DOST Strengthens Synergy of Balik Scientist Program and S&T Fellows During the 2025 NSTW

What could have been a routine program instead became a space where participants recognized that strengthening research and development begins with strengthening connections.

The event opened with institutional messages that set a strong tone for the day. Undersecretary Leah J. Buendia emphasized the importance of integrated expertise and collaboration in shaping the country's national research priorities, a reminder that R&D grows when programs work in harmony rather than in isolation. This was echoed by DOST Secretary Renato U. Solidum Jr., who described scientific discovery as something rooted in curiosity but made impactful when turned into solutions for real societal needs. His message underscored

the unique contributions of the Balik Scientist Program and the S&T Fellows Program, both of which expand technical expertise and provide vital support across regions.

Much of the program's heart continued through interactive sessions such as "Challenges ni Kuya" and "Nomination/Big Night ni Kuya." These activities encouraged participants to work together on scenario-based tasks that mirrored real challenges in science and technology. In these moments, teamwork and idea-sharing came naturally, revealing how collaboration strengthens R&D by allowing individuals to combine perspectives, test solutions, and approach problems with shared creativity. The energy in the room demonstrated that research

becomes more meaningful when sparked by collective effort.

The activity concluded with the awarding of certificates, group photos, and networking moments that felt warm and hopeful. In his closing message, Undersecretary Teodoro M. Gatchalian encouraged continued partnerships and R&D efforts that uplift communities, reinforcing the day's core message: that progress grows when people commit to working together. As participants left the venue, the strengthened linkages, shared insights, and new collaborations formed during the activity became quiet but powerful steps toward a more connected and impactful research landscape for the regions and the nation. The pursuit of accurate measurements and consumer protection took center stage as the Local Government Unit of Manolo Fortich hosted a vital Training on the Verification of Non-Automatic Weighing Instruments on November 19-20, 2025, held at Dreams Residences, San Miguel, Manolo Fortich. Twenty-five dedicated participants, comprising LGU employees and representatives from the local Public Market Vendor Association, gathered to enhance their knowledge and practical skills in metrology. The training was expertly facilitated by the DOST-Northern Mindanao, specifically the Regional Metrology Laboratory of RSTL, with Mr. Ronald A. Pangan and Mr. Jefferson A. Lumor serving as the knowledgeable speakers and trainers, providing compre-

hensive lectures and practical demonstrations.

This two-day activity is crucial for upholding the integrity of commercial transactions within the LGU. The learning sessions equipped the participants with the necessary expertise to accurately verify weighing instruments, ensuring that consumers receive the correct quantity for the price they pay. The training culminates in a significant practical application: on the second day, the newly trained team will conduct a surprise inspection in the local market. This hands-on exercise is designed to immediately translate their acquired knowledge into real-world action, reinforcing the LGU's commitment to fair trade practices and consumer trust.

In an age drowning in misinformation, their calling has never been more vital.

Held on December 3-4, 2025 at The Greenery in Baliwag, Bulacan, this year's gathering of the Publishers Association of the Philippines, Inc. (PAPI) was more than an annual event—it was a reunion of truth-seekers, a summit of storytellers, and a testament to the enduring power of Philippine journalism.

The theme, "Unmasking Deception: The Role of Investigative Media in Exposing Fake News and Corruption," set the tone for a congress that was both reflective and forward-looking.

A Ceremony That Set the Stage

Day 1 opened with the solemn Entry of Colors by Bulacan State University, followed by a heartfelt doxology by Pastor Elpedio B. Soriano Jr. As the AVP played the National Anthem and the PAPI Hymn, delegates paused—perhaps remembering the honor and responsibility behind their work.

Congress Director Alma Ochotorena welcomed the participants, but the moment grew more emotional when the assembly turned its attention to a man whose legacy continues to guide PAPI.

A Tribute to a Fallen Pillar of Journalism

PAPI President Rebecca Velasquez opened the ceremony followed by Vice President for Mindanao Anila Anne Acosta who introduced the guest of honor Governor Daniel R. Fernando, though unable to attend in person,

Media leaders, government officials, and innovators echoed their support throughout the night.

A major highlight was the awarding of P30,000 in raffle prizes and in-kind items, administered by PAPI Vice President for Visayas, Ms. Giecel Toriano-Albar. Donations from supporters across the country showcased how far the community of journalism advocates extends.

