Impeachment Court, maaaring buksan ang selyadong kahon ng tax records ni VP Sara

Posibleng buksan ng Senado ang isang selyadong kahon na naglalaman ng income tax records ni Vice President Sara Duterte habang isinasagawa ang impeachment trial.

Ayon kay Senate President Sherwin Gatchalian, posible itong mangyari kahit hindi pa namarkahan ang kahon bilang opisyal na ebidensya noong isinagawa ang pre-trial conference.

Ang nasabing kahon ay mula sa Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) at naglalaman umano'y mga tax records ni Vice President Sara Duterte, ng kanyang asawa na si Manases Carpio, at ng kanilang mga kumpanya.

Naantala ang pagbubukas ng kahon dahil binigyan muna ng pagkakataon ang panig ng depensa na magbigay ng kanilang komento tungkol sa kahilingan ng prospekusyon na buksan ito.

Ayon sa Senado, kailangan ng pahintulot ng Im-

peachment Court bago mabuksan ang mga dokumento.

Ipalaliwanag ni Gatchalian na maaaring buksan ang kahon sa mismong paglilitis kung ito ay iharap ng prospekusyon bilang bahagi ng kanilang mga ebidensya.

Nabatid na ang tax records ay inihang ebidensyang nais gamitin ng prospekusyon kaugnay ng Article II ng Articles of Impeachment laban kay Vice President Duterte.

Kung saan inakusahan ang Pangalawang Pangulo ng umano'y pagkakaroon ng yaman na hindi tugma sa kanyang kita at ng hindi umano wastong pagsisiwalat ng kanyang Statement of Assets, Liabilities, and Net Worth (SALN).

Ang sealed box ay unang ipinadala ng BIR sa House Committee on Justice noong Abril bago ito inilipat sa Senado.

Nakatakdang simulan ng Senado ang impeachment trial sa Hulyo 6, 2026.

Filipino-Chinese Groups Unite to Deliver P11 Million in Earthquake Assistance

The Federation and the entire Filipino-Chinese community are deeply saddened by the devastation caused by this tragedy," Lim said. "Our hearts go out to the families who have lost loved ones, homes, livelihoods, and sources of income. Nakikiramay po kami."

Immediately after the earthquake, FFCCCII's Regional Executive Director for Southern Mindanao, together with the South Cotabato Filipino-Chinese Chamber of Commerce, coordinated with the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) and local government authorities to assess the extent of the damage and identify urgent community needs.

Initial reports indicate that approximately 2,000 families in General Santos City have been affected, with assessments continuing in other impacted areas.

Recognizing the urgency of the situation, Lim convened an emergency meeting of leaders of the Filipino at Tsin Magkaibigan Foundation, an umbrella coalition of the 30 largest Filipino-Chinese civic, cultural, and business federations spearheaded by FFCCCII.

The coalition immediately approved P6 million for emergency relief operations. Of this amount, P1 million

was immediately released through the South Cotabato Filipino-Chinese Chamber of Commerce to prepare and distribute relief packs for approximately 2,000 affected families.

Each relief package, valued at approximately P500, contains essential items including five kilograms of rice, canned sardines, noodles, instant coffee, and ten liters of drinking water.

In addition to food assistance, the Filipino-Chinese community is donating 4,000 galvanized iron roofing sheets to help displaced families repair damaged homes and begin rebuilding their lives.

"Our local chamber will continue to closely monitor developments on the ground and coordinate with government agencies to identify communities that may require additional assistance in the coming weeks," Lim said.

Beyond immediate relief efforts, FFCCCII has earmarked an additional P5 million from its Welfare Fund for the possible repair and rehabilitation of public school buildings damaged by the earthquake,

particularly those constructed under its long-running Operation: Barrio Schools program. The combined emergency and rehabilitation commitment brings the total assistance package to P11 million.

Lim emphasized that helping fellow Filipinos during times of crisis has long been a core tradition of the Filipino-Chinese community.

"For centuries, the Filipino-Chinese community has stood side by side with our fellow Filipinos during times of calamity, crisis, and hardship. We believe that helping others is not merely an obligation—it is a moral responsibility and a shared expression of our gratitude to the nation we proudly call home," he said.

He also expressed gratitude to the 30 member organizations of the Filipino at Tsin Magkaibigan Foundation whose generosity and cooperation made the relief effort possible.

The FFCCCII President called on Filipino-Chinese communities nationwide, member chambers, civic organizations, businesses, and private citizens to continue extending assistance to affected communities and support efforts to restore local economies in Mindanao.

