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Farmers, fisherfolks receive over P47 million worth of interventions in Bulacan

CITY OF MALOLOS — More than 700 members of farmers and fisherfolks cooperatives and associations in the province received agricultural and fisheries assistance during the 'Distribution of Agriculture and Fisheries Interventions' held yesterday, November 19, 2025, at the Bulacan Sports Complex, Sta. Isabel in this city, as part of the Provincial Government of Bulacan's, through the Provincial Agriculture Office's, continuing efforts to uplift the livelihood of agricultural workers and boost local food production.



Qualified beneficiaries, who underwent careful evaluation and validation, were given various farm machineries and fisheries equipment totaling to P10,414,800.00, funded by the Provincial Government of Bulacan, and aimed at supporting their operations and increasing productivity, including 643 pieces of gillnets, 58 units of marine engines, 50 units of cisterns, 27 units of water pumps (STW), 12 units of grasscutters, 10 units of hand tractors, six units of portable rice mills, and four solar-powered irrigation systems.

Additional support from partner national agencies was also turned over, wherein the Philippine Center for Postharvest Development and Mechanization (PhilMech) provided four units of 4-wheel drive tractors amounting to P35,779,000.00; while the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) distributed 20 units of fiberglass reinforced plastic (FRP) boats equipped with 12HP engines worth P1,300,000.

He highlighted how TIP continues to create innovations that directly contribute to smarter cities and improved community living conditions.

DOST Undersecretary for Regional Operations Engr. Sancho A. Mabborang followed with an introduction of the Department's ILAW Framework for Smart and Sustainable Communities, which stands for Inclusive economies, Learning governance, Adaptive and regenerative planet, and Well-being of people and communities. He described the framework as a strategic guide for local development in the region.

DOST Secretary Dr. Renato U. Solidum Jr. delivered the keynote address, urging stakeholders to ensure that technological progress benefits all sectors of society. "Development

needs to be highly contextualized, and ergonomically designed to fit the needs of the people with varied local realities. When solutions are designed this way, they are considered 'smart,'" he said. The ceremony also witnessed a series of launches and partnership agreements that showcased DOST-NCR's ongoing initiatives. Among these were the turnover of TIP ADAPT tools for MSMEs, the turnover of Smart STI Plans for Pasig City and Caloocan City, the formal adoption of GeoRisk PH for NCR local government units through a partnership between DOST-NCR and PHIVOLCS, the launch of the DOST-NCR CITIES360 Program, and a collaboration with Sentinel and BEST Inc. promoting circular economy initiatives in Metro Manila.

A highlight of the program was "Lakbay Disenyo: From Threads to Treads," a sustainable footwear showcase organized by the Philippine Footwear Federation Inc. and the DOST-Philippine Textile Research Institute, demonstrating locally developed innovations in the footwear and textile industries.

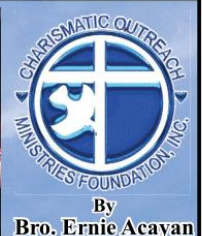

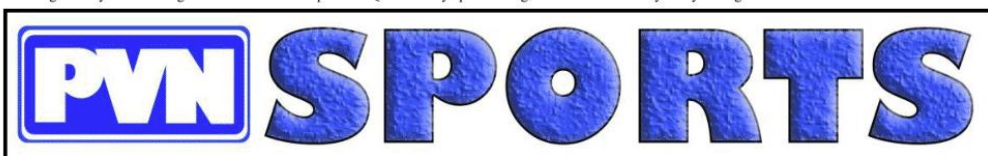

PSC tiwalang makakahakot maraming medalya ang Pilipinas sa SEA Games

Umaasa ang Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) na mahihigitan ng Pilipinas ang nahakot nilang medalya noong 2023 Southeast Asian Games sa Cambodia.