Base sa mga nakalap na dokumento, napaulat na ipinangnak si Co noong Marso 10, 1966 sa Clinica Santo Niño sa Pagadian City. Ang kaniyang ama ay natukoy na si Co Tek Chun at ang kaniyang ina ay si Co Sy Suat Kim.

Nang siyasin ang ilang mga dokumento tulad ng birth, marriage at death certificates ng kaniyang mga magulang, walang nahanap, at ang kaniyang magulang ay inilbing sa isang Chinese cemetery sa Pagadian City.

PhilHealth, ikinatuwa ang desisyon ng SC; pondo sa susunod na taon aabot sa P113-B

Ibig sabihin, mainit at humid na may mga pag-ulan sa bandang hapon dulot ng thunderstorms ang mararanansan lalo na sa Southern Luzon at Mindanao. Sa Metro Manila naman, makakaranas pa rin ng kalat-kalat na pag-ulan ngayong Lunes at sa Miyerkules, at maulap na kalangitan bukas, at possible ang rain showers sa Huwebes at Biyernes at mainit at tuyong panahon naman sa weekend.

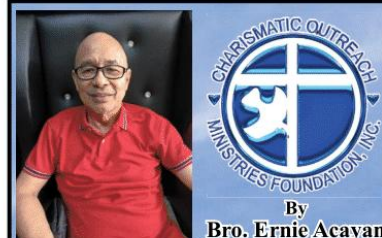

Natigil ang labanan noon matapos maging epektibo ang ceasefire deal na inareglo nina Malaysian Prime Minister Anwar Ibrahim at Trump, na kapwa sinaksihan ang paglagda sa expanded peace agreement sa pagitan ng dalawang bansa sa Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia noong Oktubre.

ers ang laban. Samantala, sa naging laban ng Raptors at Lakers ay nagbuhos ng 44 points at sampung assists ang bagitong guard na si Austin Reaves, kasama rito ang 13 free throws. Pinangunahan ni Reaves ang kanyang koponan, kapalit ni Luka Doncic na hindi muna pinaglaro dahil sa mild injury.

Nasayang naman ang halos triple-double performance ni Raptors guard Scottie Barnes na nagbalsa ng 23 points, 11 rebounds, at siyam na assists. Ang panalo ng Lakers ang ika-16 ngayong season habang nananatili sa lima ang pagkatalo nito. Tangan ng Raptors ang 15-8 win-loss record.

Amid eligibility woes, POC chief keeps faith in Gilas Pilipinas

The president of the Philippine Olympic Committee (POC) has no doubt that Gilas Pilipinas can defend its men's basketball gold in the 2025 Southeast Asian Games, even without a naturalized player in their roster.

"Gilas can win the title again — and I believe that," POC President Abraham "Bambol" Tolentino told reporters on Monday after the SEA Games Council meeting at the Grand Four Wings Hotel in Bangkok, Thailand.

"It is still painful not to see some of our players, but Gilas Pilipinas can still do it. They will still be the champion," he added.

Gilas is coached by multi-titled

mentor Norman Black for the 33rd edition of the SEA Games.

Their title defense starts on Sunday against Malaysia at 11:30 a.m., followed by the game against Vietnam on Monday at the same time at the Nimibutr Stadium.

The Philippines ran into eligibility issues heading into the SEA Games, as Thai organizers banned naturalized player Justin Brownlee, as well as TNT's Brandon Ganuelas-Rosser and De La Salle big man Michael Phillips.

Black will rely on a roster composed of: Thirdy Ravena, Matthew Wright, Bobby Ray Parks Jr., Jamie Malonzo, Von Pessumal, Robert Bolick, Justin Chua, Dalph Panopio, Abu Tratter, Saint

Benilde's Allen Bryant Liwag, Far Eastern University's Veejay Pre, and Adamson University's Cedrick Manzano.

The Philippine team will fly to Bangkok on Thursday from Manila, according to Black.

According to Tolentino, they have no idea regarding the lineup of the other teams — Pool A teams Malaysia, and Vietnam; and Pool B teams Indonesia, Singapore, Myanmar, and host Thailand.

Gilas had ceded its crown in the 2022 SEA Games in Hanoi before regaining it a year later in Cambodia, beating the host nation 80-69 behind a 23-point, seven-rebound effort from Brownlee in the gold medal game.

Nasayang naman ang 23 points ni Pascal Siakam at 16 points ni Andrew Nembhard na hindi sapat para buhatin ang Pacers tungo sa panalo.
