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DOST, PSU launch country's first ASIN R&D Center in Binmaley

BINMALEY, Pangasinan — The country's first ASIN (Salt) Research and Development Center was formally launched on February 17, 2026 at the Pangasinan State University (PSU) Binmaley Campus, marking one of the key highlights of the 2026 Regional Science, Technology, and Innovation Week (RSTW) in the Ilocos Region.

The establishment of the ASIN Center celebrates PSU's recognition as a national hub for salt research and development, in partnership with the Department of Science and Technology (DOST).

PSU President Dr. Elbert M. Galas underscored that the initiative is firmly grounded in a strong legal and policy framework, particularly Republic Act No. 8172 or the ASIN Law, which mandates the iodization of salt to eliminate iodine deficiency disorders and safeguard public health. He emphasized that salt is not only a public health imperative but also an economic resource with vast potential for local industries.

DOST Ilocos Regional Director Dr. Teresita A. Tabago recalled the region's efforts to revitalize the salt industry through consultations and strategic implementation of DOST programs. Through the ONEASIN Program of DOST Ilocos, salt producers in Pangasinan were strengthened, paving the way for the province to host the first ASIN R&D Center in the Philippines.

Representing the Office of the Executive Director of the DOST-Philippine Council for Industry, Energy and Emerging Technology Research and Development (DOST-PCIERD), Engr. Nihaliza H. Escorial described the center as a strategic step toward revitalizing and strengthening the Philippine salt industry.

Binmaley Municipal Mayor Hon. Pedro Herrera III, represented by Municipal Administrator Atty. Franco Francisco, expressed appreciation to DOST and highlighted that PSU serves as the showcase of the project, which is expected to open more opportunities for the municipality and the region. He also noted its potential contribution to clean and potable water solutions.

Pangasinan Governor Hon. Ramon Guico III, represented by Assistant Provincial Agriculturist Mr. Nestor P. Batalla, emphasized that salt holds a special place in the province's identity, noting that Pangasinan literally means place where salt is made. The provincial government affirmed its full support for the initiative and its role as a member of the ASIN Center Steering Committee.

DOST Undersecretary for Regional Opera-

tions Engr. Sancho A. Mabborang highlighted the importance of accelerating technology transfer to ensure scalability and enhance local livelihoods.

Philippine Coconut Authority Administrator Dr. Dexter R. Buted explained that the agency relies on locally sourced salt, including supply from Pangasinan, particularly for agricultural-grade salt needed in coconut fertilization projects. He stressed the need for stronger integration, synergy, and convergence among agencies to revive the salt industry, which also supports the coconut sector as one of the country's leading agricultural exports.

DOST Undersecretary for Research and Development Usec. Leah J. Buendia said the initiative goes beyond boosting salt production and focuses on empowering communities. She aligned the project with DOST's three-horizon strategy, which seeks to expand salt farms, meet growing demand, drive economic growth, and safeguard the environment. PSU is expected to lead in disseminating salt technologies to stakeholders.

Department of Agrarian Reform Secretary Conrado M. Estrella III, represented by Hon. Gilbert Estrella, conveyed full support for the project and recognized the renewed appreciation for the potential of the salt industry.

In his keynote message, DOST Secretary Dr. Renato U. Solidum Jr. emphasized that revitalizing the Philippine salt industry remains a national priority. He cited the challenge that the country imports around 93 percent of its salt requirements while producing only about 7 percent locally. He stressed the need to scale up production, encourage technology adopters, and develop new technologies for salt processing, including innovations that integrate salt production with potable water solutions.

The ASIN R&D Center will serve as a modern hub for salt science and technology, supporting research and development, technology deployment, and innovation-driven solutions to strengthen local salt industries and empower salt-making communities.

The inauguration also featured the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding between DOST and PSU, further solidifying their partnership in advancing salt research and development in the Philippines.