Sa ginawang send-off ceremony ng 1,600 na Philippine team na sasabak sa SEA Games sa Bangkok, Thailand ay sinabi ni PSC chair Patrick Gregorio na kayang higitan ang ating manlalaro ang nagdaang medalya.

Sa nagdaang Cambodia SEA Games ay nakakuha ang Pilipinas ng 58 gold, 86 silver at 116 bronze medals.

Inanunsiyo din ni Gregorio na mayroong P6,000 na dagdag na allowance sa lahat ng mga atleta at coaches na sasabak sa Thailand at mayroon ding P18,000 na Christmas bonus.

Ang nasabing halaga ay bukod pa sa P26,000 na kanilang matatanggap bilang SEA Games stipend.

Petro Gazz reclaims Reinforced glory by taking down Zus Coffee

Petro Gazz, known for being a powerhouse in PVL Reinforced Conferences, reclaimed its past glory and is now back on top of the import-laced tournament.

The Angels took down a youthful Zus Coffee side, 21-25, 28-26, 25-23, 25-20, to win their third Reinforced title—after missing out on a chance to defend their crown for a three-peat last year.

This marks their fourth overall PVL title, as they also won the 2024-25 All-Filipino contest, and the most first-place finishes in Reinforced Conferences, surpassing Creamline which has two crowns.

It was an up-and-down campaign for the Brooke Van Sickle-led squad, as they started 3-2 in Pool B, but peaked at the right time and earned the No. 5 seed following the conclusion of the two-round preliminaries.

En route to the finish line, they had to dethrone reigning champion Creamline in the quarterfinals and take out eventual bronze medalist Akari in the semifinals.

"I mean, it's awesome, I said in the beginning, 'let's run it back,' and I wouldn't say I was half-joking, but it's like you never know what's going to happen," said Lindsey Vander Weide after becoming the first PVL import to become a two-time league champion.

"And just the fact that we had such a weird start and a weird middle of the season, for us to pull it out and beat some of the top teams in the end just shows how much grit this team has," she added.

"We started a little slow, but we battled in the second. A couple of times, I think we had a little doubt, but the girls just kept focused, stayed together, and kept their unity. We just chipped away at it," said head coach Gary Van Sickle, who is already a PVL champion in just his first conference.

"But I think earlier in the year, we were [3-2], so those battles kind of helped us to fight for this one. So, I'm just proud of the girls.

They did awesome," he added.

Despite a slow start against Zus Coffee in the finale, losing the opener to the rallying Thunderbells, they regained their footing in the second set onwards.

But it had to go the hard way, as the Thunderbells were on pace to seal a 2-0 lead after they reached set point twice in that frame.

Vander Weide was there to knot things up, 26-11, as Anna DeBeer's attack unfortunately sailed out, and Ranya Musa nailed the gutsy kill block on Thea Gagarte to steal that frame at 28-26.

Step by step, the Angels slowly pulled away in Set 4, as Vander Weide powered Petro Gazz to championship point after a kill and sit on a 24-19 lead.

AC Miner kpt her team in the game with a sharp hit in the middle, but Myla Pablo was there for the championship-winning down-the-line kill to finally put the Thunderbells to sleep, walking away with the title.

Ball distribution was on point as rookie playmaker Jules Tolentino tallied 20 excellent sets, enabling her spikers and blockers throughout the game.

Vander Weide registered a match-high 23 points and nine excellent receptions, Van Sickle had 20 points and seven excellent receptions, MJ Phillips delivered 17 points, and Pablo had a double-double of 14 markers and 11 excellent digs.

"I'm really proud of our team for just having that grit and staying locked in and focusing when it really matters. And, I mean, it just goes to show, it doesn't matter how you start in a season, it just matters how you finish. So, I'm really proud of everyone," said Van Sickle.

On the other hand, it was an almost for the young Zus Coffee squad, but experience prevailed this time DeBeer, who was spectacular all-conference-long, had 18 points, Miner had 16 markers, and Gagarte chipped in 11 points for the losing cause.
