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NMDRRMC REPORTS 79.6% CONTAINMENT OF NAVOTAS SANITARY LANDFILL FIRE



The Metro Manila Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MMDRRMC) convened today to provide a status update on the Navotas Sanitary Landfill fire incident, reporting that the fire is now 79.6% contained.

DOST Ilocos Region Partners with Vintar to Advance Clean Energy, Smart Mobility

VINTAR, Ilocos Norte — The Department of Science and Technology Ilocos Region (DOST Ilocos Region) successfully partnered with the local government of Vintar to implement a suite of innovation-driven solutions aimed at addressing rising fuel costs and revitalizing local industries.

During the recent consultative meeting, DOST Ilocos Region Regional Director Teresita A. Tabao and Provincial Director Engr. Brian U. Rasco proposed the integration of e-mobility solutions, including e-tricycles and the establishment of charging stations, to modernize the municipality's transport sector. To provide immediate economic relief, DOST Ilocos Region also committed to conducting comprehensive energy audits for municipal offices and commercial establishments to identify inefficiencies and optimize electricity consumption.

Beyond energy and transport, the partnership aims to expand Vintar's textile industry through the Regional Yarn Production and Innovation Center (RYPIC). The initiative seeks to modernize the production of traditional abel fabrics by introducing industrial power looms and diversifying raw materials to include bamboo, abaca, and cotton.

Mayor Richard A. Degala expressed full

support for the program, noting that initial steps are already underway in coordination with the Philippine Fiber Industry Development Authority (PhilFIDA) to assist local farmers in sealing up cotton production to meet emerging industrial demands.

In line with strengthening local science, technology, and innovation (STI) governance, Vintar is also among the Local Government Units (LGUs) being eyed by DOST Ilocos Norte for the implementation of the Smart and Sustainable Communities Program (SSCP) and the establishment of a Municipal Science, Technology, and Innovation (STI) Council.

To ensure the sustainability of these initiatives, Director Tabao emphasized the need for a dedicated focal person to oversee the implementation of high-impact initiatives.

DOST Ilocos Region also pledged to provide specialized monitoring systems to enable the municipality to track fuel and power consumption in real time. This strategic partnership marks Vintar's transition toward becoming a "smart and sustainable" community—leveraging science and technology to balance modern innovation with the preservation of local resources and heritage. In a press briefing, MMDA Chairman and concurrent MMDRRMC head Atty. Don Artes said the discussion focused on the situation on the ground, ongoing actions, and the equipment being utilized to effectively address the issue.

"Moving forward, the incident will serve as a learning experience to improve preparedness and response capabilities," Artes stressed. President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. instructed Department of National Defense (DND) Secretary Gilberto Teodoro Jr. to seek technical assistance from foreign partners, including expert teams from Japan and the United States, to address the Navotas Sanitary Landfill fire.

"The DND chief reached out to our foreign partners, who promptly responded and committed to providing continued support for the needs of Navotas," said Special Envoy for Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) Maria Antonia Yulo-Loyzaga.

For his part, Navotas City Mayor John Rey Tiangco expressed his gratitude to the MMDA for convening the meeting. "I am thankful to Chairman Artes for convening this meeting. To provide a status update, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) reported that the air quality index in Metro Manila remains within acceptable or normal levels despite the recent incident involving the sanitary landfill. Additionally, we are utilizing a drone with thermal imaging capability to assess the possibility of ignition within the 44-hectare site," Tiangco said.

The mayor explained that the closure and rehabilitation plan had not been implemented by the operator, constituting violations of the conditions stipulated in the Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC). Metro Manila Council President and San Juan City Mayor Francis Zamora commended the Navotas LGU for its swift action to contain the fire.

"We understand how severe the situation in Navotas has been. It should serve as a lesson for us to be more prepared instead of merely reacting," Zamora said.

The NSLF Task Group, led by the local government unit of Navotas, continues to conduct fire suppression operations through soil covering, smothering, and misting.

The fire at the Navotas Sanitary Landfill began on April 10, and continues to be actively managed. Among the agencies assisting in the operations are the Office of Civil Defense (OCD), Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), Department of Transportation (DOTR), DENR-Environmental Management Bureau, and MMDA. DOST Ilocos Region Empowers TESDA RO1 Information Officers through Expert-Led Training on Photography, Photojournalism, Reels Making

More than simply teaching participants how to take photos, the training emphasized the power of photography and storytelling in documenting realities, preserving moments, and communicating stories that matter.

As part of the second day of the workshop, Mr. Lemuel G. Castigo, Science Research Specialist I, and Karl Anthony M. Bugar, Project Technical Assistant II, shared their expertise in photography, visual storytelling, photojournalism, and mobile content creation through engaging discussions and hands-on activities. The activity equipped participants with practical knowledge on camera handling, composition techniques, lighting principles, visual storytelling, ethical documentation, and mobile reels creation — essential skills in today's fast-paced digital communication landscape.

