Ayon kay Tansingo, dalawang taon siyang namibihan bilang pinuno ng Immigration at maraming mga hamon ang kinaharap ng ahensiya tulad ng border control sa mga international port of entry at exit, human trafficking, atbp.

## Remulla: Bureau of Immigration should have custody of Alice Guo

Remulla made the statement in a press briefing on Wednesday, when asked who should take custody of Guo and where she should be detained.

"Kung may dapat magde-detain kay Alice Guo it should be the Bureau of Immigration. (If someone should detain Alice Guo it should be the Bureau of Immigration.) An Immigration case should take precedence over everything. Non-bailable yan (That's non-bailable)," he said.

Guo was originally intended to be transferred to Senate custody—until a Tarlac court issued a warrant against her that put her under the jurisdiction of the Philippine National Police (PNP).

"Fake passport niya (her passport is fake), her being an alien actually, trying to pass herself off as a Filipino. I think that is a major violation of law within our country. It's really an immigration matter. Of course, the criminal aspect would be there," Remulla explained.

Remulla went on to say there is a 'possible deportation case' against Guo. The Bureau of Immigration on Monday said Guo faces deportation charges for misrepresentation and undesirability.

"Ang tingin ko (I think), when everything clears up already, it would have to be with Immigration and Immigration would just have to

seek our permission to bring her to court every time," Remulla said.

Guo remains under the custody of the PNP but senators insist Guo should be detained at the Senate since their arrest order came first.

### JURISDICTION OVER GRAFT CASE VS. GUO

Remulla said they are still awaiting the reply of the Office of the Ombudsman. He wrote to the Ombudsman to seek clarification over the graft case filed against Guo in a Capas Regional Trial Court.

Remulla earlier said the case should have been filed before Sandiganbayan.

"We expect them to respond to our letter very soon. We also intend to write a letter to the court administrator so that all these confusion will be done away with. We cannot allow these things to happen again. I don't think we want a conflict of jurisdiction for any person we want tried for different crimes. So dapat ito magclear," he said.

"The Capas court cannot take precedence over what the Sandiganbayan should be doing. This is a case of a really, a court issuing an order without jurisdiction," the DOJ chief added.

Remulla admitted he was not comfortable knowing the case against Guo was filed in a court within Tarlac, wherein she was a mayor of a municipality.

"It's commonsensical

to think that she would be more influential in that area which has been in her sphere of influence because she's the mayor in a town in the province where she's being taken as a detainee, kaya may discomfort kaagad ako sa simula palang," he said.

Remulla said the human trafficking complaint filed against Guo has already been submitted for resolution, which they expect to be out within this week or next week.

He said they want the case resolved soon to prevent dilatory tactics from Guo.

Meantime, the DOJ said the supposed surrender feeler from Wesley, the brother of Alice Guo, remains part of an

ongoing investigation.

"Sa ngayon part of the process of investigation lang yan. Kasi, gaya ng nangyari noong iba, this could be a deflection, hindi natin alam baka nililihis lang tayo. (Now that is just part of the process of investigation. Because, like previous instances, this could be a deflection. We don't know if we are being diverted.) It's the burden on them to show proof na they really intend to voluntarily surrender," Justice Undersecretary Raul Vasquez said.

"Pag hindi siya sumuko, hindi totoo. So we'll just have to wait," Remulla added.

(If he doesn't surrender, it's not true. So we'll just have to wait.)

## Remulla on Quiboloy house arrest: It's only given to those who don't resist arrest



Justice Secretary Jesus Crispin Remulla said requests to place an accused under house arrest is up to the discretion of the court. But in the case of Kingdom of Jesus Christ leader Apollo Quiboloy, Remulla said he does not see the need on why it should be granted.

"But as far as I remember, 'yung mga binibigyan ng house arrest 'yung mga hindi nag resist o kaya pumayag kaagad na maaresto. 'Yung mga nanago at nagpahirap sa gobyerno, madalang tayo mag bigay ng house arrest sa mga taong ganito," Remulla said on Wednesday when asked about Quiboloy's request.

The DOJ chief said those who have medical conditions may also be granted house arrest. "This is something we are not ready to discuss because it is within the court's ambit.

Hindi tayo dapat ang sumagot sa bagay na yan," he added.

Quiboloy's camp said it filed a motion in court requesting to transfer him to the custody of the Armed Forces of the Philippines from the Philippine National Police.

KOJC chief legal counsel Israelito Torreon said the move is out of concern for Quiboloy's safety.

The Department of National Defense on Monday rejected the proposal seeking the transfer of the religious leader.

### REMULLA ON QUIBOLOY'S FACE BEING HIDDEN

Remulla again questioned the way Quiboloy's presentation to the public was handled by police.