"No act of kindness is too small when people are in need," Lim said. "The road to recovery may be long, but the resilience, courage, faith, and bayanihan spirit of the Filipino people remain stronger than any earthquake." The press conference coincided

with the observance of the Dragon Boat Festival, one of the most important celebrations in Chinese culture. Lim noted that the festival honors Qu Yuan, a poet, patriot, and principled statesman whose devotion to public service continues to inspire generations.

"As we commemorate the Dragon Boat Festival—a celebration of patriotism, solidarity, and service to others—may we be reminded that our greatest strength lies in our unity and compassion for one another," Lim said.

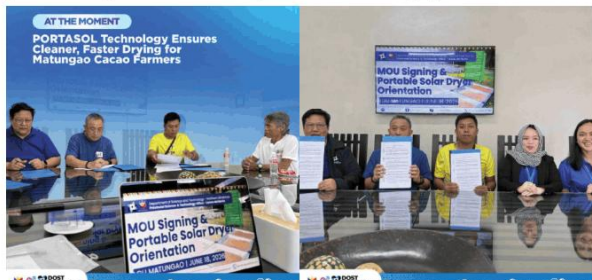
PORTASOL Technology Ensures Cleaner, Faster Drying for Matungao Cacao Farmers

Traditional open-sun drying leaves hardworking farmers at the mercy of unpredictable weather, leading to high post-harvest losses and lower market prices. To address this challenge, the Local Government Unit of Matungao and DOST Lanao del Norte officially sealed their partnership on June 18 at Matungao Municipal Hall. Led by Mayor Hon. Jaber M. Azis, this collaboration focuses on introducing science-based solutions to secure local food production and protect farmers' livelihoods.

To guide the community toward sustainable agriculture, DOST is deploying the Portable Solar Dryer (PORTASOL). This innovative technology directly answers the need for a faster, cleaner drying process. Featuring stackable, enclosed aluminum trays, it protects crops from rain, dust, and pests. Following the signing, DOST conducted a hands-on orientation for the Matungao Integrated Farmers Association to ensure they maximize this tool

for their cacao production. Municipal Agriculture Officer Mr. Steward D. Rosiana emphasized that adopting these smart tools reduces hard labor while preserving crop quality. By working closely with local leaders, DOST helps transform traditional farming challenges into highly resilient, profitable, and worry-free livelihoods.

DOST continues to walk alongside local leaders and agricultural communities to turn innovation into everyday progress.



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ESWF Unveils ENTER BATTLE ZONE 2026 to Strengthen Philippine Esports Pipeline



MANILA, Philippines — The E-Sports World Federation (ESWF) has officially launched ENTER BATTLE ZONE (EBZ) 2026, a nationwide Mobile Legends: Bang Bang tournament designed to identify and develop emerging Filipino esports players while expanding opportunities for competitive growth and international exposure.

The tournament will take place on July 31 to August 2, 2026, bringing together teams from across the country in a structured competitive environment that offers cash prizes, official ESWF rankings, and access to talent development pathways within the federation's esports ecosystem.

ESWF Chairman Engr. Reynaldo Sanchez leads the initiative, emphasizing the organization's goal of strengthening esports as a professional development platform for Filipino youth. 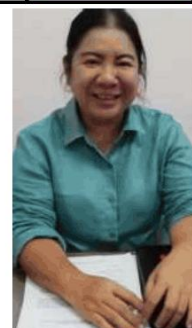

DSWD pro- gram assists 100 child la- bors in Antique

A total of 100 children-at-risk in Antique are beneficiaries of a government program that extends holistic and immediate interventions to child laborers and their families.

Antique Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office officer-in-charge Carcen Panaguigon said the children, aged 5 to 17 years old, are beneficiaries of the Strategic Help Desks for Information, Education, Livelihood and Other Developmental Interventions (SHIELD) program of the Department of Social Welfare and Development.

"The children are considered at risk because they are being exposed to a hazardous work environment," she said in an interview on Thursday.

Their families earn a living by farming, fishing and hauling heavy loads of charcoal and rice from upland barangays down to the lowland.

As part of the interventions, each will receive PHP5,000 financial assistance to be released in two tranches this school year 2026-2027.

The beneficiaries are from the towns of Sibalom, 22; Barbaza, 18; Laua-an, 17; Valderama and Tobias Forner, with 14 each and Hamtic, with 15. In addition to cash assistance, their parents are also referred to government agencies for livelihood training. (PNA)

Iloilo confirms first ASF case of 2026

The Office of the Provincial Veterinarian on Thursday confirmed the province's first case of African swine fever (ASF) this year after a sow and four pigs in a backyard farm in Barotac Viejo tested positive for the disease.