Mr. Bugar first discussed the technical foundations of photography, including camera basics and functions, proper handling of camera settings, composition techniques, and lighting principles. He also highlighted the importance of un-

derstanding the Exposure Triangle — aperture, shutter speed, and ISO — as the heart of every well-crafted image.

"Ang Exposure Triangle ang pinalakasan ang pagpapaliwanag ng photography. Mas mahalagang maintindihan ito dahil dito nagsisimula ang tamang pagkuha at pag-control ng bawat shot. At kung walang light, walang photo — ganoon lang kasimple ang photography," Mr. Bugar explained. Participants were introduced to the science behind capturing images and how proper control of light, timing, and composition can transform ordinary shots into compelling photographs. Following the photography session, Mr. Castigo discussed the fundamentals of photojournalism and visual storytelling, emphasizing that powerful photographs are not only technically good — they should also tell meaningful stories.

"Anyone can take a photo. But not everyone can tell a story in one frame. Kaya mula ngayon, huwag lang tayong basta magpicture. Mag-document. Magkuwento at mag-capture ng mga moments na may meaning," he shared.

He further discussed the importance of ethical storytelling, identifying impactful shots, caption writing using the Five Ws, proper documentation, and creating engaging reels using mobile phones to effectively communicate stories to the public. The workshop became more dynamic as participants applied the concepts through practical shooting exercises, output presentations, and interactive critiquing sessions where creativity, technical skills, and storytelling were put into action behind every frame.

More than a technical training, the activity served as a reminder that photography is a powerful tool for communication and public service — one that can capture reality, amplify stories, and preserve moments that inspire communities.

Through initiatives like this, DOST Ilocos Region continues to strengthen partnerships with regional agencies by sharing knowledge and technical expertise in communication, media, and digital content development anchored on science, technology, and innovation. The intensive training gathered key agricultural frontline workers and stakeholders from MAFAR BARMM, LGU-Midsayap, LGU-Kidapawan, LGU-Carmen, LGU-Kapalawan SGA BARMM, LGU-Makilala, LGU-Lake Sebu, LGU-Banailisan, LGU-Matalam, LGU-General Santos City, and LGU-Maasin, alongside local cacao farmers.

Her discussion highlighted the science behind proper food handling, rigorous sanitation, and strict quality assurance parameters required to transition local cacao into safe, premium-grade,

and export-ready commodities.

Through this collaborative "Training of Trainers" model championed by Dir. Malawan, DOST XII intends to create a powerful multiplier effect. By arming Agricultural Extension Workers (AEWs) with rigid scientific methodologies, they are fully empowered to cascade these modern, compliant processing practices directly to grassroots farming communities across the region.

This science-driven approach ensures that our local chocolate and cacao products don't just capture markets locally but confidently meet world-class food safety regulations.

Under the visionary leadership of Regional Director Engr. Sammy M. Malawan, PhD, the Department of Science and Technology Region XII (DOST XII) Food Safety Team, in active collaboration with the Department of Agriculture through the Agricultural Training Institute

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Teodoro set to attend premier defense meet in Singapore

Department of National Defense (DND) Secretary Gilberto Teodoro Jr. will take part in the 23rd Asia Security Summit of the International Institute for Strategic Studies (IISS), known as the Shangri-La Dialogue (SLD), to be held in Singapore on May 29-31.

In a statement late Tuesday, the DND said Teodoro will deliver a plenary talk on "Evolving Security Partnerships in a Fragmenting World," with discussions expected to focus on emerging security dynamics, partnerships and approaches to addressing security challenges.

It also added that the DND chief will participate in high-level engagements and discussions with counterparts and stakeholders on matters of mutual interest and regional security cooperation.

Last year, Teodoro delivered remarks on "Cross-Regional Security Interlinkages," in which he referenced President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr.'s keynote address at the 2024 Shangri-La Dialogue, highlighting the importance of the rules-based international order in sustaining regional stability and prosperity.

The SLD is a premier Indo-Pacific defense summit that convenes defense ministers, military leaders, policymakers and security experts to discuss key regional and global security issues and strengthen dialogue on evolving defense and strategic concerns. (PNA)

DOJ requests accounting of firearms owned by Senate

Government prosecutors have asked for an accounting of the firearms owned by the Senate, the Department of Justice (DOJ) said Tuesday.

"Our special panel of prosecutors have issued a subpoena to the Office of the Senate Secretary directing the production of documents relevant to the ongoing fact-finding investigation, particularly, we have asked for the oath of office of Senate Sergeant-at-Arms Ret. Gen. Mao Aplasca," DOJ Secretary Freddie Vidua told reporters in a press briefing.

"We have also requested for a summary or inventory of firearms available and owned by the Senate and their corresponding issuance documents to corresponding Senate officials and employees," he added.