With strong collaboration among national agencies, the provincial government, and the academe, the launch of the ASIN R&D Center positions Pangasinan at the forefront of efforts to revitalize the salt industry, promote food security, and drive sustainable economic growth. (Nelson Santos)

DOST, Cong. Caogdan Explore Innovation Support for Coconut and Cattle Industries in Cotabato Dost

Through the Department of Science and Technology Region XII (DOST SOCCSKSARGEN), Hon. Rudy S. Caogdan, Representative of the Second District of Cotabato and member of the House Committee on Science and Technology, paid a courtesy visit to the Department of Science and Technology Central Office in Bicutan, Taguig to explore science-driven opportunities that can accelerate agricultural and industrial development in his district.

Congressman Caogdan together with DOST SOCCSKSARGEN Regional Director Engr. Sammy P. Malawan met with DOST Secretary Renato U. Solidum Jr., Regional Operations Undersecretary Sancho A. Mabborang, Countryside Development Assistant Secretary Engr. Maria Teresa B. De Guzman and Annabelle V. Briones, Executive Director of the Industrial Technology Development Institute (ITDI), to discuss potential collaborations that would harness innovation for coconut processing and cattle production in Cotabato Province.

As one of the key agricultural provinces in SOCCSKSARGEN, Cotabato has strong potential to move beyond raw commodity production toward value-added processing. Discussions highlighted the need to enhance coconut processing technologies to improve extraction efficiency, product quality, and



compliance with national and international standards.

By leveraging ITDI's expertise in food processing, packaging, testing, and national metrology, local farmers and micro, small, and medium enterprises (MSMEs) can be supported in developing higher-value coconut products such as virgin coconut oil, coco sugar, flour, and other derivative products that command stronger market demand. The collaboration aims to ensure that producers are not limited to selling copra or raw nuts, but are empowered to participate in processing, branding, and commercialization.

Beyond coconut, the meeting also highlighted the need to strengthen Cotabato's cattle industry. Recognizing the province's growing livestock sector, Congressman Caogdan sought DOST's support in modernizing cattle

production and meat processing through science-based interventions.

Discussions focused on research-driven feed formulation, food safety testing, meat preservation, and improved packaging to enhance productivity, ensure quality standards, and expand market access. Integrating technology across the livestock value chain is seen as key to increasing farmer incomes and supporting regional food security.

Following the meeting, the delegation toured ITDI's state-of-the-art laboratories and technical divisions, where they were briefed on available technologies ready for adoption and commercialization. The visit showcased ITDI's capabilities in industrial research and development, standards and testing services, materials science, chemical and analytical ser-

vices, food innovation, and national metrology — core pillars in strengthening local industries and accelerating economic growth.

The convergence reflects a shared commitment to building an integrated innovation ecosystem that bridges national research institutions with grassroots communities.

With coconut and cattle identified as strategic growth drivers, Cotabato Province is positioning itself for a transition toward science-enabled, value-added agriculture. Through strengthened partnerships between national R&D institutions and local leadership, the province moves closer to transforming its natural resources into sustainable economic opportunities — demonstrating that from research laboratories to rural livelihoods, innovation is shaping the future of Cotabato.

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Building a Matatag and Maginhawa Future Through STI at Ilocos Region's RSTW 2026



The Department of Science and Technology (DOST) officially opened the 2026 Regional Science, Technology, and Innovation Week (RSTW) in the Ilocos Region on February 16 at CSI Stadia, convening national and local leaders, academic institutions, industry partners, and innovators under the theme "Siyensya, Teknolohiya, at Inobasyon: Kabalik sa Matatag, Maginhawa, at Panatag na Kinabukasan," with the sub-theme Building Smart and Sustainable Communities.

In her welcome remarks, Belen T. Fernandez, Mayor of Dagupan City, underscored the city's commitment to innovation-driven governance. She emphasized that a smart city is defined not only by digital systems or modern infrastructure, but by how knowledge and innovation generate employment, protect the environment, improve public services, and empower the youth.

