# DOST, Intramuros launch PH-made electric 'e-tranvia' for heritage tourism



MANILA, Philippines — In a move toward sustainable transport and heritage tourism, the Department of Science and Technology (DOST), in partnership with the Intramuros Administration (IA), officially unveiled the country's first Filipino-engineered all-electric tourist transport vehicle, or "e-tranvia," on March 19 in Intramuros, Manila.

The 18-seater, low-speed, battery-electric vehicle is designed to navigate the historic streets of the Walled City, blending modern innovation with cultural preservation.

Developed through a collaboration among DOST-National Capital Region (NCR), the DOST-Industrial Technology Development Institute (ITDI), the University of the Philippines Diliman (UPD), and Cagayan State University (CSU), the e-tranvia

highlights Filipino ingenuity in sustainable mobility solutions.

Intramuros Administrator Atty. Joan M. Padilla emphasized the importance of partnerships between government and academe in delivering

people-centered innovations.

"This collaboration reflects the strength of partnerships between the government and the academe in delivering practical and people-centered solutions," Padilla said, expressing hope that the project would inspire further efforts toward greener mobility and smarter tourism systems.

Designed to echo the tranvias that once operated in Intramuros in the late 19th century, the vehicle complements the historic atmosphere of the area while offering an environmentally friendly alternative to traditional diesel-powered transport.

CSU led the conceptualization and structural development of the e-tranvia, including the vehicle frame, suspension system, and body paneling. The body and roofing panels utilize abaca fiber composite material, an innovation developed by DOST-ITDI.

Meanwhile, UPD handled the electrical and electronic systems, equipping the vehicle with a lithium-ion battery, electric motor, controller, and charging infrastructure—effectively eliminating reliance on fossil fuels.

Science and Technology Secretary Renato U. Solidum Jr. underscored the role of such innovations in addressing rising fuel costs and supply concerns, while promoting accessible electric

mobility across the country.

He also highlighted the importance of strengthening research and development in e-mobility, expanding charging infrastructure, and sustaining partnerships with higher education institutions. At present, Intramuros has deployed one e-tranvia unit, with three additional units expected to arrive soon. Additional units are also planned for deployment in South Cotabato, Cagayan province, and Malacañang Palace, according to CSU President Dr. Arthur G. Ibañez.

The initial material cost of each unit is estimated at P2.5 million. DOST-NCR Regional Director Engr. Romel T. Tresvalles said efforts are underway to secure private sector partnerships to support large-scale production.

"By reimagining a symbol of our history through Philippine engineering and sustainable technology, we are breathing new life into the walled city," Tresvalles said.

The e-tranvia is currently available to the public free of charge through a rolling tour within Intramuros. The route includes key heritage sites such as Fort Santiago, Museo de Intramuros, Baluarte de San Diego, Foro de Intramuros, Centro de Turismo, nearby schools, and the Pasig Esplanade. ## Fernando backs Region 3 fireworks safety campaign

CITY OF MALOLOS — Governor Daniel R. Fernando joined the Philippine National Police and the Philippine Pyrotechnics Manufacturers and Dealers Association, Inc. (PPM-DAI) as guest of honor on March 23 at the Pavilion in Hiyas ng Bulacan Convention Center in this city to support a regional Fireworks Safety Seminar and Fireworks Display Operators' Seminar aimed at empowering Region 3 stakeholders with the safety standards necessary to reduce injuries and ensure the long-term sustainability of the local pyrotechnics industry.

The People's Governor underscored the importance of strengthening industry knowledge and skills, encouraging stakeholders to continuously improve their practices and strive for state-of-the-art standards in fireworks manufacturing, handling, and distribution. He emphasized that these educational efforts are essential for long-term viability and community protection.

"Ginagawa po natin ito upang maiwasan ang nadidigrasya taun-taon, kaya huwag po tayong manawa na humanap pa ng mga kaalaman ng mga dapat pa nating gawin sa ating pagnenegosyo ng paputok. Let us also share this knowledge to others para mas mapalawak pa ang kaalaman ng bawat isa, maiwasan ang mga aksidente, at masiguro ang kaligtasan ng ating komunidad," Fernando said.