Vidua said the DOJ also asked for the Senate's security logs.

"Di ba you are familiar with going in and out of the Senate every time you go in, you identify yourself, you put in the time, you put in the details of your entry into the Senate. And when you also exit, there are also particular details on that matter. We requested for those documents," he said.

The DOJ also issued a subpoena to the Commission on Audit to produce records relating to the inventory of assets, particularly firearms owned by the Senate.

The justice department particularly requested the

CZ "Scorpion" assault pistol seen in videos of the May 13 shooting incident, involving Senate security personnel led by Aplasca and the National Bureau of Investigation.

Vidua said some persons may be held liable for obstruction of justice.

"(T)here are several acts punished under the rule: concealing evidence, tampering with evidence, witness tampering, misleading authorities, delaying legal processes," he said.

"And let me remind you, if you are a public official or employee found guilty of committing these acts, there is an accessory penalty that you will be perpetually disqualified from holding public office," he added.

Criminal Investigation and Detection Group director Maj. Gen. Robert AA Morico II earlier said criminal complaints would be filed against Aplasca and at least two of his men who were found to have discharged their firearms during the controversial May 13 incident.

Morico said the actions of Aplasca and his personnel constituted a clear violation of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 11917, or the Private Security Services Industry Act, which was enacted in 2022 during the term of then-Sen-

ate president Vicente Sotto III.

He said the IRR clearly states that a warning shot is not included in the six stages that need to be observed before the use of lethal force.

Under the RA 11917, private security personnel are required to follow a six-level "force continuum": alert presence (Level 1); verbal communication (Level 2); physical restraints (Level 3); use of chemical agents (Level 4); temporary incapacitation (Level 5); and use of force or firearms (Level 6). NFA intensifies emergency rice milling to support palay farmers

The National Food Authority (NFA) on Tuesday said its rice milling activities have been intensified to support local palay (unhusked rice) farmers in Soccsksargen.

The grains agency collaborated with rice millers for the intensified milling initiative under the emergency procurement program. In a statement, NFA administrator Larry Lacson said at least 1,100 palay farmers in Central Mindanao are expected to be supported under the emergency procurement milling initiative. "This is more than just a procurement exercise. Every bag of palay we move out of our warehouses means another farmer we can help and another family assured that their harvest has value," he said.

He said the initiative also helps free up spaces in NFA warehouses in the region.

"We are clearing space not simply to store rice, but to keep buying from farmers who rely on us during difficult market conditions. That support can spell the difference between profit and loss for many small growers," Lacson said.

The NFA has tapped 15 rice mills for the emergency procurement milling services initiative.

It covers PHP48.5 million worth of contracts or more than 215,000 50-kilo bags of palay harvested across Soccsksargen.

The bulk of the milling contracts, covering around 161,841 bags of palay, was awarded to six millers in North Cotabato, which collectively have a 12-hour milling capacity of 4,526 bags. The other six millers in Sultan Kudarat will process 45,357 bags, while three millers in South Cotabato will handle the remaining 7,965 bags.

About 133,251 bags of rice are expected to be produced from the milling services program for the government's rice buffer stock.

Agriculture Secretary Francisco Tiu Laurel Jr. said the NFA milling program seeks to sustain palay procurement for farmers at favorable prices.

"When the government steps in to buy their harvest at fair prices, we protect livelihoods, strengthen food security, and ensure that Filipino families will continue to have rice on their tables," he said. Tiu Laurel vowed to replicate the milling contract in other areas in the country to further boost support for palay farmers.

The DA chief said the emergency procurement milling initiative also backs the administration's flagship Benteng Bigas Meron (BBM) Na program. (PNA)

PBBM lauds OFWs' role in stronger PH-Japan ties, vows welfare support

President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. on Tuesday pledged continued support for the promotion of the rights and welfare of overseas Filipino workers (OFWs) in Japan, as he acknowledged their key role in strengthening the Philippine-Japan relations.

Speaking before the Filipino community in Tokyo, Marcos expressed gratitude and admiration for Filipinos in Japan, describing them as the "face of the Philippines" and a symbol of resilience and quiet strength.

Marcos said Filipino workers in Japan, employed in factories, offices, schools, hotels, hospitals, restaurants, and construction sites, serve as a key link in deepening people-to-people ties and expanding cooperation between the two countries in various fields.

"Bago pa man kami makikipagpulong sa mga pinuno ng Japan, minarapat naming unahin ang pakikipagkita sa inyo sapagkat kayo ang dahilan kung bakit mahalaga ang relasyon ng Pilipinas at Japan (Before we meet with Japanese leaders, we made it a priority to meet you because you are the reason why the relationship between the Philippines and Japan is important)," he said.