Teresita A. Tabao, DOST Ilocos Regional Director, highlighted that the early celebration of RSTW was made possible through Dagupan City's proactive partnership with DOST. A major highlight of the event was the launch of the first-ever DOST Niche Centers in the Regions (NICER) Salt Research and Development Center in Pangasinan, an initiative designed to strengthen the province's salt industry and research capacity. She stressed that collaboration with local governments and

communities remains essential in building smart and sustainable communities. Delivering the inspirational message on behalf of Pangasinan Governor Ramon V. Guico III, Raymundo D. Rovillos, President of Pangasinan Polytechnic College, affirmed that the province's innovation agenda is people-centered. He cited the revitalization of salt-making initiatives and announced the upcoming launch of the PPC-DOST iHub, envisioned as a premier training ground and entrepreneurial incubator for the region's emerging technology leaders.

Ana Carmela Ventura-Remigio, Presidential Assistant Secretary for Northern Luzon, emphasized that science, technology, and innovation (STI) are critical to achieving a future that is resilient, prosperous, and secure. She noted the alignment between national development goals and DOST's four pillars, stressing that innova-

tion must be purposeful and directed toward meaningful progress. In his keynote address, Renato U. Solidum Jr., DOST Secretary, highlighted Pangasinan's historical connection to salt production—derived from the word "asin"—as a symbol of how science and innovation are deeply rooted in local knowledge and livelihoods. He encouraged local governments, researchers, educators, and students to continue transforming science into practical solutions and ideas into opportunities for inclusive regional growth. The program also featured reports from current STI Ambassadors of Region I, the conferment of new STI Ambassadors from academia, government, industry, and the environmental sector, and the awarding of STI assistance to partner institutions, including Universidad de Dagupan, Pangasinan Polytechnic College, and the Dagupan City Government.

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Ceremonial highlights included the distribution of STARBOOKS units, the Water Compendium and TOUR-LISTA platforms, the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding for the institutionalization of MAGHANDA for KIDS, and the launch of the SOLIDO Knowledge Hub.

During the press conference, Mayor Fernandez expressed gratitude to DOST and its Ilocos Regional Office for hosting RSTW in Dagupan. She emphasized the strengthened partnership in advancing the city as a smart and sustainable community through science- and data-driven solutions tailored to local needs. She cited the establishment of science-focused schools to promote early STI education, the adoption of DOST-developed Disaster Risk Reduction and Management technologies to improve preparedness and mitigation, and the implementation of science-based waste management programs to support environmental sustainability—initiatives fully backed by Secretary Solidum and the DOST community.

Running until February 18, the 2026 RSTW features technology exhibits, forums, and partnership-building activities aimed at strengthening agriculture, industry, education, tourism, and disaster resilience. The event reaffirms that in the Ilocos Region, science and innovation remain essential partners in building a smarter and more sustainable future. (Nelson Santos)

Idiniin ng International Criminal Court (ICC) na si dating Pangulong Rodrigo Duterte ay may direktang kontrol at nagbigay ng suportang pinansyal sa malawakang patayan sa ilalim ng kanyang anti-narcotics campaign.

Sa isinagawang confirmation of charges hearing nitong Lunes na hindi dinaluhan ni Duterte, ipinunto ni ICC Prosecutor Mame Mandiaye Niang na pinopondohan at personal na tinutukoy ng dating pangulo ang mga target ng Davao Death Squad o DDS.

Ayon kay Niang, mahalaga ang kontribusyon ni Duterte para ma-neutralize ang mga kriminal sa Pilipinas sa pamamagitan ng pagpatay.

Biniyang-diin ng prosecutor na bukod sa regular salary, nakakatanggap din umano ng cash per head ang mga direktang salarin na sumusunod sa utos dahil sa takot, pabuya, o bulag na katapatan.