The seminar gathered fireworks manufacturers and retailers from across Region 3 to strengthen compliance with safety standards

while promoting responsible practices that secure the industry's growth as a legitimate source of livelihood.

Critical fire safety inputs focusing on preventive measures and emergency preparedness in handling volatile materials were provided during the sessions. Furthermore, the Department of Trade and Industry presented updates on consumer protection and regulatory compliance, ensuring that products reaching the market meet national requirements, and a significant portion of the program was dedicated to a comprehensive discussion on the 2021 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 7183, which governs the manufacture, distribution, and use of pyrotechnic devices.

To ensure the technical proficiency of all participants, experts presented detailed procedures for the safe handling of fireworks tailored specifically for manufacturers and display operators. These modules covered advanced techniques, risk management, and operational safety standards. Separate guidance was also provided for dealers and retailers, focusing on the correct storage, transport, and sale of fireworks to ensure public safety.

The Fireworks Safety Seminar and Fireworks Display Operators' Seminar is part of the continuing efforts supported by Fernando to promote a safer and more responsible pyrotechnics industry in Bulacan and across Region 3.

# DOST Ilocos Region Strengthens Strategic Direction for 2026 Through Special ManCom Meeting

The meeting was presided over by Regional Director Teresita A. Tabag, with the participation of Assistant Regional Directors, Provincial Directors, and Unit Heads, reinforcing a unified leadership approach in steering the agency's strategic programs and ensuring the effective delivery of STI interventions that benefit communities and industries across the Ilocos Region.

A major highlight of the meeting was the presentation of preparations for the Innovation Summit for North Luzon Cluster, led by ARD Deeth-1180 P. Libunao and the DOST Pangasinan team. As presented by Ms. Jennifer C. Fernandez, Senior Science Research Specialist of DOST Pangasinan, the summit is envisioned as a major platform for advancing innovation collaboration across Northern Luzon.

Among the key activities to be featured are the Ceremonial Technology Licensing Agreement (TLA) signing involving Regions I, II, and the Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR), technology adopter success stories, and forums promoting innovation and technology transfer. These initiatives aim to accelerate the commercialization and adoption of locally developed technologies, strengthening regional competitiveness and innovation ecosystems.

During the meeting, Director Tabag also emphasized the significance of the Secretary's 3 Horizon Strategy, underscoring its role in guiding the Department's long-term vision for science, technology, and innovation. She highlighted the need for regional programs to align with this strategic framework to ensure that initiatives translate into tangible benefits for communities and industries.

Key programs supporting this direction include the Small Enterprise Technology Upgrading Program (SETUP), OneLab, the Solido DRRM Knowledge Hub, Project SARAI, and the region's Innovation Hubs (iHubs) - all of which contribute to expanding technology access, strengthening disaster resilience, and enhancing innovation-driven development.

Updates on the agency's 2nd Surveillance Audit and preparations for the Philippine Quality Award (PQA) were presented by Assistant Regional Director for Technical Operations Services Racquel M. Espiritu, who also serves as the PQA Manager, along with Engr. Brian U. Rasco, Provincial Director of Ilocos Norte. The discussion reinforced the importance of maintaining high standards of organizational excellence and clarified the roles and responsibilities of staff to ensure readiness and compliance with

quality management systems.

Moreover, Human Resource staff Beverlyn B. Cardinez also presented updates on the agency's roadmap toward PRIME-HRM (Program to Institutionalize Meritocracy and Excellence in Human Resource Management) Level III accreditation, outlining the key phases and milestones necessary to strengthen the agency's human resource management systems and institutionalize a culture of meritocracy and performance excellence.

The meeting concluded with presentations from the Committee Heads of the 2026 Regional Science, Technology, and Innovation Week (RSTW), who shared their post-event evaluation highlighting accomplishments, challenges encountered, and strategic recommendations to further enhance the planning and impact of future regional STI celebrations.