Kayo ang nagbibigay-buhay sa ugnayang ito sa gitna nga ng Pilipinas at ng Japan. Napakahalaga para sa amin na ipabatid sa inyo na ang inyong pamahalaan ay walang tigil at walang sawang nagsisikap upang mapangalagaan ang inyong mga karapatan, kapakanan at kaligtasan habang kayo ay naghahanapbuhay sa ibayong-dagat (You give life to this relationship between the Philippines and Japan). It is important for us to assure you that your government is continuously working to protect your rights, welfare, and safety while you work abroad."

The President said his four-day state visit to Japan, undertaken upon the invitation of the Japanese government, aims to enhance bilateral relations in key areas such as labor protection, trade and commerce, defense, and regional cooperation.

He emphasized the importance of the 70th anniversary of the normalization of diplomatic relations between the Philippines and Japan, calling it a milestone in the long-standing partnership between the two nations.

Marcos also acknowledged the impact of global crises, including the rising oil prices triggered by the ongoing Middle East conflict, and cited government interventions, including the declaration of a state of national energy emergency and implementation of the Unified Package for Livelihood, Industry, Food and Transport (UPLIFT) program.

Despite global challenges, Marcos said cooperation between the Philippines and Japan remains strong, noting continued efforts to deepen collaboration to cushion the impact of the Middle East crisis and ease the burden on affected sectors

"Pinatunayan din ng krisis na hindi maibubukod ang Pilipinas sa epekto ng pagkakaantala ng suplay ng langis at walang bansang kayang lutasin ang krisis ng enerhiya ngayon nang nag-iisa (The crisis has shown that the Philippines is not exempt from the impact of disrupted oil supply, and no country can solve the energy crisis alone)," he said.

"Bagama't pareho nating pinagdadaanan ang hamon na dala ng kakulangan ng suplay ng enerhiya, hindi napatid ang pagtutulungan ng ating dalawang bansa upang maibsan ang hirap na nararamdaman ng taumbayan (Although we are both facing challenges brought by energy supply shortages, cooperation between our two countries remains unbroken in easing the burden on our people)."

Despite the latest global developments, Marcos said he wants to make some time to meet the Filipino community in Japan, praising their vibrant spirit and strong sense of camaraderie.

He reaffirmed the government's commitment to protecting the rights, welfare, and safety of Filipinos working and residing in Japan.

He also paid tribute to long-time Filipino residents who paved the way for younger generations, recognizing their contributions to stronger ties between the two countries.

Marcos said Filipino migrants have helped shape and strengthen communities across Japan, which now number around 350,000 and represent

one of the largest expatriate groups in the country.

He expressed confidence that Filipinos in Japan will continue to excel in their respective fields while serving as positive contributors to their communities.

"It is my fervent hope that you succeed in all your endeavors in your chosen careers, whether it be business, the arts, professional arena, the service sector or in sports. I urge you to make a good account of yourselves, and be proud of your heritage as Filipinos," he added.

Marcos also encouraged young Filipinos in Japan to maximize opportunities while maintaining pride in their heritage, noting that integration should not mean losing one's identity.

"We all agree that living in Japan requires a delicate balance. Japan is a nation of profound tradition, structure, and etiquette. For us to thrive here, we need to be masters of the art of integration. We must respect the local laws, embrace the culture, and learn the language," he said.

"However, integration does not mean assimilation. It does not mean forgetting your roots and abandoning who you truly are. Our greatest asset is our unique identity. Let your Filipino heritage emanate from you in your daily interactions while still being mindful of social norms, and watch it enrich your social environment and spheres of influence." (PNA)

DILG to LGUs: Fast-track renewable energy project approvals

The Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) has directed local government units (LGUs) to streamline and speed up the approval process for renewable energy (RE) projects nationwide to support the country's clean energy goals.

In a statement Tuesday, the DILG said it has laid down more streamlined guidelines for securing documentary requirements and clarified procedures for applicants seeking local approval for RE projects through Memorandum Circular 2026-032 issued May 11.

Under the directive, LGUs are required to issue a standardized Resolution of No Objection (RONO) through the Sangguniang Panlungsod or Sang-

guniang Bayan, replacing the previous Letter of No Objection (LONO) issued by local chief executives. The RONO formally signifies the LGU's support for a proposed RE project. The DILG said the measure aims to reduce unnecessary delays, eliminate redundant documentary requirements, and improve coordination between national government agencies and LGUs in line with the country's renewable energy targets. Renewable energy projects include the development of infrastructure for energy storage systems, as well as solar, wind, hydro, geothermal, biomass, and other clean energy sources. To simplify transactions, the DILG said the process for applicants should involve only three steps: submission of

application forms and documentary requirements, receipt of the order of payment, and payment of fees along with the issuance of the RONO. LGUs are also required to act on applications within 45 working days upon receipt of complete requirements. If an application is denied, LGUs must provide a written explanation and specify remedial measures that applicants may undertake. The directive supports President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr.'s push for energy security, conservation, and faster public service delivery following the issuance of Executive Order No. 110, which declared a national energy emergency and reinforced the government's commitment to clean and sustainable energy. Palace pushes for faster rollout of DOLE priority programs

Malacañang is pushing for the swift implementation of the Department of Labor and Employment's (DOLE) priority programs, including the Tulong Panghanapbuhay sa Ating Disadvantaged/Displaced Workers (TUPAD), to support job generation.