Patunay rin umano ng ganap na kapangyarihan ni Duterte ang pagbabala ng kaso ng patayan nang ipasuspinde niya nang dalawang beses ang operasyon. Nahaharap si Duterte sa tatlong bilang ng crimes against humanity dahil sa kawalan ng due process para sa mga biktima. Ayon sa tala ng gobyerno, aabot sa 6,200 ang napatay sa drug war, ngunit iginigit ng human rights groups na posibleng pumalo ito sa 30,000. Itutulong ang mga pagdinig sa Pebrero 24, 26, at 27.



DA inilunsad ang P20/kilo na bigas sa barangay level sa Davao City

Sinimulan na ng Department of Agriculture (DA) ang barangay-level rollout ng P20 kada kilo na bigas sa Davao City, bilang pagpapalawak ng programang "Benteng Bigas, Meron Na!" ng administrasyon.

Unang isinagawa ang distribusyon sa Barangay Matina Crossing at sinundan sa Barangay Tungkulan sa Toril District noong Pebrero 20, sa pangunguna ni Assistant Secretary for Agribusiness, Marketing and Consumer Affairs Genevieve Velicara-Guevarra, kasama ang mga opisyal ng barangay at kinatawan ng National Food Authority (NFA) at Food Terminal Corporation (FTI).

Ayon kay Guevarra, mahalaga ang aktibong partisipasyon ng lokal na pamahalaan upang matiyak na makarating ang subsidized rice sa mga target na benepisyaryo tulad ng mga indigent, senior citizen, persons with disabilities, minimum wage earner at solo parents. Aniya, nakatulong umano ang P20 Benteng bigas masterlist registry system, isang online registry ng mga benepisyaryo upang mapabilis ang beripikasyon at pagbili ng bigas.

Ipinaliwang ng DA na napapanahon ang pagpapalawak ng distribusyon dahil puno umano ang mga bodega ng NFA. Sa pamamagitan ng mas mabilis na paglalabas ng suplay sa mga barangay, nababawasan ang laman ng mga warehouse at nabibigyang-daan ang patuloy na pagbili ng palay mula sa lokal na magsasaka.

Target ng pamahalaan na makinabang ang hanggang 60 milyong Pilipino sa programa ngayong taon, at plano itong ipagapatuloy hanggang sa Hunyo 2028.

Sa naganap na preliminary investigation hinggil sa plunder case, ibinahagi ng tagapagsalita na hindi nagsumite si Sen. Jinggoy Estrada ng kanyang kontra-salaysay.

Habang intasan naman ng prosekusyon ang NBI na bigyan ng kopya ang mga respondents ng kaniang isasamang mga karagdagang ebidensya sa reklamo.

Biniyang sila ng ilang araw lamang hanggang sa ika-26 ng Pebrero, sa kasalukuyang taon 2026.

Kaya naman sa oras na mabigyan na ng kopya ang mga respondents, pagtitiyak ng Department of Justice na sila'y mayroong panahon at pagkakataon upang ito'y sa-

gutin. Ani Justice Spokesperson Martinez, ang mga respondents ay maaring magsumite ng kaniang mga kontra-salaysay ng hindi lalagapas sa itinakdang araw na ika-9 sa buwan ng Marso. Ang nabanggit na petsa ay ang susunod na isasagawang preliminary investigation kaugnay sa reklamo ng kinakaharap ng senador kasama pati ilang mga dating opisyal.

Bukod kay Senador Jinggoy Estrada, kapwa niya respondents maging sina former Department of Public Works and Highways Secretary Manuel Bonoan, former Public Works officials Roberto Bernardo, Gerard Oplencia, Henry Alcantara, at John/Jane Does.

Maging ang namayapang si former Public Works Usec. Catalina Cabral ay kabilang rin sa mga sinampahan ng Natiional Bureau of Investigation-Department of Justice Bid-Rigging Task Force.

Partikular na kaniang kinakaharap ang mga reklamo ng plunder, paglalagab sa Section 3(e) ng Republic Act

3019 o ang Anti-Graft and Corrupt Practices Act, Receiving Gifts by Public Officers at Corruption of Public Officers.

