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DOST Engages Media on Programs, Innovations Ahead of 2025 NSTW



Officials from the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) convened with members of the local and national media during the 2025 NSTW Press Conference held on November 19 at La Preciosa, Arabella Place, Laoag City. The event provided an overview of what the public can expect at the upcoming National Science, Technology, and Innovation Week (NSTW) celebration set to take place in Ilocos Norte.

During the briefing, DOST representatives highlighted the various activities, exhibits, and technology showcases designed to bring cutting-edge innovations closer to communities in the region. They emphasized that the 2025 NSTW continues the agency's commitment to expanding access to science and technology—ensuring that advancements are felt not

only in major urban centers but across the entire country.

The press conference also served as a platform to discuss the Department's ongoing and future programs, particularly those supporting inclusive development, regional innovation, and stronger collaboration with local government units, academic institutions, and private-sector partners.

During the engagement, Publishers Association of the Philippines, Inc. (PAPI) President Rebecca Madeja-Velasquez raised a critical question on why many homegrown technologies showcased in RSTW (Regional Science, Technology, and Innovation Week), NSTW, and Handa Pilipinas fail to take off despite their promise. She emphasized the persistent gap

between invention and market readiness, pointing to the need to better understand the role of the Philippine Higher Education Validation and Innovation Testbed (PHI-TEST) in elevating local technologies to the global market.

In response, Science and Technology Secretary Renato Solidum Jr. explained that the challenge is not unique to the Philippines. "Kadalasan, 10%

lang 'yan sa ating innovation, and that is not only the statistics for the PH but all over the world," he said, noting that many innovations falter because they lack a clear market perspective during development. He added that innovators often focus solely on the invention itself and overlook how technologies will be implemented or adopted by users. "When people devel-

op technologies, innovation lang ang kanyang naisip, pero 'yung paano i-implement at paano gagamitin ng ibang mga tao o paano pa mahikayat 'yung iba na gamitin ito, ay kailangan i-improve pa 'yung produkto," he remarked.

According to Solidum, PHI-TEST aims to address this gap by validating technologies in real-world settings nationwide. "Kaya

'yung PHI-TEST gagawin ng DOST and universities and inventors, if you want, 'yung kanilang technology, pero kailangan ipakalat sa buong Pilipinas at tingnan kung ano pang improvement ang kailangan gawin," he said. He added that the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) will play a major role in the effort—"at good news, sila daw ang magpopondo."

DOST Assistant Secretary Napoleon K. Juanillo Jr. further explained: "Unang-una po, may konteksto naman ito. Ang SUCs kasi, ang tawag sa kanila ay experimental stations... So binabalik lang natin sa kanila 'yung mandate nila to test out all of these innovations that they themselves have initiated." He also emphasized that PHI-TEST will not be limited to SUC-developed technologies, but will also include privately funded innovations and those from regional and provincial innovation hubs. He noted that CHED has given its consent, enabling nationwide testing across diverse demographics, environments, and conditions. "Kung sakali man ang results n'on ay revision, reformatting, pivoting, then at least meron tayong evidence as to what to do next. At kung successful, then well and good, we can tell the investors ready for investments," he added. Through these initiatives, DOST reinforces its goal of empowering Filipinos through science, technology, and innovation. (Nelson Santos)

The center plays a vital role in reinforcing the Philippine textile sector by supplying affordable and reliable Filipino-made yarns to fashion designers, apparel makers, social enterprises, and MSMEs. With an annual capacity of up to 40 tons of natural fiber-blended yarns, RYPIC reduces reliance on imported raw materials while enhancing local productivity and competitiveness.

The Ilocos Region, home to 860 active weavers and nearly 2,000 across Luzon, stands as

a cultural stronghold of Philippine weaving traditions. By providing consistent access to quality yarns, RYPIC helps preserve and elevate this heritage, allowing artisans to expand their markets and innovate their designs.

The center also opens livelihood opportunities for farmers and rural workers involved in fiber cultivation and processing. It supports national goals such as Republic Act No. 9242 (Philippine Tropical Fabrics Law) and resonates with the Tatak Pinoy vision of strengthening local industries, innovation, and Filipino creativity.

