDER

MARESTELA WASQUIN GENOBISA** ("Marestela") is of legal age, Filipino, married, with residence address at Purok 5, Kanapulo, Magsaysay, Davao del Sur, where she may be served with summons, notices, orders, decisions, and other processes of this Honorable Court. She is an indispensable party being the biological mother of the Petitioner. Respondent **CITY CIVIL REGISTRY OFFICE OF MANILA** ("CCRO-Manila") is being sued in its official capacity with office address at the Manila City Hall, Ermita, Manila, where it can be served with summons, notices, orders, decisions, and other processes of this Honorable Court. All other persons having interest in the instant Petition are being impleaded in accordance with the provisions of Rule 108 of the Rules of Court. University of Santo Tomas, Ateneo de Manila University, and De La Salle University advanced to the UAAP Esports NBA2K24 Final Four at the close of the group phase on Wednesday at the Doreen Fernandez Black Box, Aréte Ateneo in Quezon City.

Carlos Yulo nakatanggap ng dagdag na P20-M cash incentives kay Pres. Marcos

Nakatanggap ng dagdag na P20 milyon mula sa Office of the President si Pinoy 2-gold Olympic medalist at gymnast Carlos Yulo.

Isinagawa ang nasabing paggawad ng cash incentives sa Palasyo ng Malacañang ilang oras pagdating sa bansa ng mga atletang Pinoy na sumabak sa Paris Olympics.

Ayon kay Pangulong Ferdinand Marcos Jr na tinapatan lamang nito ang incentives na nakasaad sa Republic Act 10699 or the National Athletes, Coaches, and Trainers Benefits and Incentives Act.

Nakasaad sa batas na ang sinumang atleta na makakuha ng gintong medalya sa Olympics ay makakatanggap

ng P10 milyon.

Dahil dalawang gintong medalya ang nakuha ni Yulo mula sa floor exercise at vault ay mayroon na itong P20-M na natanggap base sa batas.

Ginawaran din ni Pangulong Marcos si Yulo ng Medal of Merit na ibinibigay sa mga indibidwal na nakakagawa ng mga pagkilala sa mga international events sa larangan ng literature, sciences, arts, entertainment at sports na maituturing na national pride.

Mabibigyan din ng dagdag na P2-milyon ang mga bronze medalist na Pinay boxers na sina Nesthy Peticio at Aira Villegas kung saan tinapatan din ng Pangulo ang nakasaad sa batas na P2-M.

Maging ang mga hindi nakakuha ng medalya ay binigyan din ng Pangulo ng incentives na nagkakahalaga ng P1-M habang tig-P500,000 ang mga coaches.

Nabigyan din ng pagkilala ang lahat ng mga atleta kung saan kinilala ng pangulo ang hirap at sakripisyo ng mga atleta na makasali sa mga international sporting events.

Magugunitang nitong Martes ng gabi ng dumating na sa bansa ang atletang sumabak sa Paris Olympics kung saan sa araw naman ng Miyerkules ay isasagawa ang Hero's parade.

Teletigers Esports Club's Erix Daniel Delos Reyes finished first in Pool A with six points, while Teletigers Gideon Marty Del Val and Daemiel Erzbet Argame, who shared the chair in Pool B, remained flawless throughout the group stage, sweeping all universities and achieving the highest possible score of seven points.

After UST secured the top seed in both pools, Teletigers NBA2K head coach Augusto De Jesus III expressed joy that all his players advanced to the next round. He even mentioned that they would head straight to practice at nearby hotels.

"Mas magiging masaya ako kapag magkapat ang both UST sa finals. Doble yung saya. Kaya mamaya, plano namin na mag-practice na sa mga malalapit na hotel dito, wala nang uwiyan," said De Jesus.

Joining the Final Four alongside the Teletigers were the Blue Eagles' Justin Carl Lagac and Paolo Jesus Medina from Pool A, who advanced through

a tiebreaker against FEU's Nehemiah Maninit and UP's Andreus Javier. Also advancing was Viridis Arcus' Kegan Audric Yap, who finished with six points.

The playoffs on Thursday will follow a cross-over format, where Teletigers' Delos Reyes will face La Salle's Yap, while UST's Del Val/Argame will go up against Ateneo's Lagac/Medina in a best-of-three series.

The Finals is also a best-of-three series. Viridis Arcus head coach Rial Polog Jr. expressed confidence in their championship chances, especially with Yap taking the helm for La Salle.

"Yeah, I am confident (mag-champion) kasi yung nakapasok sa playoffs ay team captain namin. So, I am super confident na makuha [namin] yung championship," Polog said.

After the match between the Tamaraws' Maninit and the Fighting Maroons' Javier, where FEU won 47-44, a tiebreaker ensued among the two squads

and Ateneo decided through quotient. The Blue Eagles went a +22, the Fighting Maroons had 0, and the Tamaraws Esports ended with -22.

Completing the group stage standings in Pool A, the Fighting Maroons placed third, and the Tamaraws took fourth place. De La Salle University's Jose Paradocho finished fifth with three points, Adamson University's Joaquin Obado had two points, University of the East's Joshua Mariano had a point, and National University's Jarell Allaga finished scoreless.

In Pool B, unlike Day 1, all universities managed to earn points. With UST leading the pool and La Salle following, Ateneo's Luis Jovellanos finished with four points. FEU's Justine Lagmay, NU's John Reyes, and UE's Ceanne Manalastas all finished with three points. Adamson's Aaron Advincula and Remigio Aguinado III, along with UP's Angelo Nuestro and Raphael Sison, each ended the group stage with a point.

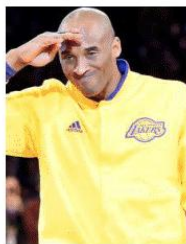
Huling warm-up jacket ni Kobe Bryant naibenta sa auction ng mahigit P16-M