Kaugnay nito, tumanggap ibahagi naman ni Justice Spokesperson Martinez ang mga idinagdag ng kawanihan na mga pangalan bilang panibagong respondents sa reklamo.

Pinayuhan ni Catholic Bishops Conference of the Philippines (CBCP) Caritas Philippines Episcopal Commission on Social Action, Justice & Peace (ECSA-JP) President Bishop Gerardo Alminaza ang mga pamilya ng mga biktima ng drug war na magkakatag at lakasan ang loob, kasabay ng nakatakdang pagsisimula ng confirmation of charges hearing laban kay dating Pangulong Rodrigo Duterte ngayong Pebrero 23.

Sa misang ginanap sa Our Lady of Remedies Church sa Malate, Maynila, na pinangunahan ni Bishop Alminaza para sa mga biktima, hinimok niya ang mga pamilya na manatiling matibay habang gumugulong ang proseso ng hustisiya para sa kanilang mga mahal sa buhay.

Aniya, mahalagang manindigan ang mga pamilya sa pagsasabi ng katotohanan tungkol sa nangyari sa ilalim ng kontrobersyal na drug war. Dagdag pa ng obispo, kailangan nila ng sapat na lakas ng loob dahil sa patuloy na pananakot at pangungutya—

Tinukoy din niya ang ICC bilang isang angkop na forum na nagbibigay ng pag-asa para sa mga biktima at sa mga Pilipinong patuloy na nakikipaglaban para sa proteksyon ng karapatang pantao.

Under investigation pa naman 'yun," ani Magno. Nauna nang inanusyo ng NBI na naghain sila ng cyberlibel complaint laban kina Jay Sonza at Eric Celiz dahil sa umano'y pagpapakalat ng pekeng medical records. Ayon sa ahensya, naihan na ang reklamo sa prosecutor's office. Nilinaw naman ni Magno na hiwalay ang isinasagawang imbestigasyon sa kaso ni Argota. Sa-

mantala, sa isang video na in-upload sa social media, nagpasalamat si Argota kay Magno at sa mga opisyal ng NBI. "Maraming salamat po, NBI Director Magno, at nauunawaan niyo 'yung pinaglalaman ko. Pasensya na rin kayo na naabala ko... guys, ang NBI hindi kalaban. Sumusunod lang 'yan sa utos, kaya 'wag kayong mag-isip nang masama," ani Argota. "Wala pang inilalabas na karagdagang detalye ang mga awtoridad hinggil sa resulta ng pagdingin, ngunit inaasahang magpatuloy ang imbestigasyon sa mga sununod na araw."

Spurs overpower Pistons in clash of NBA's form teams

Victor Wembanyama led a defensive masterclass as the San Antonio Spurs out-muscled the Detroit Pistons 114-103 Monday in an intense and aggressive clash between the NBA's two most in-form teams.

Sitting second in the Western Conference, the Spurs were pushed hard for their ninth-straight victory by the East-topping Pistons, who had entered the home court matchup on a five-win streak of their own.

Defenses dominated the first meeting between the two sides this season, with the 7-foot-5 Wembanyama making six blocks and 17 rebounds to fuel transitions as



the Spurs pulled clear in the latter stages.

While the Pistons' shooting was at times sloppy, Devin Vassell led the Spurs' offense, with 28 points including seven three-pointers -- as many as the entire Detroit team managed collectively.

"They tried to impose their will. We tried to get out on transition, keep getting stops, find an open man. That's what we did," said Vassell.

The Spurs had raced to a 12-point lead from tip-off. But they trailed by the end of the first quarter, setting the tone for a fiercely contested back-and-forth game.

Late in the second quarter, Cade Cunningham barged Stephon Castle to the floor, angering Spurs teammate Keldon Johnson who earned a technical foul for retaliating.

But the Pistons' defense kept them in the game, putting Wembanyama under particular pressure. The French prodigy struggled to make an offensive mark on the early action.

San Antonio took a slender lead into half-time. The contest tightened further in the third quarter.