The benefits of RYPIC Ilocos Norte extend beyond textile production. It uplifts communities, safeguards cultural identity, promotes sustainable natural fibers, and positions the Philippines as a regional leader in textile innovation rooted in local expertise. (Dave Masirag)

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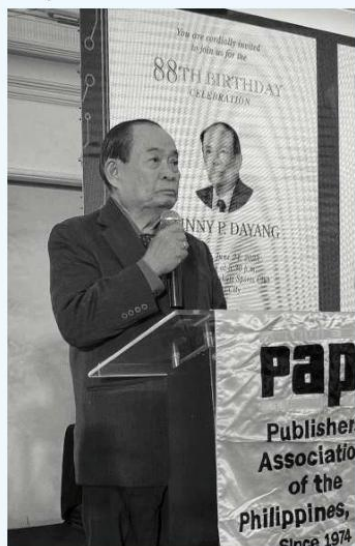
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CMMA Posthumously Honors Veteran Journalist Juan "Johnny" P. Dayang With Serviam Award

The Catholic Mass Media Awards (CMMA) will posthumously honor the late Juan P. "Johnny" Dayang, veteran journalist, publisher, and advocate for ethical media, with the 2024 CMMA Serviam Award. Established in memory of CMMA founder Jaime L. Cardinal Sin, the award recognizes media professionals whose lives reflect Christian service, integrity, and faith-inspired communication.



Dayang, who passed away on April 29, 2025, served as CMMA Board Secretary, president of the Publishers Association of the Philippines, Inc. (PAPI), president of the Manila Overseas Press Club, and founding president of the Federation of Provincial Press Clubs of the Philippines. He also served as a UNESCO commissioner, Red Cross governor, and former mayor of Kalibo.

He played a key role in establishing the CMMA, including introducing Cardinal Jaime L. Sin to Ambassador Antonio Cabangon Chua, helping bring the awards to life, a vision he nurtured until his final days.

"Our father was a staunch advocate of the Catholic Mass Media Awards," said Juan E. Dayang, Jr., senior diplomat at the Philippine Embassy in Ankara, Türkiye. "It was his dream to see the CMMA thrive. Although I cannot be there in person, I am proud that his daughters will receive this award on behalf of our family, honoring a legacy that touched countless lives."

Dayang was tragically killed at his home in Kalibo, Aklan, on April 29, 2025. His passing drew condemnation from national and international organizations. UNESCO Director-General Audrey Azoulay said, "I condemn the killing of Juan Dayang and call for a transparent and thorough investigation to ensure that the perpetrators are brought to justice. Impunity for such crimes must not be tolerated as it only emboldens those who seek to silence journalists and prevent them from fulfilling their crucial role of informing the public."

The 47th Catholic Mass Media Awards will present the Serviam Award posthumously to Juan "Johnny" Dayang at the Citystate Tower Hotel, 1315 A. Mabini Street, Ermita, Manila, on Wednesday, November 19, 2025, at 5:00 PM.

The award will be received by his daughters, Bernadette Dayang and Geraldine E. Dayang-Fernando. Juan E. Dayang, Jr., currently a senior diplomat at the Philippine Embassy in Ankara, Türkiye, is unable to attend.

"This award honors our father's life and work," said Bernadette and Geraldine Dayang. "He lived by the principles of service, faith, and truth. We are proud to continue his legacy."

Laoag City, DOST Showcase Pyrolysis Facility Turning Plastic Waste Into Community Resources

Representatives from DOST and partner institutions conducted a project visit to the facility today, witnessing firsthand how the innovative technology transforms plastic waste into usable resources that benefit both the environment and the community. The visit highlighted the facility's operations and its potential to elevate environmental, economic, and social outcomes for the people of Laoag City.

Developed by DOST, the pyrolysis technology converts plastic waste into fuel and other by-products. For residents, this innovation means cleaner surroundings, reduced landfill waste, minimized pollution, and improved public health. The process also lowers greenhouse gas emissions, contributing to ongoing efforts in climate action. Additionally, the energy and by-products generated can support local operations, opening opportunities for sustainable development and possible employment.