Through collaborative planning and strategic leadership, the Special ManCom Meeting reaffirmed DOST Ilocos Region's commitment to strengthening innovation ecosystems, improving organizational excellence, and advancing "Agham na Ramdam" - science and technology that deliver meaningful solutions, expand opportunities, and improve the lives of communities across the Ilocos Region. ## Trillanes, handa na sa pag-testigo sa impeachment vs VP Sara

Kinumpirma ni dating Sen. Antonio Trillanes IV na naghahanda na siya sa pagharap sa Kamara bilang testigo sa impeachment proceedings laban kay Vice Sara Duterte ngayong Abril.

Ayon kay Trillanes, siya ang magsisilbing pambunag na testigo sa pagdinig ng House justice committee.

Susundan naman ito ng iba pang testigo na inaasahang magpapatibay sa kanyang mga pahayag.

Aniya, maghahain siya ng presentasyon kaugnay ng mga alegasyon kabilang ang umano'y ill gotten wealth ng Bise Presidente, involvement ng pamilya Duterte sa illegal na

droga at iba pang isyu.

Sinabi pa ni Trillanes may nakalap silang dokumento na kasama ang bunsong anak ni dating President Rodrigo Duterte na si Kitty sa mga tumanggap ng dibidendo mula sa isang sinasabing drug lord noong 2011 hanggang 2013.

Ibinibigay umano ang bayad na umaabot sa P40 to P50 milyon kada anim na buwan sa pamamagitan ng tseke na kino-convert sa manager's check na nakapangalan sa mga miyembro ng pamilya Duterte, kabilang umano ang joint account nina Kitty Duterte at inang si Honeylet Avanceña.

## Bagong COVID-19 variant na 'Cinada', 'wala pa sa PH — DOH

'Wala pang naitatalang kaso sa Pilipinas ng bagong COVID-19 variant na tinatawag na "Cicada" (BA.3.2), na natukoy sa ilang bansa kabilang ang Estados Unidos, ayon sa Department of Health (DOH) noong Sabado.

Ayon kay DOH spokesperson Undersecretary Albert Domingo, mas kaunti ang bilang ng mga kaso ngayong taon kumpara sa nakaraang taon. Dagdag pa niya, hindi na kasingdalas ang genomic sequencing para sa COVID-19 dahil hindi na ito itinuring na Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC).

"Hindi pa kami nakakita ng Cicada variant, pero kahit pa may makita, hindi ito dapat ikabahala," paliwanag niya.

Natukoy ang Cicada strain noong Nobyembre 2024 sa South Africa at ito ay nagmula sa Omicron lineage ng virus.

Ayon sa World Health Organization (WHO), na-monitor na ang BA.3.2 sa 23 bansa at wala pang ebidensiya na nagpapakita ng mas malalang sakit, diagnostic failure, o mababang bisa ng mga kasalukuyang antiviral kumpara sa ibang Omicron lineages.

Tinukoy ng WHO na bagama't may "pronounced immune-escape profile" ang BA.3.2, hindi pa ito nagdudulot ng karagdagang panganib sa pampublikong kalusugan kumpara sa umiikot na Omicron variants.

Suportado rin ito ng U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), na nagsabing sa laboratory studies, ang BA.3.2 ay may kakayahang umiwas sa antibodies, kaya't mahalaga ang patuloy na genomic surveillance at pagsusuri sa bisa ng bakuna at antiviral treatments. Ayon kay Domingo, natural lamang para sa mga virus tulad ng COVID-19 ang magkaroon ng bagong variant.

"Hanggang hindi nagbibubukas ng alarma ang WHO o iba pang international health bodies, walang dahilan para mag-alala. Patuloy ang pagpapatupad ng standard precautions at infection control measures," ani Domingo.

Dagdag pa niya, nakatuon ngayong ang DOH sa mga sakit na kaugnay ng maimit at tuyong panahon, pati na rin sa contingency planning para sa national health system sa harap ng national energy emergency.

## Free Rehab Services for PWDs Boosted Under DOST-Led Partnership

MAKATI CITY, March 24, 2026 — Access to free and quality rehabilitation services for persons with disabilities (PWDs) is set to expand following the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Department of Science and Technology-National Capital Region (DOST-NCR), Project EMPOWER, and INDIBA Philippines at the INDIBA Office in Century Diamond Tower, Makati City.