He maintained that the KOJC leader's face should not have been completely covered when he was presented to the media by the national police.

The PNP also drew flak online for releasing blurred versions of the mugshots of Quiboloy, which some be-

lieve were "special treatment" since he is a high-profile inmate.

The DOJ chief believes the police should be fair with these procedures.

"Hindi dapat ganun ang nangyari. Sinabi na natin dati, dapat diyan fair is fair. Nilagay mo nga sa wanted poster, hindi mo ilalagay sa, hindi mo ilalabas na huinuli mo, hindi mo papakita yung mukha. Dapat pinakita mukha. So people will believe na nahuli talaga," he said.

"Dapat makita ng tao, dapat masatisfy ang tao na siya talaga yung under custody," Remulla added.

The PNP on Tuesday defended the move, saying they usually blur the faces of arrested individuals, even if they are ordinary citizens.

It said this is based on the advisory of the Commission on Human Rights that individuals are presumed innocent until proven guilty.

### FREEZE ORDER VS. KOJC SHOULD BE IMPLEMENTED

The DOJ stood firm that the freeze order issued against the back accounts and real properties registered under the name of Apollo Quiboloy and his KOJC church must be implemented, regardless of the administrator.

In March, former President Rodrigo Duterte was appointed administrator of KOJC properties.

"Yung freeze order ng CA dapat Sundin kahit sino man ang may hawak ng properties or bank accounts. The fact naging administrator ng KOJC properties si former President Rodrigo Duterte ay isang bagay na hindi importante sa issue ng freeze order. Ang importante diyan, may freeze order at dapat sundan. Habang nandiyan yan, ipaputupad yan at wala dapat makagalaw," Justice Undersecretary Raul Vasquez said.

Last month, the Court of Appeals extended the freeze order up to February 6, 2025.

Duterte filed cases against Interior Secretary Benhur Abalos, PNP Chief Gen. Rommel Marbil and other PNP officials over the police operation in the KOJC compound in Davao City.

National Prosecution Service OIC-Prosecutor General Richard Fadullon said the complaints will be transferred to the main office in Manila.

"Yes there were cases that were filed for unjust vexation before the Prosecutor's Office Davao. I think there has already been an order to transfer these cases here in the main office for us to have a prosecutor investigate all of them," he said.

## Bato sees 'lapses' in PNP, KOJC actions during Davao standoff, vows 'fair' probe

"Meron both sides, merong kwan, may mga hindi karapat dapat na gawin pero yung sa pulis yung kanilang extended service of warrant na umabot ng 14 days. Conducting search without search warrant ay nakikita natin yun ay mga mayroon silang mga nagawang paglabag," Dela Rosa said in a press conference.

Dela Rosa is chairperson of the Senate Justice and Human Rights subcommittee tasked to investigate the incident.

"I have to be fair and balanced sa aking investigation. Mahal ko yung PNP, sa kabila naman I am a Davaoeno at mahal ko rin yung mga Davaoeno o yung mga members ng KOJC," he said.

"So kailangan kung may nakita akong mali in the course of my investigation natural sisitahin ko sila at kung may nakita akong mali rin na ginawa ng mga members ng KOJC natural sinita ko rin sila," Dela Rosa added.

Dela Rosa said that Committee Chairman Senate Minority Leader Aquilino Pimentel III is eyeing remedial legislation because the incident may have involved substantive rights instead of just

mere procedures. Dela Rosa said he is not yet sure if he will conduct another hearing since Quiboloy is now in government custody.

Petitioner Yukio Mizoguchi, by counsel, 1 unto this Honorable Court, most respectfully states that:

1. Petitioner, whose complete name is Mizoguchi, Yukio Hasegawa, was born on January 15, 1955 in Hyogo Japan to parents Yayoi Mizoguchi and Hachiro Mizoguchi. A copy of Petitioner's Certificate of Birth is hereto attached and

made an integral part hereof as Annex "A".

2. Petitioner is a citizen of Japan, a country whose laws grant Filipinos the right to become naturalized citizens thereof. The petitioner is registered as a resident alien and possesses an **alien certificate of registration (ACR)** from the Bureau of Immigration. A copy of his ACR hereto is attached as Annex "B".

3. Petitioner's first recorded arrival date in the Philippines was on April 08, 1977, at the Manila International Airport based on his available old passport, attached hereto as Annex "C". However, according to the records of the Bureau of Immigration of the Philippines, his first arrival date in the Philippines was on June 20, 1994, aboard a Thai Airways plane with flight number TG62. A certificate of arrival issued by the Bureau of Immigration of the Philippines on September 08, 2017, attached hereto as Annex "D".