Provincial Veterinarian Dr. Darel Tabuada said authorities immediately dispatched a response team after receiving laboratory results from the Department of Agriculture's Regional Animal Disease Diagnostic Laboratory in Western Visayas on Tuesday.

The Barotac Viejo case is the province's first confirmed ASF case this year.

When the team arrived, the infected animals had already been properly disposed of.

Authorities also thoroughly cleaned and disinfected the area.

"Based on our monitoring, in coordination with the Municipal Agriculture Office, there are no suspected cases in the surrounding community. We consider this an isolated incursion case," Tabuada said.

He commended the farmer for complying with veterinary protocols, including the proper disposal of the infected animals.

To confirm the area is free of additional cases, the provincial government is completing the requirements to reclassify Barotac Viejo from a red (infected) zone to a pink (buffer) zone.

Tabuada reminded hog raisers, particularly backyard farmers, to observe Level 1 biosecurity measures, including installing perimeter fences, maintaining footbaths, limiting the movement of people in and out of farms,

and avoiding swill feeding.

"I would like to emphasize that ASF has not been eliminated in Iloilo province, which means the threat remains. Based on our records, Iloilo recorded 28 positive cases in 2025, with 26 detected at border checkpoints and two traced to a stockyard in Pavia," he said.

The province will strengthen existing protocols following reports of ASF cases in other provinces in Western Visayas, Tabuada said.

Authorities will focus on enforcing biosecurity measures in backyard and commercial farms.

Local government units, farmers, and slaughterhouse operators are also urged to ensure complete documentary requirements when transporting hogs.

Required documents include a veterinary or animal health certificate, a disinfection certificate for the transport vehicle, and a local transport permit.

Tabuada urged farmers not to panic but to strengthen biosecurity and adopt safer swine-raising practices. (PNA)

Malasiqui schools to hold incident drills after Tacloban incident

The Malasiqui Police Station will lead incident drills in schools this week as part of preparedness measures for teachers and students following the shooting incident in Tacloban City.

Lt. Col. Francisco Sawadan Jr. said Wednesday the incident drills will include

such scenarios as live shooting indoors and outdoors, hacking, and mauling incidents.

"The drill is for us to know the readiness of the students and teachers and to improve in areas they may lack," he said.

An orientation will be

held first to inform participants of what to expect and how they should respond, he said, adding that it will be a regular activity in schools.

Sawadan said police have boosted visibility in schools and tapped force multipliers in the barangays. (PNA)

ASF cases confirmed in NegOr town; 4 other areas under surveillance

The Provincial Veterinary Office (PVO) has confirmed five cases of African swine fever (ASF) in the Negros Oriental town of La Libertad, prompting intensified containment measures and heightened surveillance in four other municipalities.

PVO chief Dr. Melody Vilan reported the confirmed cases during a meeting of the Provincial Task Force on ASF on Thursday, attended by Governor Manuel Sagarbarria, local officials and other stakeholders.

"The positive results were based on blood samples collected from pigs in La Libertad on June 25 and 26 from the barangays of Martillo (Sitio Binatangan), Mapalasan, Pisong (Sitio Pisok), and Pangca," Vilan said.

Of the 65 blood samples collected, Vilan said five tested positive for ASF—one from Binatangan in Barangay Martillo, two from Barangay Mapalasan, and two from Sitio Pisok in Barangay Pisong.

The nine blood samples collected from Barangay Pangca all tested negative for the disease.

Vilan said eight pigs from affected households would be culled to prevent further spread of the virus.

She added that biosecurity measures, including chemical disinfection in areas where infected pigs were found, are being implemented.

Unlike previous ASF control protocols that required depopulating pigs within a 500-meter radius of an infected site, Vilan said current guidelines call for culling only pigs in households or

backyard farms where ASF has been confirmed.

Meanwhile, the PVO has placed the towns of Sibulan, San Jose, Amlan, and Siaton under close surveillance following reports of hog deaths in recent weeks.

Vilan said veterinary personnel are profiling affected animals before collecting blood samples for laboratory testing. She also stressed the need for barangay-level monitoring and surveillance to help contain the virus's spread.

During the meeting, agriculture officials noted that some hog raisers have been reluctant to report pig deaths for fear that authorities would order the culling of their animals if ASF is confirmed.