The initiative reflects the core principles of the circular economy—where waste is not discarded but transformed into valuable resources that can be reintegrated into the community. During the visit, stakeholders discussed optimizing the facility for energy efficiency, exploring renewable energy integration, and replicating the technology in other municipalities. 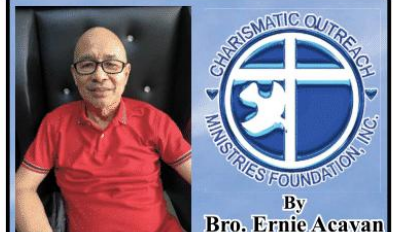

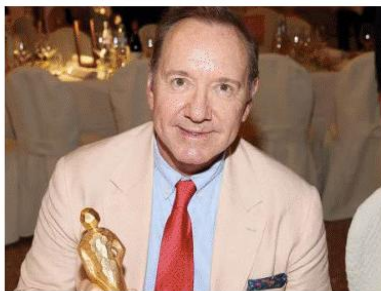

Indeed, Blackpink was in our area over the weekend for their "Deadline" concert tour, and the thousands of Filipino Blinks who packed the Bulacan venue for the first of the two-day affair couldn't have been more thrilled. It had, after all, been two years since the quartet last performed in the country (though Jisoo notably returned on her own just this March for a solo fan meeting).

"It is so lovely to be back. We are so excited to perform here tonight," Rosé told the crowd.

Presented by Live Nation Philippines, the first night of the "Deadline" tour in Bulacan saw the foursome power through 29 songs in just under three hours. The show was divided into five acts, marked by VCR interludes that told the story of the group embarking on a road trip across the desert and a Las Vegas-style cityscape.

That they barely released any new group material since their last tour — having spent much of the past year focused on their solo projects — did little to dampen the fans' enthusiasm. If anything, it proved that one simply never grows tired of Blackpink's music, which often leans into edgy and hard-hitting hip-hop, complete with catchy, shout-along choruses.

Many of the performances were spectacles in their own right, with the girls performing alongside a live band and dozens of dancers, backed by vivid visuals, laser lights and pyrotechnics. During "Kill This Love," for example, pink liquid visuals exploded behind the performers as flames shot up from the front of the stage, accentuating the song's climactic moments.

The expansive screen would also split into four when the girls spread out across the main stage, leaving each member backed by a large panel flashing close-ups of their faces, as seen in "Playing With Fire." A similar effect unfolded during "Stay," with serene sky visuals framing the members as they each took their place atop individual raised platforms while delivering the calming, folksy track that had the entire arena swaying along.

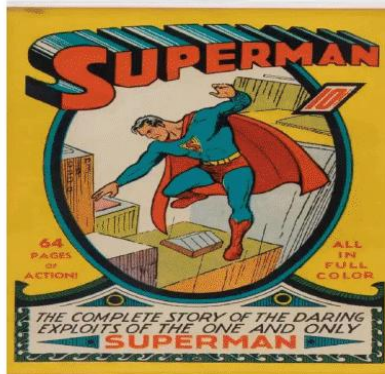
The quartet also made full use of the B-stage and the two walkways that led to it, which wrapped around the VIP pit. They would leisurely make their way toward the B-stage, engaging with nearby fans and occasionally stopping to perform dance routines along the way.

Towards the end of the heartbreak anthem "Lovesick Girls," the girls encouraged the crowd to repeat the chorus while clapping along. "Your turn" or "louder," they'd prompt, though they hardly needed to, given the local crowd's reputation for passionately singing along, which was very much evident throughout the show.

In another instance, while urging the crowd to sing along, Rosé even remarked that Filipinos had "beautiful voices."

But singing along wasn't the only thing Filipino Blinks did. When Blackpink returned to the stage to debut their newest track, "Jump," many in the arena immediately sprang to their feet, leaping in sync with the song's frenzied energy, just as the chorus asked them to.

The setlist also featured the group's debut tracks, "Boombayah" and "Whistle," alongside hits like "Pink Venom," "How You Like That," "Shut Down," "Ddu-Du Ddu-Du" and "As If It's Your Last." Fan-favorite deep cuts, meanwhile, included "Pretty Savage," "Don't Know What To Do," "Forever Young," "Really" and "See U Later."