Executive Secretary Ralph Recto met with newly appointed DOLE Secretary Francis Tolentino at Malacañan Palace in Manila on Tuesday to provide direction on the faster implementation of key labor programs.

The meeting was held a day after the

Palace announced Tolentino's appointment as the new DOLE chief.

Recto and Tolentino discussed President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr.'s directive to accelerate initiatives aimed at creating more employment opportunities for Filipinos, the Office of the Executive Secretary (OES) said Wednesday.

Recto emphasized the importance of the strategic rollout of the TUPAD program, particularly in support of Brigada Eskwela.

He said TUPAD beneficiaries should be tapped to help accelerate the main-

tenance, repair, and cleaning of public schools nationwide ahead of the opening of classes.

He said the initiative would not only help ensure school readiness but also provide short-term employment for workers in need.

Recto assured Tolentino of the OES' full support in advancing the agency's key programs.

He also expressed confidence in Tolentino's leadership, saying he is "the right man for the job." (PNA)

DSWD starts payout for 150K regional PEMEDES drivers

The Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) on Wednesday began the regional payout of the cash relief assistance for Private Express and/or Messengerial Delivery Service (PEMEDES) drivers.

"Magsisimula na po ngayong Miyerkules ang pagbibigay ng cash relief assistance sa mga PEMEDES drivers sa labas po ng Metro Manila. Tuloy tuloy na po ang schedule natin. Base sa listahan mula sa ating mga rhiyon, ang target po ay higit na 150,000 na mga regional PEMEDES drivers ang mabibigyan ng PHP5,000 cash relief assistance para matulungan sila na matugunan ang kanilang mga pangangailangan lalo pa't mataas pa rin ang presyo ng petrolyo dahil sa krisis sa Middle East (This Wednesday, we will start distributing the cash relief assistance to PEMEDES drivers outside Metro Manila. Based on the list from the regions, we target to provide more than 150,000 PEMEDES drivers with PHP5,000 in cash relief assistance to assist them in their needs, especially with the high fuel prices due to the Middle East crisis)," DSWD spokesperson Assistant Secretary Irene Dumlaog said in a news release.

She said the regions that will conduct payout activities are the Cordillera Region, Ilocos Region, Cagayan Valley, Central Luzon, Calabarzon, Mimaropa, Bicol Region, Western Visayas, Central Visayas, Eastern Visayas, Zamboanga Peninsula, Northern Mindanao, Davao Region, and Soccsksargen.

"Sisiguraduhin po ng aming mga DSWD Field Offices na magiging maayos ang pamamahagi ng tulong sa ating mga kababayan. Iti rin po ay alinsunod sa utos ni Pangulong Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. na masiguro na lahat ng mga drivers na appektado ng mataas na presyo ng krudo ay mabibigyan ng tulong mula sa

gobyerno (The DSWD Field Offices will ensure that the distribution of aid will be orderly. This is also in line with the directive of President Marcos to ensure that all drivers affected by the high cost of fuel will be given assistance from government)," Dumlaog said.

Among those scheduled to receive the cash aid are regional PEMEDES drivers from the LBC Express, Grab Express, Fastrak Services Inc., Global Jet Cargo Philippines Inc., J&J Dynamic, Express Speed Riders Inc., and Lalamove Technology Philippines.

For updates on the payout schedules and venues, drivers may refer to the official Facebook page of the DSWD: <https://www.facebook.com/dswdserves> or any of its field offices.

Dumlaog said the simultaneous payouts will continue to ensure that no qualified PUV drivers will be left behind.

Aside from the regional cash aid distribution, special payouts in Metro Manila are also being simultaneously conducted for jeepney, tricycle, transport network vehicle service (TNVS), and motorcycle taxi drivers, as well as service delivery riders.

The DSWD implements the cash relief assistance under its Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) program.

This program serves as a social safety net or stop-gap mechanism to support the recovery of individuals and families experiencing unexpected crises.

It also forms part of the DSWD's contribution to the government's Unified Package of Livelihoods, Industry, Food, and Transport (UPLIFT) framework of intervention to the sectors most affected by the tensions in the Middle East, including the public transport sector. (PNA)

PNP secures Pampanga collapse site amid shift to retrieval ops

The Philippine National Police (PNP) has deployed tighter security protocols around the site of a collapsed nine-story building in Angeles City, Pampanga, following the official termination of emergency rescue efforts.

PNP Chief Gen. Jose Melencio Nartatez Jr. said the Police Regional Office 3 (PRO-3) and the Angeles City Police Office were instructed to focus on securing the area and assisting affected families as retrieval operations continue.