Sagarbarria reiterated that the provincial government is preparing to declare a state of calamity to allow the use of calamity funds to respond to the ASF outbreak.

He said the proposed declaration would also address the ongoing infestation of the red-striped soft scale insect (RSSI), which has affected thousands of hectares of sugarcane plantations across the province.

The governor said that a resolution from the Sangguniang Panlalawigan is required before the provincial government can officially declare a state of calamity.

He emphasized that the immediate priority is to strengthen containment measures in communities to prevent the ASF virus from spreading to other areas of Negros Oriental. (PNA)

Antique gov't to build Bahay Pag-Asa

The provincial government here is scouting for a property to establish the Bahay Pag-Asa for children in conflict with the law (CICL) in Antique.

Provincial Social Welfare and Development officer-in-charge Careen Panaguiton said Antique has 37 CICLs. Two have been referred to the Regional Rehabilitation Center for the Youth (RRCY) in Guimaras because of their suspended sentences due to murder.

Those with suspended sentences are found guilty of an offense, but instead of jail imprisonment, since they are minors, they are sent to a center managed by the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) to undergo a rehabilitation pro-

gram.

"It would be nice if there is a Bahay Pag-Asa in Antique so that children with suspended sentences will no longer be brought to the DSWD-RRCY," she said.

She said that with the Bahay Pag-Asa in Antique, social workers will have a chance to manage not only the CICL but also their parents.

"Most of the CICLs are from dysfunctional families, so there is also a need to case manage their parents," she added.

Meanwhile, this capital town, San Jose de Buenavista, will renovate its old building and convert it into Bahay Pag-Asa to accommodate CICL with suspended sentences. (PNA)

More Pangasinenses to receive rice aid via LGSF

The municipal government of Calasiao, Pangasinan is among the recipients of the Local Government Support Fund (LGSF), and its residents will soon receive free rice assistance from the national government.

"We wholeheartedly thank the President for this program wherein thousands of Dagupanites were given food assistance and free rice," Mayor Belen Fernandez said in Filipino on her official social media account.

The city government also sells up to 30 kg. of rice at PHP20 per kg. under the Bengteng Bigas, Meron Na! program to vulnerable sectors, such as farmers, fisherfolk, tricycle drivers, solo parents,

senior citizens and persons with disabilities.

The LGSF and the Socio-Civic Projects Fund (SCPF) are key components of government efforts to strengthen support for LGUs

and communities.

The LGSF provides financial assistance to LGUs to support priority development programs and projects, while the SCPF funds community-level initiatives, including

education support.

Families in need will receive 10 kg. of rice every two months, six times a year, through the LGSF to help ensure food security for vulnerable sectors. (PNA)

DSWD cash-for-work program gives financial relief to NIR students

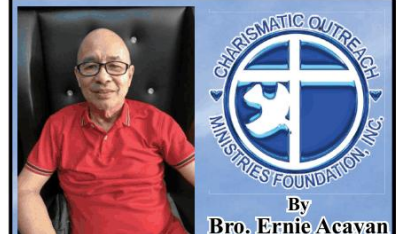

Buildings in Caraga meet accessibility standards for PWDs

Most buildings and public spaces in the Caraga Region are now compliant with accessibility requirements for persons with disabilities (PWDs), according to the Regional Committee on Disability Affairs (RCDA).

Accessibility in buildings and spaces is mandated by Batas Pambansa No. 344 (Accessibility Law), Presidential Decree No. 1096 (National Building Code), and Republic Act No. 7277 (Magna Carta for Persons with Disabilities).

"While some structures were built before these laws took effect, most new buildings and public spaces already meet accessibility standards for PWDs," said Joebert Tapales, president of the League of Persons with Disability Affairs Officers in the region.

Tapales added that RCDA and partner agencies regularly conduct audits to ensure compliance with accessibility requirements.

"We continue to encourage owners of non-compliant buildings to make the necessary adjustments. But the new structures in the region are now compliant as required by law," Tapales said.

Melanie Juan, Social Welfare Officer III of the Department of Social Welfare and Development-Caraga (DSWD-13), said a series of accessibility audits will be

conducted this July.

"As chair of the RCDA, the DSWD leads regular inspections of government offices and other facilities to ensure accessibility," Juan said.

She noted that audits are scheduled for July 6 to 9 in government offices, followed by another round from July 13 to 15 at major establishments and malls in Butuan City.

Aid to PWDs

Juan also reported that DSWD-13 released assistance to PWDs in the region in 2025 through various programs and services.