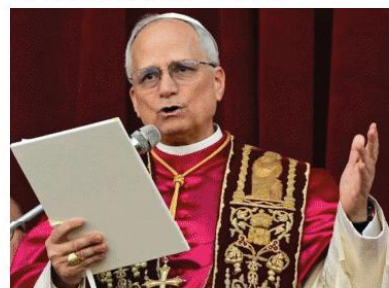

Nagretiro si Nadal noong 2024 matapos ang maha-babang karera sa professional tennis, kung saan isa sa kanyang pinakatanyag na rekord ay ang pagiging World No. 1 sa loob ng 209 linggo.

Future Hall of Famer Chris Paul, magreretiro na sa pagtapos ng 2025-26 NBA season

Inanunsyo ng beteranong NBA guard na si Chris Paul nitong Sabado na ang 2025-26 season na ang kanyang magiging huling taon sa NBA.

Bago ang kanilang laro sa Charlotte, nag-upload ang twelve-time All-Star na tubong North Carolina ng isang video online na naglalaman ng mga mahahalagang highlights mula sa kanyang karera. Tampok dito ang mga sandaling mula nang siya ay ma-draft bilang fourth overall pick noong 2005 NBA Draft.

Sa loob ng halos dalawampung taon sa liga, nag-ukit si Paul ng pangalan bilang isa sa pinakamahasay na point guard sa kasaysayan. Kabilang sa kanyang mga parangal ang: NBA Rookie of the Year (2006). Apat na beses All-NBA first-team, Limang beses na NBA Assist Champion, Anim na beses na Steals Leader, Pitong beses na All-Defensive First Team, NBA All-Star Game MVP (2013)

Nakamit din ni Paul ang

dalawang Olympic gold medals kasama ang Team USA — una noong Beijing 2008 at sumunod noong London 2012. Habang ito naman ay ikalawa sa NBA history sa assists na may 12,532, at ikalawa rin sa steals na may 2,727. Noong 2021, kinilala siya bilang bahagi ng NBA 75th Anniversary Team.

Naglaro si Paul sa pitong iba't-ibang team sa loob ng 20 NBA seasons kinabibilan-

gan ito ng New Orleans Pelicans, Los Angeles Clippers, Houston Rockets, Oklahoma City Thunder, Phoenix Suns, Golden State Warriors at San Antonio Spurs.

Samantala, ngayong season ay pumirma si Paul muli sa Clippers kung limitado nalang ang oras nito sa paglalaro, sa unang sampung laro ay nakakapagtala lamang ito ng 2.5 na puntos kada laro at 3.3 na assist kada laro.



Tyrese Maxey, binuhat ang Sixers sa kaniyang 54-pt explosion vs Bucks



Gumawa ng career high na 54 points si Philadelphia 76ers guard Tyrese Maxey matapos buhatin ang kaniyang koponan laban sa Milwaukee Bucks, 123 – 114.

Napisok ni Maxey ang 18 field goals sa kabuuan ng laban, kasama ang 9 assists, tatlong steals at tatlong blocks. Inabot ng overtime ang laban ng dalawang team, matapos makipagsabayan ang Bucks sa opensa at natapos ang 4th quarter sa score na all-106. Sa pagpasok ng OT, hindi na nakaya ng Bucks ang maintin na opensa ng Sixers sa pangunguna ni Maxey. Sa loob ng maikling panahon (5 mins), nagawa ng Sixers na magpasok ng 17 points habang tanging walong puntos lamang ang naisagot ng 2021 NBA champion.

Nasayang ang double-double performance ng sophomore NBA player na si Ryan Rollins sa tuluyang pagkatalo ng Bucks.

Ibinabad si Rollins sa loob ng 40 minutes, at nagawa niyang magpasok ng 13 field goals na katumbas ng 32 points habang ipinose rin nito ang 14 assists. Sa naturang laban, kapwa hindi nakapaglaro ang star player ng dalawang koponan na sina Joel Embiid at Giannis Antetokounmpo.

Sa kabila nito ay parehong nagpakita ng impresyong opensa ang dalawa kung saan napanatili ng Bucks ang 49% shooting habang umabot sa 43% ang Sixers.

Naging malaking bentahe lamang ng Philadelphia ang 21 free throws na napasok sa kabuuan ng laban habang umabot lamang sa sampung libre ang Bucks.