"As operations in Angeles City officially transition from rescue to retrieval, I have directed the regional director of PRO-3 and the local police force to shift their primary focus toward establishing a tight security perimeter, managing crowd control, and providing absolute, compassionate assistance to the affected families," Nartatez said in a statement.

The building collapsed in Barangay Balibago on May 24 and prompted a large-scale inter-agency response

involving the PNP, the Armed Forces of the Philippines, the Bureau of Fire Protection, the Office of Civil Defense, and local disaster councils.

Rescue teams spent several days searching through debris before authorities declared the end of rescue operations and the start of retrieval efforts.

"Our personnel on the ground are strictly ordered to preserve the dignity of the deceased, facilitate the swift and orderly movement of disaster response vehicles, and main-

tain a secure environment so that clearing and structural safety assessments can proceed without delay," Nartatez said.

The PNP chief also directed the PRO-3 to maintain round-the-clock police visibility around the collapse site.

He said additional personnel will be deployed in the surrounding areas of Barangay Balibago to prevent disruptions as heavy equipment and retrieval teams continue operations.

"This crisis has shown that our joint communication channels and unified command structure at the Incident Command Post are highly effective, allowing our police units to perfectly complement the technical clearing operations of our military and fire counterparts while ensuring public safety and order on the ground," Nartatez said. (PNA)

Authorities intercept P292-M shabu shipment at MICP

Authorities have intercepted a shipment containing 43 kilos of shabu worth around PHP292.4 million at the Manila International Container Port (MICP) in Manila on Monday.

The Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) said the shipment containing 129 rectangular packs of shabu is currently under investigation to determine its origin, intended recipients and possible links to local and international drug trafficking networks.

"This successful interdiction highlights the unwavering commitment of our law enforcement agencies to protect the country's borders from the entry of illegal drugs," PDEA chief Undersecretary Isagani Nerez said in a statement on Wednesday.

"Through strengthened inter-agency coop-

eration and intensified intelligence operations, we will continue to pursue and dismantle drug trafficking syndicates that threaten the safety and welfare of our communities," he added.

The country's ports remain under strict monitoring as the government continue to enhance its enforcement capabilities against illegal drug activities.

Nerez said the operation demonstrates the effectiveness of strong coordination among partner agencies in protecting the country from becoming corridors of drug trafficking.

Authorities assured the public that case build-up operations and profiling activities are ongoing in preparation for the filing of appropriate charges against individuals involved in the attempted shipment of illegal drugs. (PNA)

Nartatez says PNP won't 'go soft' on Dela Rosa

The Philippine National Police (PNP) on Wednesday assured the public that Sen. Ronald Dela Rosa will not receive special treatment amid concerns that some officers may go soft on the former PNP chief because of his long ties with the police organization.

In a news release, PNP chief Gen. Jose Melencio Nartatez Jr. stressed the organization remains bound by the law and by its mandate to serve the public without fear or favor.

"The Philippine National Police operate strictly on legal frameworks and our sworn oath to serve and protect, meaning no individual is above the law regardless of rank or title," he said.

He assured that institutional respect for Dela Rosa as a former top cop would not affect the conduct of police personnel, stressing that all actions of the organization will remain guided by professionalism, impartiality and transparency.

Nartatez also directed all police units to strictly follow standard operating procedures in any operation related to Dela Rosa, who is facing an arrest warrant issued by the International Criminal Court over the previous administration's drug war.

He ordered commanders to avoid preferential treatment and prevent unauthorized disclosures that could compromise lawful procedures.

The PNP chief made the remarks after questions surfaced on whether police officers would strictly enforce legal procedures involving Dela Rosa because he once led the country's police force and

still commands respect within the institution.

"We expect all officers to uphold standard operating procedures without fear or favor, and we explicitly appeal to Senator Dela Rosa's enduring sense of duty as a lifelong law enforcer to cooperate fully with the legal process," Nartatez said.

"The eyes of the nation are on us, and the PNP will remain a professional, disciplined institution that honors the badge by executing its mandates with maximum restraint, strict adherence to human rights, and total accountability," he said.

CIDG, NBI search Bato's alleged

hideout
Meanwhile, Criminal Investigation and Detection Group (CIDG) and National Bureau of Investigation (NBI) operatives on Wednesday morning searched a house in Barangay Balibago, Angeles City, Pampanga where Dela Rosa was allegedly hiding.

In a phone interview with reporters, Barangay Balibago chairman Joseph Ponce said authorities coordinated with him at around 5:30 a.m. before carrying out the operation at a house inside Diamond Subdivision owned by a certain Lakay Cariño, whom he identified as the maternal uncle of actor-turned-senator Robin Padilla.

Ponce said he immediately sent barangay officials, including village watchmen and barangay peacekeeping personnel to witness the operation.