The collaboration, implemented under the Community Empowerment through Science and Technology (CEST) Program of DOST, brings together the expertise of government, private sector, and non-government organi-

zations to deliver inclusive, science-based solutions for communities. Central to the initiative is the rollout of a free adaptive fitness and rehabilitation program aimed at providing accessible, continuous, and high-quality care for beneficiaries, particularly those who often struggle to sustain treatment due to financial constraints.

Project EMPOWER President John Darnell "JV" Castro shared that what began as a simple conversation evolved into a meaningful collaboration driven by a shared commitment to support PWDs. Drawing from his own personal experience with illness, he underscored the importance of accessible

rehabilitation, noting that many individuals are forced to discontinue treatment because of high costs. This reality, he emphasized, highlights the need for services that are not only effective but also free and continuous.

DOST-NCR Regional Director Engr. Romelen T. Tresvalles emphasized that the partnership reflects how science, technology, and innovation can be translated into concrete and inclusive solutions for marginalized sectors. She noted that the initiative aligns with DOST programs such as NICER and "Agham na Ramdam," which aim to ensure that the benefits of science are felt by all, especially underserved commu-

nities.

Supporting this, DOST Undersecretary for Regional Operations Engr. Sancho A. Maborrang highlighted the importance of strong collaboration across sectors in improving the quality of life of Filipinos. He stressed that science should serve everyone without discrimination, and that sustained support from government and partners is key to expanding inclusive programs like this.

For its part, INDIBA Philippines reaffirmed its commitment to making advanced rehabilitation technologies more accessible. Chief Commercial Officer Chung-Chieh Jen emphasized their goal of expanding access to innovative treatment solutions, while Philippine Business Director Jacqueline Y. Guerrero expressed pride in contributing to a program that empowers PWDs and promotes inclusive development.

Overall, the initiative is expected to not only broaden access to rehabilitation services but also foster a healthier, more productive, and inclusive quality of life for PWDs nationwide, advancing the shared vision of delivering solutions and opportunities for all. (Nelson Santos)

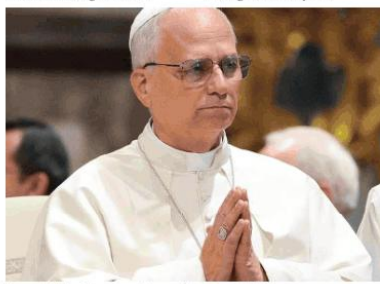

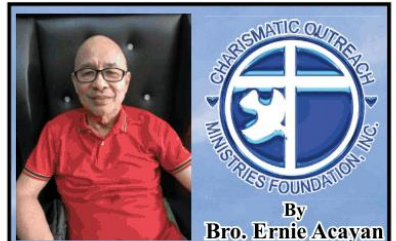

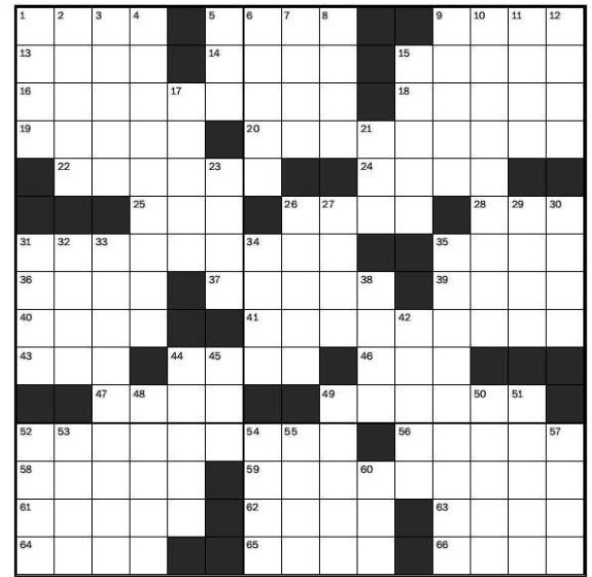