A total of 2,722 PWDs received PHP18 million in aid under the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation program, while 125 PWD groups and associations were granted PHP25 million worth of livelihood projects through the Sustainable Livelihood Program.

About 320 PWDs benefited from the Lawa at Binhi program, receiving PHP2.4 million in assistance, while 288 PWDs were provided PHP4.3 million under the "Walang Gutom" initiative.

The agency's flagship poverty alleviation program, Kapit Bisig Laban sa Kahirapan-Comprehensive and Integrated Delivery of Social Services, also extended PHP4.1 million in aid to more than 1,000 PWDs in the region. (PNA)

Accountability sought from private school facing outcry in Bacolod

Top officials of this highly urbanized city are seeking accountability from private school AMA Computer College Bacolod Campus, which has been facing graduation-related complaints from parents and students and has also been flagged for lack of a business permit.

The school became controversial after its 98 senior high school students were allegedly barred from participating in their graduation ceremony on June 24 due to late payment of fees.

It was also found out that AMA Computer College Bacolod Campus failed to secure a business permit for 2026.

In a statement on Thursday, Bacolod City Lone District Rep. Alfredo Abelardo Benitez said he has filed a resolution seeking to investigate the matter and to strengthen protection for students.

"The Department of Education policy is clear. No student who has earned the right to graduate should ever be denied that milestone because

of their inability to pay," he added.

Benitez also posted on Facebook photos of his meeting with the parents of the aggrieved students, in the presence of Vice Mayor Claudio Jesus Puentevilla.

In an earlier statement, Mayor Greg Gasataya said the non-payment of fees should never be a reason to prevent students from joining the graduation ceremony so long as they have fulfilled all academic requirements.

On July 1, the city's Business Permits and Licensing Office served a second notice of violation to AMA Computer College Bacolod Campus for operating without a business permit.

The first notice, served on June 25, had a three-day compliance period.

The school management failed to act, prompting the issuance of another notice, which gives it 15 working days to comply with the requirements. (PNA)

50K NIR families benefit from DSWD's Walang Gutom program

About 50,000 families across the Negros Island Region (NIR) are benefiting from the government's Walang Gutom Food Stamp Program, including about 20,000 from Negros Oriental, a Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) official said Thursday.

DSWD-NIR Director Arvin Razo said the program, now in its second year nationwide, is being implemented for the first time in the newly created region.

Under the program, qualified beneficiaries receive monthly food credits worth PHP3,000 that can be used to purchase nutritious food, including fruits, at accredited retailers.

"This program is one of the flagship initiatives of the President to ensure that no Filipino family goes hungry,"

Razo said.

To promote the program, the DSWD-NIR held an Innovation Caravan and the Walang Gutom Cook-Off Challenge at the convention center in this city on Thursday as part of the Nutrition Month celebration.

Razo said that five teams from various local government units took part in the cook-off challenge, with the winning team set to represent the NIR in the national competition.

He said the participants, beneficiaries of the Walang Gutom program, showcased dishes prepared with locally available produce and raw ingredients.

Meanwhile, DSWD Assistant Secretary for Innovations Baldr Bringas said the administration of President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. continues to prioritize programs

addressing poverty, hunger, and illiteracy.

Despite billions of pesos invested in government interventions, Bringas said the country continues to face persistent social challenges.

Citing data from the Philippine Statistics Authority, he said that about 750,000 households nationwide remain food poor, or unable to afford three nutritious meals a day.

He also raised concerns about the country's literacy situation, saying that many Filipinos continue to struggle with reading comprehension, while the number of families living on the streets continues to rise.

Bringas said DSWD Secretary Rex Gatchalian has emphasized the need to adopt innovative approaches, noting that repeating the same interventions would not yield dif-

ferent results.

He said the department created its innovations group to develop practical solutions, challenge conventional approaches, and improve the delivery of social services.

Undersecretary Ed Punay, meanwhile, underscored the importance of a whole-of-government ap-

proach in implementing anti-poverty programs.

He said the President has directed national government agencies to strengthen coordination with local government units to ensure the effective implementation of programs and services for poor and vulnerable sectors. (PNA)

Giit ng mga ito, kailangang maprotektahan ang mga bata mula sa mapanganib na online content na maaaring maka-apekto o maka-impluwensiya sa kanilang aksyon o mga kilos. Kabilang dito ang mga content na hindi akma sa kanilang edad, mapanganib na usapan, mga pagbabanta, video ng karahasan, at iba pang mga banta na lumalabas sa digital space.