According to Ponce, authorities al-

legedly based their suspicion on reports that Dela Rosa may have transferred to Cariño's pickup truck after leaving the Senate on the dawn of May 14.

Investigators, however, failed to find Dela Rosa or the pickup vehicle at the residence.

Ponce said the situation remained peaceful during and after the operation.

Authorities have yet to issue an official statement regarding the operation or confirm whether the raid was connected to efforts to locate Dela Rosa.

Firearms licenses

In another development, the PNP Firearms and Explosives Office (PNP-FEO) has ordered the revocation and cancellation of the firearm licenses of Dela Rosa.

In a two-page order dated May 26, FEO chief Brig. Gen. Jojo Manalad said the measure is pursuant to Section 4 of Republic Act 10591 or the Comprehensive Firearms and Ammunition Regulation Act.

The order also stated that the 117 firearms registered under Dela Rosa's name must be immediately confiscated or deposited to the Supply Accountable Officer of PNP-FEO for proper disposition.

"This Order of Revocation shall be immediately executory," the order read. (PNA)

NTA: Traders vow to buy local tobacco harvest amid overproduction

The National Tobacco Administration (NTA) on Wednesday assured the procurement of all flue-cured Virginia (FCV) tobacco leaves from local farmers.

This came after the agency's successful negotiations with traders to procure all local tobacco harvested this season.

The NTA has been conducting talks with industry stakeholders since March to address the possible "stop-buying" scenario due to oversupply of local tobacco leaves.

In a statement, NTA Administrator and CEO Belinda Sanchez said traders have already committed to purchasing local tobacco at reasonable prices, considering the recent supply and demand changes.

"The tobacco supply was short in the last two years, resulting in strong demand and unexpectedly high prices in the last two trading seasons," she said. "However, this trading season, prices declined due to overproduction, consistent with the law of supply and demand."

The overproduction, projected to hit 5 million kilograms, was attributed to the increasing number of non-contracted tobacco farmers cultivating traditional Virginia tobacco varieties under the contract growing system of local government units (LGUs).

The overproduction represents about 27 percent more than the 18.05 million kilo purchase commitment by trading companies and cigarette manufacturers for the 2026 trading season.

In terms of approved floor prices, the approved FCV tobacco price ranges from PHP98 per kilogram for

Class AA leaves to PHP62 per kilogram for reject-quality leaves.

To date, the highest buying price for prime-class FCV tobacco has reached PHP105 per kilogram.

This is higher than the approved floor price but lower than the PHP130 per kilogram highest buying price for prime-class FCV tobacco leaves during the 2025 trading season.

Besides the overproduction, NTA Deputy Administrator for Operations Nestor Casela also cited the poor-quality tobacco leaves due to limited irrigation water supply and unfavorable agro-climatic conditions brought about by extreme heat.

To address these concerns, Sanchez and Casela recently met with mayors and municipal agriculturists from Virginia tobacco-producing LGUs and urged them to encourage farmers to participate in the Tobacco Contract Growing System (TCGS).

Under the TCGS, authorized tobacco companies commit to purchasing the produce of contracted farmers under agreed terms and conditions, providing farmers with assured markets and more stable income.

Contract growers are also given access to production inputs, technical assistance and financial support from tobacco companies to help improve both the quality and volume of their harvests.

To date, about 10,000 out of the 45,000 registered tobacco farmers are enrolled in the NTA's TCGS program.

Of the registered tobacco farmers, about 25,000 are contracted by private sector companies. (PNA)

Type 88 missile system to beef up PH's archipelagic defense thrust

Japan's Type 88 surface-to-ship missile system could greatly enhance the defensive capabilities of the country's Comprehensive Archipelagic Defense Concept (CADC) should the Philippines manage to acquire it.

"That will be a big help because it is aligned with our capability development for CADC," Armed Forces of the Philippines spokesperson for the West Philippine Sea Navy, reservist Rear Adm. Roy Vincent Trinidad, said during an interview with reporters on Wednesday.

Once acquired, Trinidad said, this platform will allow the AFP more leeway in carrying out its mandate under the CADC.

Japan's Type 88 surface-to-ship missile system got a lot of fanfare in the "Balikatan" exercise earlier this month when it was used for the first time to sink a decom-

missioned Philippine Navy (PN) ship during a maritime strike training exercise off Laoga, Ilocos Norte.

Under the CADC, the AFP is required to protect all Philippine territories, including its 200-nautical-mile exclusive economic zone, from all hostile threats.

Japanese media reports earlier said Tokyo is looking at the possibility of exporting the weapon system to the Philippines.

This report has yet to be confirmed by Philippine defense and military officials.

Earlier, PN spokesperson Captain Marissa Martinez said that Japan's Type 88 surface-to-ship missile systems could be a valuable addition to the country's coastal defense capabilities.