4. Petitioner has continuously and permanently resided in the Philippines since his arrival and has been residing at No. 107 Dayap St., Ayala Alabang, Muntinlupa City, for at least one (1) year prior to the filing of this Petition. A copy of his Residence Certificate issued by the Barangay of Ayala Alabang Muntinlupa is attached as Annex "E".

5. Petitioner is one of the directors and the majority stockholder of the Daruma Corporation, a domestic corporation duly organized and existing under and virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines with principal office address at Daruma Bldg. No 2015 Senator Gil Puyat Avenue, Pasay City. Copies of this Annual Income Tax Returns for the years 2021, 2022, and 2023, are attached hereto and made integral parts hereof as **ANNEXES "F," "G," and "H."** Copy of **Bank Certification**, as **ANNEX "I"**.

6. Petitioner speaks and writes English and Filipino.

7. Petitioner has been married since May 16, 1982, to Eden Villanueva-Mizoguchi, in Manila. A copy of the Marriage Certificate as **ANNEXES "J"**.

8. Petitioner is entitled to the benefit of Section 3 of the Revised Naturalization Law (Commonwealth Act No. 473) reducing to five (5) years the requirement under Section 2 of ten (10) years of continuous residence.

9. Petitioner and his wife begot three (3) children, namely Hideo, Keiko, and Kenji, who were born on May 29, 1983; November 21, 1984; and August 17, 1986, in Manila respectively. Petitioner does not have any minor children required to be enrolled in any public or private schools recognized by the Department of Education or Office of the Private Education of the Philippines, where Philippine History, government, and civics are taught or prescribed as part of the school curriculum. Copies of the birth certificates are attached hereto as **ANNEXES "K," "L," and "M," respectively.**

10. Petitioner is exempt from the requirements of Section 6 of the Revised Naturalization Law (Commonwealth Act No. 473) regarding the filing with the Office of the Solicitor-General a declaration under oath of his bona fide intention to become a citizen of the Philippines, as he has been residing in the Philippines for more than 30 years prior to the filing of this Petition. However, despite being exempted from filing the Declaration of Intention before the Office of the Solicitor General, the Petitioner still filed the same. Copy of the declaration of intention received on November 10, 2027, by the Office of the Solicitor General attached hereto as **ANNEX "N"**.

11. Petitioner possesses all the qualifications under Section 2, and none of the disqualifications under Section 4 of the Revised Naturalization Law.

11.1. Petitioner believes in the principles underlying the Philippine Constitution; is of good moral character and has conducted himself in a proper and irreproachable manner during the entire period of his residence in the Philippines in his relations with the constituted government as well as with the community in which he lives; has mingled socially with the Filipinos, and has evinced a genuine desire to learn and embrace the customs, traditions, and ideas of the Filipinos.

11.2. Petitioner is not opposed to organized government or affiliated with any association or group of persons who uphold and teach doctrines opposing all organized government; he does not defend or teach the necessity or propriety of violence, personal assault, or assassination for the success and predominance of their ideas.

11.3. Petitioner is not a polygamist or a believer in polygamy or the practice of polygamy; Petitioner has never been convicted of any crime involving moral turpitude. Copy of his NBI Clearance Attached hereto as **ANNEX "O"**.

11.4. Petitioner is not suffering from mental alienation or incurable contagious disease. The Medical Certificate is attached hereto as **ANNEX "P"**.

11.5. Petitioner is not a citizen or subject of a nation at war in the Philippines or a country whose laws do not grant Filipinos the right to become naturalized citizens or subjects thereof.

12. It is Petitioner's intention in good faith to become a citizen of the Philippines and to renounce absolutely and forever any allegiance and fidelity to Japan. Petition shall likewise reside continuously in the Philippines from the date of the filing of this Petition up to the time of his admission to Philippine citizenship.

13. This Petition is supported by the Judicial Affidavits of two credible persons, namely, Carlito I. Vargas, Eulogio C. Baquiran, and Celso E. Lozada, both Filipino Citizens, and residents of No. 11 Lourdes St., Pasay City, 61-b Moonstone rd., Batasan Hills-Northview I Subd., Quezon City, and No. 44 Pres. Quirino Ext., Phase 5, Zone 6, Signal Village, Taguig City, respectively, who personally know the Petitioner to be a resident of the Philippines for more than thirty (30) years, to be a person of good repute and morally irreproachable, and who, in their opinion, that Petitioner has all the qualifications necessary to become a citizen of the Philippines and is not in any way disqualified under the provisions of the Revised Naturalization Law.

14. Petitioner desires to become a citizen of the Republic of the Philippines.