Ayon sa grupo na binubuo ng mga pediatricians at mga eksperto, labis na bul-

nerable ang mga bata na mayroon na o dati nang nakikitaan ng 'developmental, behavioral, at mental health needs' sa exposure nila sa digital space.

Hindi aniya nare-regulate ang lumalabas sa online, at ang kanilang exposure o pagkakalantad sa mga mapanganib na content ay posibleng maka-impluwensiya sa kanila.

Nanindigan ang grupo na kailangang ma-regulate ang access ng mga bata sa digital space, lalo na kung hindi makayang i-regulate ng pamahalaan ang mga lumalabas na content sa online.

Batay sa ilang report, umabot na sa halos 1,500 katao ang nasawi, habang

marami pa rin ang nawawala at patuloy na hinahanap sa mga gumuhong gusali.

Dumadami rin ang tulong mula sa ibang bansa. Mahigit 24 na bansa ang nagpadala ng mga rescue teams, pagkain, at iba pang supplies upang makatulong sa Venezuela.

Sa kabilang banda isang 21-anyos na lalaki naman ang ligtas na na-rescue sa ilalim ng gumuhong gusali matapos ang mahigit 106 oras na paghahanap.

Isinagawa ang matagumpay na rescue operation sa tulong ng mga team mula Venezuela, Mexico, at El Salvador.

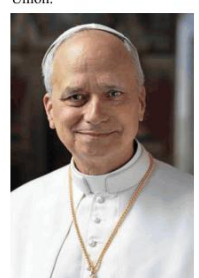

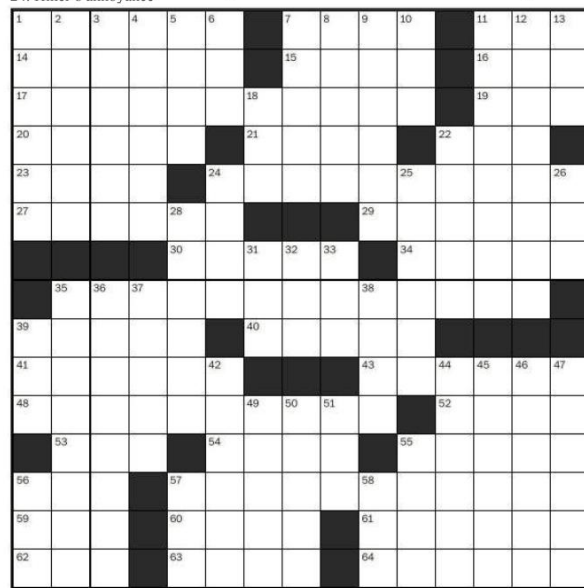

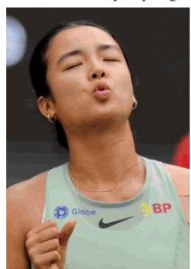

Sinundan pa ito ng isang goal mula kay Barış Alper Yılmaz sa ika-31 minuto upang agawin ang bentahe bago ang half-time, 2-1. Sa pagpasok ng second half, muling binuhay ni Sebastian Berhalter ang pagasa ng USA sa ika-49 na minuto para sa 2-2 equalizer. Bagaman nagpatuloy ang pisikalang laban para mauwi sana ito sa isang draw,

hindi pumayag ang Team Turkey at sa stoppage time (90+8 mins) ay ipinasok ng koponan ang isang goal para tapusin ang laban sa score na 3-2. Pulitika (Kanan) Sa kabila nito ay una nang nakapasok ang USA sa Round of 32 matapos nitong dominahin ang unang dalawang laban at ibulsa ang pinakamagandang record sa Group D. Sa kabilang banda, dalawang beses na ring natalo ang Turkey at posibleng hindi na makakausap pa sa susunod na elimination round.

dle Eastern team at tatlong minuto makalipas nito ay tinangka muli ng koponan na makapagpasok ng goal. Sa ika-13 minuto ng laban, ipinasok ni Ramin Rezaeian ang equalizer goal mula sa isang mahirap na angulo. Hindi naman ito nasalo ng Egyptian goalkeeper, at naitabla ang laban sa unang 13 minuto pa lamang

ng match. Sa kabila ng maituturing na 'exciting' na pagsisimula ng laban, hindi na nakapagpasok pa ang magkalalang koponan ng karagdagan goals. Ito ay sa kabila pa ng mga ser-ye ng atake sa second half, nanatiling matibay ang depensa ng dalawang koponan hanggang sa huling pito ng referee.