She declined to comment on what role the Type 88 can play should the Philippines get around to getting it even

as the BrahMos cruise missile system, which the Philippines acquired three batteries from India, is now nearing operationalization.

These missiles are capable of a speed of Mach 2.8 and have a warhead of 200 kg. to 300 kg. and a range of 290 km.

The Type 88 has a range of 100 to 180 km. and a warhead weight of 225 kg. and with speeds described as subsonic. (PNA)

Nanindigan din ang mambabatas na ang nursing homes ay dapat na mayroong angkop na mga pasilidad,

mga kwarto at espasyo para sa mga senior citizens, gayundin dapat mayroong basic utilities, kuryente at tubig, kwalipikadong staff, basic health at recreational facilities at administrative office.

Dapat ding ang bed capacity ng institusyon ay angkop sa dami ng mga nakatatandang populasyon.

Mula noon, inilabas niya ang kantang "What If," na naging official soundtrack ng K-drama na ToGetHer, at sinundan ito ng digital single na "Way," bilang opisyal niyang debut sa South Korea.

Dahil dito muling pinatuyan ni Gwyn ang kanyang talento matapos sumali sa South Korean singing competition na Sing Again, isang programang nagbibigay ng panibagong pagkakataon sa mga "forgotten" o

underrated singers.

Sa naturang show, umapaw ang popularidad ni Gwyn matapos palitan ang kanyang screen name na "Dorado" na kinuha sa kanyang last name.

Toshifumi Suzuki, 'father' of Japan convenience stores, dies

Former chairman of Seven & i Holdings Toshifumi Suzuki, credited for the global success of 7-Eleven convenience stores, has died at the age of 93, the company said Monday.

Suzuki -- known as the "father of the convenience store" in Japan -- died due to heart failure on May 18, the company said in a statement.

"We would like to express our deepest gratitude for the kindness shown to him during his lifetime and respectfully inform you of his passing," the statement said.

Suzuki is known for opening the first 7-Eleven in Japan in 1974 and growing the business into the world's largest convenience store chain, including through turning the struggling US headquarters into a subsidiary of the Japanese company and rebuilding it.

He told the Asahi newspaper in an interview that he personally came up with the

idea of selling rice balls, or onigiri in Japanese, at 7-Eleven stores. More than 2 billion of the snacks are now sold annually in their branches around Japan, the Asahi said.

After joining major supermarket chain operator Ito-Yokado in 1963, Suzuki brought the convenience store format to Japan from the US through 7-Eleven.

He introduced 24-hour operations, as well as a wide range of other services including ATMs and utility bill payments.

In 1978, he became president of Seven-Eleven Japan, and in 2005, when the holding company Seven & i Holdings was established to integrate the group's supermarket and family restaurant businesses, he took over as chairman and CEO.

Suzuki quit the company in 2016 after losing a boardroom battle that critics said was aimed at putting his son in charge.

Maraming tinutulan ng mga immigrating advocates at ilang mambabatas ang hakbang na ito, dahil maari itong magdulot ng family separation at dagdag na abala sa mga aplikante. Sa kabuuan, ang bagong polisiya ay naglalayong higpitan ang proseso ng permanent residency at baguhin ang matagal nang sistema ng immigration sa Amerika.

Ang Shanxi ay isa sa pinakamahirap na probinsiya ng China, na kilala bilang coal-mining capital ng bansa.

Pinakahuli sa naitalang traheidiya bago ang insidente ngayong taon ay ang pagguho ng isang open-pit coal mine sa northern Inner Mongolia noong 2023 na kumitil ng 53 katao.

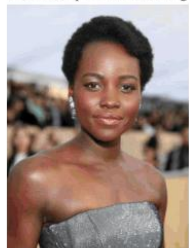

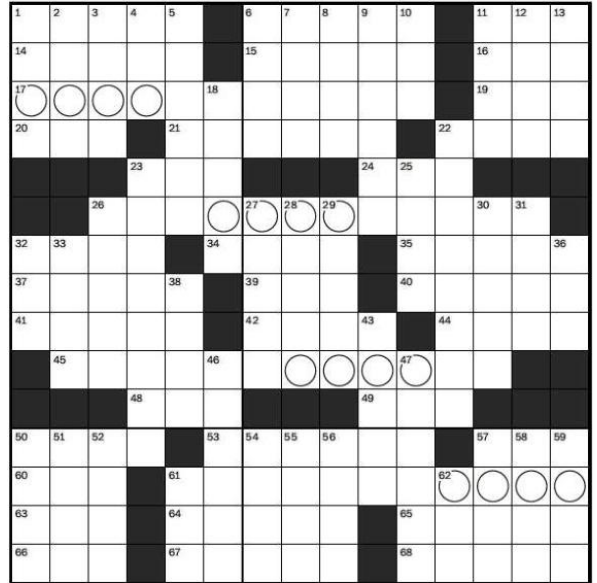
